LAST GAME

The Baysox won their third-straight contest last night, taking down the Akron RubberDucks 9-0. Garrett Stallings and Peter Van Loon combined for what was the fourth shutout win of the season for the Baysox. Stallings picked up his first win of the season, firing five frames with seven strikeouts, before Van Loon pitched a season-long four frames with six punchouts of his own, picking up his first save of the season in the process. Coby Mayo drove in the first three runs of the evening with an RBI single in the second and a two-run home run in the sixth. Bowie would go on to add two more runs in the sixth via an Isaac Bellony RBI single and Anthony Servideo sacrifice fly. The Baysox added four more runs in the ninth, on RBI singles by Heston Kjerstad, Mayo, and Billy Cook. A second run came across on the Cook single on an error. Mayo also ended the evening with a season-high four RBI in the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter tonight with a record of 19-21. Akron sits fifth in the Eastern League Southwest division, but just two games out of first place. The RubberDucks split their six-game series in Richmond last week and took four of six from the Baysox in Bowie last month. Both sides enter the series struggling defensively. Akron's 40 errors on the season are the second-most in the Eastern League. Only the Baysox (44) have more. Akron's roster is highlighted by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Positioned prospects include INF Angel Martinez (No. 9), OF Petey Hapin (No. 15) and INF Jose Tena (No. 21). On the mound, the RubberDucks' staff is led by right-handers Tanner Burns (No. 20) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30), along with southpaw Doug Nikhazy (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Hunter Stanley is projected to get the ball tonight for Akron. Stanley has pitched to plenty of traffic on the basepaths, with 30 hits allowed in 30.2 innings. The right-hander is coming off a season-high five runs (four earned) allowed in 4.1 innings in Richmond last Friday. Stanley has already more than doubled his inning total from his first pro season, after he was placed on the injured list in early May of 2022 following just four starts (14.1 innings) for High-A Lake County. An 11th round pick of Cleveland in 2021 out of Southern Mississippi, Stanley made his first professional start against the Baysox on 4/15 in Bowie. He took the loss after allowing four earned runs in four innings, on four hits, with a pair of walks and four strikeouts. All four runs were surrendered by Stanley in the fourth and final inning of his outing (Heston Kjerstad solo home run, John Rhodes RBI single, Donta' Williams two-run double) Stanley features a fastball, slider, changeup, and curveball.

SLIPPING UP

Two more errors for the Baysox last night upped their Double-A-leading total to 46 on the season. This comes after a season where Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors, an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 162 total errors.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 56 hits and a .376 average - 48 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hits in seven-straight games for the third time this season, and has collected hits in 17 of his 18 games this month. He holds a .397 average and a 1.045 OPS in the month of May. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks fifth in the league in on-base percentage (.415) and OPS(.945).

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. The Orioles' No. 5 prospect has demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - leading the Eastern League in slugging (.634), in addition to sitting third in average (.324) and OPS (1.034) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (21), third in hits (46) and second in total bases (90), while sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 26-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. His current 11-game hitting streak is tied for the longest by a Baysox player this season (Cesar Prieto - 11, 4/7 - 4-20) Kjerstad has reached base safely in 35 of his first 36 Double-A contests.

THE RHODE LESS TRAVELED

OF John Rhodes has continued to catch fire at the plate for Bowie in the month of May. Rhodes has reached in 13 consecutive games for the Baysox, with hits in six-straight contests overall. The on-base stretch for Rhodes is the second-longest by a Baysox player this season. Since his return from the injured list, Rhodes is hitting .378 (14-for-37). Rhodes has also proved to be one of Bowie's most consistent run-proudgers, with his 20 RBI tied for second-most on the team with Coby Mayo and one behind Heston Kjerstad for the team lead.

- Opened the season with 13 consecutive scoreless innings, currently the longest scoreless streak for a Baysox pitcher this season.
- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft.
- Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning)** Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
