TULSA, OK – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals went back-and-forth with the Tulsa Drillers but came out ahead, for a 6-5 win at ONEOK Field on Wednesday night.

- Second baseman **Robbie Glendinning** went 2-for-5 and drove in the first five runs of the game for Northwest Arkansas. Down by a run in the third, he connected on a three-run, go-ahead home run. His 19th homer of the year was not the end of his night offensively, as the Australian added two more runs of insurance in the seventh with a two-run double.
- Starting pitcher **Anthony Veneziano** pitched into the seventh for both the second time this season and his career, with 6.2 innings while striking out eight. Between the second and fourth innings, he retired eight straight and found himself at just 78 pitches through six innings, but ran into trouble in the seventh as the Drillers managed to tie the game up 5-5 with three runs, just two earned to Veneziano.
- After **Kasey Kalich** recorded the final out of the seventh and threw a scoreless eighth, Naturals leadoff hitter **Tucker Bradley** opened the ninth with a line drive home run to right field, his second in as many nights and 11th of the season to put the Naturals ahead 6-5.
- Yefri Del Rosario** made quick work of the Drillers in the bottom of the ninth, with a 1-2-3 frame to lock down his sixth save of the year.
- Bradley, Glendinning, **CJ Alexander** and **Angelo Castellano** each contributed two-hit games, while Alexander scored twice in the winning effort.
- John Rave** and **Luca Tresh** each drew two walks as eight of nine Naturals starters in the lineup reached base twice.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 8-4 all-time when playing on September 2

On September 2, 2018, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Arkansas Travelers, 8-2 at Dickey-Stephens Park, behind a 3-for-5, 6-RBI game from right fielder **Ed Lucas**. Lucas doubled and scored in the first inning, then doubled in two runs in the third inning. Retired his next two plate appearances, Lucas came to the plate with the bases loaded in the ninth and ended a seven-pitch at-bat with a grand slam to left field, his 10th home run of the season as important insurance in the victory. Starting pitcher **Anthony Lerew** held the Travelers to two runs (one earned) over 6.0 innings with no walks and six strikeouts to earn his 10th win of the year.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A Quad Cities* (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 26 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 3 of the Naturals' 26 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Jonah Dipoto**, **Jake Means** and **John Rave**.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 38-10, while when scoring six runs or less, just 13-61.
- The Naturals are 35-15 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 16-55.
- The Naturals are 46-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 5-56 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 31-23, whereas 20-47 when the opponent scores first ... the team that scores first in through 121 Naturals games is 78-43 (.645 winning percentage).

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 7-18 in one-run games this season, meaning 18 of their 70 losses (25.71%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 23 losses this season (including 14 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 121 games, the Naturals have stolen 156 bases in 194 attempts (average 1.29 steals/game, 80.41% success rate).

- 156 steals is second in the Texas League, ranks seventh in Double-A and 35th in the Minors.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 80 of 121 games this season (66.12%), including 39 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 18 times, meaning 36 of 156 steals this year (23.08%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 16 times, SIX of those occasions being Maikel Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- **Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks sixth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks eighth in the league.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 86 of 105 games played this season (81.90%) and reached base multiple times on a team-best 53 occasions ... he has hits in 73 of 105 games and has a team-best 32 multi-hit games, as well as 15 multi-run games and 11 multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .289 batting average leads qualified active Naturals hitters ... his 112 hits rank third among Kansas City's minor league hitters, while .289 average ranks fourth and 22 doubles are tied fourth, a .373 on-base percentage is fifth, 36 extra-base hits are tied sixth, 173 total bases rank seventh, 68 runs scored are tied seventh and a .820 OPS is ninth.
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 36 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .265 hitter (39-for-147) with a .365 on-base percentage and .780 OPS.
- Four of Bradley's 11 home runs this year came in the month of August, on 8/20 and 8/21, as well as 8/30 and 8/31 ... four homers last month ties a career-high of home runs in a month, which he also accomplished in May 2022.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks 11TH in batting average (.323), while his .426 on-base percentage is 12TH when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.323), slugging percentage (.535) and OPS (.961), while he ranks second in on-base percentage (.426) behind Logan Porter's .433 ... his 184 total bases between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied second in the system, 18 home runs are tied third and 71 runs batted in are tied fourth.
- Gentry has reached base in 53 of 58 games (91.38%), including 25 straight games ... he has hits in 41 of his 58 games with the Naturals, with already 20 multi-hit games.
- In 58 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .315 (68-for-216) with 11 doubles, 13 home runs and 48 runs batted in, with a .967 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 28 of 58 games, with 11 multi-RBI games.
- Gentry leads the Naturals in nearly every category since joining the team, with the highest average (.315), most total bases (118), most home runs (13) and most runs batted in on the team (48) ... his 48 RBI and 118 TB are third in the Texas League since June 14, while a .966 OPS is fifth and his 13 homers rank tied sixth since his promotion to Double-A.
- Tyler has compiled the two longest on-base streaks among Naturals hitters this season, including an active 25-game stretch that ranks tied for the sixth-longest in franchise history ... since July 30, he is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with seven extra-base hits and 20 walks, for a .470 on-base percentage over the last 25 games, the longest active streak in the Texas League and tied for the eighth-longest this year ... between June 26 and July 17, he reached safely in 18 consecutive games, batting .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- When combining his number between the Naturals and Mississippi Braves (Double-A), he has a career-best 24 home runs and 80 runs batted in ... among all Double-A hitters this year, he ranks tied third in RBI and tied sixth in home runs.
- In 35 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .264 (38-for-144) with 17 extra-base hits (nine home runs) and 37 runs batted in, with 27 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 24 of 35 games with the Naturals, 13 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 15 of 35 games, including already 11 multi-RBI games.
- Yesterday, Alexander was named the Naturals' August Player of the Month ... over 21 games in the month of August, Alexander hit .297 (27-for-91) with eight home runs and 29 runs batted in ... 29 RBI led both the Texas League and all Double-A hitters last month, while tied second among all full-season Minor League hitters ... his 8 HR were tied for the league lead, tied third in Double-A and tied tenth in the minors ... 57 total bases last month were tied fourth in Texas League and tied seventh in Double-A.
- CJ homered in four straight games at home against Tulsa, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.

DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

Today marks the 2nd doubleheader for the Naturals in 2022 and 68th overall in franchise history.

- On June 9 in Tulsa, the Naturals swept a doubleheader over the Drillers, 5-3 and 3-0.
- Northwest Arkansas has swept its last four doubleheaders dating back to last year and six of its last nine going back to 2019.
- All-time, in games as part of a doubleheader, the Naturals are 69-61.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: **LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

April 25 to May 1: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

May 23 to May 29: **2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

June 27 to July 3: **OF Tyler Gentry** ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (5)

May 2 to May 8: **LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.
