YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 4-2, taking a no-hitter into the ninth inning. Hayden Birdsong worked five hitless innings and struck out five batters in his start. Tanner Kiest pitched two innings. Tyler Myrick threw a hitless eighth held 1 - 0 antil a 3 for-4 In the eighth, Adrián Sugastey worked a bases-loaded walk to push the lead to 40 . TT Bowens brought home the only 3-for-4. In the eighth, Adrian Sugastey worked
Bowie runs with a two-run double in the ninth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels, having won three-of-four to open the week, are looking for their first series win of the season. Richmond has won five-of-its-last six games dating back to last week's series at Harrisburg. In tonight's game, the Flying squirrels play as the Richmond River City, a one-night rebrand for James River Appreciation Night presented by River City Roll. The on-field jerseys are being auctioned to benefit the James River Association.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have split the last two series, including a six-game series to open their home schedule against Akron from April 9-14 and a six-game road series in Harrisburg from April 16-21. They dropped two-of-three at Somerset to open the season from April 5-7. Last year, the Flying Squirrels reached the postseason for the second consecutive season and the fourth Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished $33-36$, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a $41-28$ record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent ( 79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 8-5 in their last 12 games.

THE BAYSOX won five-of-six in last week's series at Prince George's Stadium against the Altoona Curve, including a walk-off single on Friday in the 10th inning by John Rhodes and a walk-off grand slam by Jud Fabian in the ninth on Saturday. The Baysox opened the year taking two-of-three against the Reading Fightin Phils at home before dropping four-of-six in Hartford from April 9-14. Last year, the Baysox went 67-70, fourth in the Southwest Division. They finished last in the first-half Southwest Division standings, going 31-38, before going $36-32$ in the second half, third-best in the division. The Bowie roster includes nine of MLB. com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/1B Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 27) and OF/2B Billy Cook (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 10), Beavers (No. 11), Fabian (No. 13), Bright (No. 21), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 30).
FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched last Sunday at Harrisburg and surrendered three runs (two earned) over 4.2 innings, his shortest start of the year, with a season-high three walks His last start at The Diamond was on April 10 when he threw five scoreless innings against the RubberDucks. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Brandon Young makes his third appearance of the year and his second start. He was reinstated from the 7-day injured list today after being placed on the IL on April 17. He made his season debut at Hartford on April 9 and allowed three runs over 4.1 innings, striking out seven. He last pitched on April 16 against the Curve and threw one relief inning, allowing one run. Young missed the start of the 2023 season before beginning rehab starts in July. He joined the Baysox in mid-August and went $0-3$ with a 4.26 ERA. After signing with the Orioles in 2020 out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels infielder Hayden Cantrelle, he began the 2022 season with Bowie before suffering an injury after three starts and missing the rest of the year.

SUGASTEY SURGING: Adrián Sugastey had hit safely in his last seven games before a hitless game Saturday, the longest streak by a Flying Squirrels player this year. He did work a walk, extending his on-base streak to eight games. During that streak, Sugastey is batting . 321 ( 9 -for-28) with eight singles, a double, four RBIs and three runs scored. This year, Sugastey is the youngest catcher in the Eastern League. With his debut earlier this month, Sugastey became the second-youngest catcher in team history behind Tommy Joseph (2012) and the 13th-youngest player in franchise history.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting 387 (12-for-31) over his current eight-game on-base streak with three doubles, five RBIs and five walks. That stretch has raised his season batting average from . 069 to .233 . In his last four games, Wilson is batting OPS. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 154 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons

HOWELL HEATING UP: Carter Howell has reached base in 10 consecutive games, the longest on-base streak by a Flying Squirrels batter in 2024 so far. In that stretch, he is batting .306 (11-for-36) with four doubles, one triple, four RBls, six walks and seven runs scored. Last year in his first full professional season, Howell led the Giants system in hits (144) and triples (8) and

PAY YOUR DUES: In his 10 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, Damon Dues is batting . 304 (7-for-23) with nine walks and a .500 on-base percentage, which is first in the Eastern League (min. 25 PA). In his current eight-game on-base streak, Dues has reached base 14 times. Dues signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of Wright State University.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 184 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and also ranked third with a 3.31 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.54 ERA this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (2.07) and Erie (2.37). The Richmond bullpen has the fifth-lowest ERA (3.13) in the league

BIDDING FOR HISTORY: On Friday night, the Flying Squirrels' pitching staff took a no-hit bid into the ninth inning against the Baysox, but came three outs shy of finishing the no-hitter. There has only been one no-hitter pitched by the home team in the 40 -year history of The Diamond, which was a seven-inning no-no in 2013 by Jack Snodgrass and Daryl Maday. The last time Richmond team completed a no-hitter at home was on June 1, 1977 when Richmond Braves pitcher Mickey Mahler no-hit the Toledo Mud Hens at Parker Field.
