Today's Games

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound today, looking to notch their second win streak of 5G this year (3/28-4/2). Toledo will counter with RHP **Ty Madden**. Columbus is 25-12 (.676, best in the IL) versus right handers this year. Madden has pitched against the Clippers four times in his career, going 0-0 with a 1.00ERA (16.0IP, 21H, 14R, 14ER, 13BB, 15K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus has pulled ahead in the season series vs. Toledo (7-4) after going 10-11 opposing the Mud Hens last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022). The Clippers have scored first in eight of 11 against Toledo this year (6-2), compared to 16 times (9-7) in their other 44G. Individually, **Bo Naylor** has hit .303 (20x66, 1HR and 12RBI) in 18G against Toledo in his career.

Climbing

Entering today's contest looking up at only four other teams, the Clippers hold their highest ranking in the standings (5th) since ending the day tied for 4th on 4/8 (6th to 13th in between). Unfortunately, Columbus is still 4.0 games out, having spent the last 33G between 3.0 (three times, last on 5/20) and 6.0 (twice, last on 5/2). The Clippers are 9-3 (3rd in the IL) since getting swept in a DH at St. Paul on 5/15.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus was scoreless in both the 8th and 9th last night for the second time this month (8G total; scored in 14 of 19 last 8ths and eight of 13 last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 92 runs from the 8th inning on (nine more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .975OPS (+121 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 26 runs in the last 19G (more than 11 teams have all season, including Toledo).

Too High

Though **Cooper Ingle** has reached in six of his last 16PA, his OBP dipped to .479 (4th in MiLB among players with at least 100PA). Since going deep in consecutive games at St. Paul on 5/16, Ingle is slashing .302/.415/.605 with 3HR and 13RBI in 11G. He reached 200BB in his career on Friday (17% of PA) and today will mark his first ever game played in fair territory (196G at catcher, 66G at DH).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .301/.386/.603 with 20XBH and 31RBI in his last 35G (1XBH in first 12G), including 7HR and 19RBI since 5/10 (1-3rd most HR in the IL during that span, 3rd in RBI). However, with RISP this year, he is hitting just .172 (10x58). Watson's walk last night snapped a 15G streak without (67PA, 23K; 34%), his longest stretch since 17G from 5/21-6/17/22 (career long, 76PA; hit .189, 14x74).

Weak Spot

Over the last 10G, in which Columbus is 7-3, the Clippers have a total of 6HR (324AB), the worst 10G stretch of the season. Only 1HR has come from hitters 4-6 in the order (**George Valera** batting fifth on 5/19 vs. Louisville), with two of today's such batters (**Ralph Velazquez** and **Bo Naylor**) having yet to homer with Columbus. **CJ Kayfus** is homerless in his last 78AB with Columbus (7/19/25).

Gaining Steam

George Valera owns a 16G on base streak since 5/5 (.380OBP). Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but he has over reached half the time in the last 8G (.514OBP in 35PA; hitting .346, 9x26 with 9BB and 4K). His walk rate is down a tick this year (12.0%; 13.3% from '22-25), while his K-rate is down considerably (16.9% from 26.5%).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of April). Huff is 5x23 (.217) in 8G since the streak ended, but has 6RBI (39RBI in 45G; had career high 47RBI in 101G last season).

Back on Track

In the last 17G, the Columbus bullpen has a 3.03ERA (65.1IP, 22ER), 3rd best in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 17G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 15th at 5.23; starters have a 5.45ERA, 16th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 4HR to 103BF since.

This Date in Clipper History

5/31/2014

The Clippers swept a day-night double header vs. Louisville, winning the first game 19-3 as **Audy Ciriaco** went 4x5 with a triple, a HR and 3RBI and **Tyler Cloyd** twirled a complete game. In the nightcap, the Clippers squeaked by 2-1, thanks to a walk-off single from Ciriaco. In a surprising twist, the game with 22 runs scored took 2:44 to complete, while the game with three runs was a 3:03 marathon.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 77-75 (.507) in pitch reviews, with batters going 43-50 (.462) and pitchers/catchers going 34-25 (.576). They have run out of challenges in 31G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 851, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 78 through the first 55G (on pace for 211SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (49; nabbed 51 times in 2004).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,932RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.34 through the first 55G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 156HR (3rd lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 10th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 30G this season (19-11, .633), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 416-431 (.491), 386-385 with Columbus (.501).

Workhorse

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 80 pitches a start this season, at 87.3 (along with **Ryan Webb**, only pitchers to throw more than 90 in a game multiple times). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 519G ago)

Stellar Support:

Through 8GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 1.69ERA in relief (32.0IP, 6ER), stranding two of three runners inherited. The defense has committed only 6E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forward 6.0 runs per game. That all adds up to a 7-1 record for Columbus when he takes the hill.

2026 Spring Training:

Allen pitched four times for Cleveland during spring training, going 0-2 with an 18.00ERA (10.0IP, 25H, 20R, 20ER, 8BB, 9K). He was optioned to Columbus on 3/22, but did not join the team until 3/31.

Last Season:

Pitched the entire season with Cleveland... after season opening loss at San Diego on 4/1 (5.1IP, 7H, 4R, 4ER, 5BB, 1K), went 1-0 with a 0.56ERA (16.0IP, 1ER) in next 3GS (4/9-4/20), before loss vs. Boston on 4/27 (4.1IP, 9H, 7R, 7ER, 3BB, 2K)... won with a scoreless start on 5/13 vs. Milwaukee (6.0IP, 3H, 1BB, 6K) and earned a win in a relief outing on 5/31 vs. Los Angeles (1.0IP, 2K)... went 3-3 with a 3.34ERA (35.0IP, 13ER) in 6GS (4QS) prior to the All-Star Break (6/11-7/11)... lost a pair out of the Break before winning vs. Colorado on 7/29 (7.0IP, 8H, 2R, 2ER, 1BB, 3K)... struggled over 5GS from 8/12-9/4, turning in a 6.66ERA (25.2IP, 19ER)... won a scoreless start on 9/20 at Minnesota, following a nine-day layoff (8.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K)... did not pitch in the AL Playoffs.
