YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 6-5, with a walk-off sac fly by **Brandon Martorano** in the bottom of the ninth. Trailing, 5-4, entering the ninth, Richmond scored when **Mike Gigliotti** was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded. Richmond scored the first run in the first inning on a double-play groundout. Erie tied the score, 1-1, with a solo homer by Parker Meadows in the third. Erie took a 2-1 lead in the fifth on a solo home run by Dillon Dingler, but Gigliotti drove in a run with a groundout in the bottom of the inning to tie the score, 2-2. Quincy Nieporte homered in the sixth to open a 4-2 lead, but **Tyler Fitzgerald** answered with a two-run homer to tie the game, 4-4, in the bottom of the inning. Dingler moved Erie back in front with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the ninth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the second series between the two teams this year. From April 20-24, the Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park in Erie. The two teams will meet again for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 13-18 to close the regular season. The Flying Squirrels enter play today in first place in the Southwest Division, ahead of Erie and Akron by one game with 13 games remaining before the first half closes on June 26.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won nine-of-2 games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road at Akron, knocking the RubberDucks out sole possession of first place. The Flying Squirrels have won six series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 606 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 234 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.92 ERA (4 ER/39.0 IP) over the last 11 games since May 31.

THE SEAWOLVES had gone 13-4 since May 19-June 5 before dropping four-of-five in this week's series. They are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Richmond and Akron. Prior to this series, Erie had won each of its last three series against New Hampshire, at Bowie and at home against Harrisburg. On the year, the Erie pitching staff has a 3.70 ERA, which is second in the EL. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Dillon Dingler (3), Gage Workman (10), Wilmer Flores (14), Reese Olson (16), Parker Meadows (18), Andre Lipcius (24) and Austin Bergner (28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his team-leading 12th start of the season and his third against Erie. He started the series-opener on Tuesday and allowed three runs over 3.2 innings. He also faced the SeaWolves on April 21 at UPMC Park and allowed two runs over 4.1 innings. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Reese Olson makes his 11th start and 12th overall appearance this year. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and surrendered four runs in 4.1 innings of work, striking out six. He also made a start against Richmond this year, allowing three runs over five innings with nine strikeouts on April 21 at UPMC Park. He was the Opening Day starter for the SeaWolves on April 8 against Akron and threw four scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Olson was drafted by the Brewers in the 13th round in 2018 out of North Hall High School in Georgia. He was traded to the Tigers on July 30, 2021 for LHP Daniel Norris. He was promoted to Erie last August and made his Double-A debut at The Diamond on August 20, allowing one run in four innings. He also pitched against Richmond in Erie on September 17 and allowed one run, a solo homer by Shane Matheny, with eight strikeouts over six innings in his final outing of the year. Olson is rated by MLB.com as the Tigers' No. 16 prospect.

#WINNING: The Flying Squirrels have tied their best record in franchise history through 56 games at 32-24, ahead of 31-25 starts in 2013 and 2014. The Flying Squirrels' best start through 57 games is 32-25, which was set in 2013 and 2014 and can be surpassed with a win this afternoon.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,093) and total attendance (176,710). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 74 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (77). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 16 homers on the season, with 13 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 183 home runs.

A LITTLE RELIEF: The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.92 ERA (4 ER/39.0 IP) over the last 11 games since May 31. In that stretch, **Blake Rivera** has made two scoreless outings with 5.0 scoreless innings. **R.J. Dabovich** has pitched four outings without allowing a run, covering 4.1 innings with seven strikeouts and no walks. **John Russell** has worked three straight scoreless outings in that span, totaling 4.0 innings. **Chris Wright** and Dabovich have combined to convert all four of the team's save opportunities in that stretch.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 22 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .309 (25-for-81) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 16 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on May 7 at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in the 8-4 win over the Ducks on May 9. On Saturday, he lifted a walk-off sac fly in the bottom of the ninth for a 6-5 win over Erie.

FITZ ON FIRE: After opening the season hit .162 through May 26, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is batting .341 (15-for-44) with four homers, five doubles and nine RBIs over his last 12 games since May 27. On May 29, Fitzgerald homered twice and tied a single-game franchise record with five hits. He also set new single-game franchise records with five runs scored and 13 total bases. He clubbed his eighth homer of the year in Saturday's win over the SeaWolves.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .342 (28-for-82) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 17 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on Tuesday. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. He collected two walks in Saturday's game, extending his on-base streak to 24 games, which is the longest active streak in the league and tied for the second-longest this year overall.

ARMANI ARRIVES: After going hitless in his Double-A debut on May 15, **Armani Smith** has picked up at least one hit in 11-of-his-last-14 games played. During that 14-game span since May 17, Smith is batting .346 (18-for-52) with a homer, three doubles, a triple, four RBIs, seven runs scored and five walks. He hit his first Double-A homer on Thursday against the SeaWolves.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is hitless over his last three games, going 0-for-12 in that span with three strikeouts. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 40 of his 50 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.307), tied for third in hits (61) and seventh in total bases (96).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 16th homer of the season on Friday night, his third straight game with a homer. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (20). He has hit 13 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. With two homers on May 29 against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking seven in his last 13 games since May 26.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.307), tied for third in hits (61) and seventh in total bases (96). **Sean Roby** is second in home runs (16), seventh in SLG (.517) and 10th in total bases (91). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in walks (27). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6). **Taylor Rashi** is tied for sixth in games pitched (19). **Chris Wright** is tied for fourth in saves (6). **Bryan Brickhouse** is 10th in innings pitched (51.0). **Jake Dahlberg** is tied for eighth in winning percentage (.600).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: In the Eastern League, Kerry Carpenter is first in batting average (.318), first in homers (20), first in RBIs (42), first in SLG (.677), first in OPS (1.051), first in extra-base hits (29), first in total bases (130), second in runs scored (40) and tied for third in hits (61). Quincy Nieporte is tied for third in homers (15), first for third in RBIs (40), fifth in SLG (.567), eighth in OPS (.890), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (23) and sixth in total bases (97). Andre Lipcius is sixth in OBP (.407) and second in walks (42). Gage Workman is tied for fifth in doubles (14) and tied for fifth in stolen bases (15). Dillon Dingler is 10th in doubles (13).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whitmore** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
