Today: After a postponement yesterday, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers, play a doubleheader for the fourth and fifth games of their six-game series. Wisconsin has won two of the first three games between the two clubs, including an overwhelming thumping yesterday. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and T-Rats this season.

Last Game, Thursday: Timber Rattlers 10, Lugnuts 0. Lansing catcher **Logan Sauve** delivered a leadoff double in the third inning, the only Nuts base hit against the combined efforts of rehabbing Kyle Harrison (5 2/3 IP), Jason Woodward (1/3), Bjorn Johnson (1 IP), Yerlin Rodriguez (1 IP) and José Meneses (1 IP). Meanwhile, Lansing starter **Jorge Marcheco** gave up an Eric Bitonti solo home run in the first inning, Tayden Hall solo homer in the second, Braylon Payne solo homer in the third, and back-to-back solo shots from Payne and Daniel Dickinson in the fifth. Luiyin Alastre added a two-run homer off Ryan Brown in the sixth inning, marking the second time this season that Lansing has allowed six home runs in a game.

LUG-NOTES

2026 Twinbills: Today marks the Lugnuts' third doubleheader of the season. Lansing was previously swept at home on April 17 by West Michigan, 6-4 and 4-1, and was swept at home on April 29 by Dayton, 5-2 and 7-0. The Nuts and T-Rats also played a doubleheader last year, splitting the two games on April 18.

July's Best: With July concluded, the Lansing Lugnuts were led by...

- **Jared Sprague-Lott** posted an .847 OPS, batting .306/.423/.424, with a team-leading 20 runs, 36 total bases, 8 steals and 17 walks in 22 games.
- **Ali Camarillo** hit a team-leading .313, tying Sprague-Lott with 26 base hits in 22 games, drawing 12 walks compared to nine strikeouts.
- **Abel Mercedes** recorded a 0.00 ERA, allowing two unearned runs in seven appearances while giving up just two hits in 27 batters faced.

A'round the A's: Though Single-A Stockton lost to Lake Elsinore, 15-5, 18-year-old **Breyson Guedez** went 3-for-5 with a single, double, home run and three RBIs; Guedez finished July with a .375 avg. and a 1.047 OPS, with six games of at least three hits. Guedez has 12 games with at least three hits this season.

Roster Transaction: Right-hander **Blaze Pontes** was promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday and fired two hitless innings with two strikeouts in an 8-3 loss to Arkansas. He joins **Bobby Boser**, **Davis Diaz**, **Justin Riemer**, **Devin Taylor**, **Casey Yamauchi**, **Nathan Dettmer**, **Jay Dill**, **Jackson Finley**, **Jake Garland**, **Ben Hansen**, **Ryan Magdic** and **Zane Taylor** to be called up this season, plus a trade of **Kyle Robinson** to Pittsburgh (and Robinson is currently pitching in Double-A).

Against the West: With Thursday's loss, the Nuts are 14-12 (and 5-10 on the road) against West Division teams this season: 4-1 vs. Cedar Rapids, 7-5 vs. Quad Cities, 2-4 at South Bend, and 1-2 at Wisconsin. Lansing's overall 41-55 record has been weighed down by a 4-13 record vs. West Michigan and 3-9 mark vs. Lake County.

Major League Lugnuts: Nine former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Hump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. Bolte, Jump and White join **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Luis Morales**, **Jack Perkins**, **Jacob Wilson**, **Lawrence Butler** and **Tyler Soderstrom** on the Athletics' current roster, meaning that former Lugnuts comprise 40% of the A's 25-man roster.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted Sunday into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

AUGUST 1 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: 19-year-old Jake Marisnick made his Lugnuts debut, jumping up from the Gulf Coast Blue Jays. Marisnick, a 3rd-round selection in 2009, had slashed .287/.373/.459 in 35 games in the GCL. In his Lugnuts debut, he went 2-for-3 with a single, double and two RBIs, plus an HBP. Kevin Ahrens went 2-for-2 with two walks and two solo home runs, scoring four runs, but the Lugnuts lost at Bowling Green, 10-8. Lugnuts pitcher Egan Smith was ejected in the 9th from the first-base visitors dugout and made sure to take a sloooooow walk to the clubhouse out beyond the left-center field wall..

2024: Ryan Lasko launched an eighth-inning, three-run, game-tying homer over the batter's eye, but the Dayton Dragons battled back to outlast the Lansing Lugnuts 13-9 in 11 innings on a rainy night at Jackson® Field™. The Dragons brought a 7-4 lead to the bottom of the eighth with rehabbing Major Leaguer Connor Overton on the mound. But Overton hit T.J. Schofield-Sam with a pitch, gave up a single to Jonny Butler and then allowed Lasko's first High-A home run, a majestic 435-foot clout to straightaway center.

MLB Pipeline's No. 14 A's prospect / No. 7 pitcher (behind Jamie Arnold, Wei-En Lin, Braden Nett, Kade Morris, Shotaro Morii, Henry Baez); Fastball 55, Curve 45, Slider 55, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... topped the 2025 Lugnuts in starts (25)... closed A's 2026 Spring Breakout win, tossing the final two innings vs. Brewers prospects.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... will tie for the Midwest League lead with his 19th start today... ranks 5th in the MWL in innings (83, 6 2/3 behind league-leading teammate Samuel Dutton) and ranks 5th in batting average (.261)... limited opposition to .195 avg. with 3.86 ERA in April, but allowed .260 avg. with 7.23 ERA in May, .263 avg. with 6.93 ERA in June, and .343 avg., 4.96 ERA (in 16 1/3 IP) in July... limiting lefties to .234 avg., righties are batting .286 (and .457 SLG)... allowing .354 avg. / .997 OPS in 1st inning.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
