Today: It's the second of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. The T-Rats won the opener last night, dropping the Nuts to 13-9 against teams from the West Division and 0-6 when playing road games at teams whose names start with the letter W.

Yesterday: Timber Rattlers 7, Lugnuts 2. In the Nuts' second consecutive game to last over three hours, the Timber Rattlers broke a 2-2 tie in the fifth inning on a Luis Castillo RBI single, en route to a five unanswered runs and a series-opening win. Five different Lugnuts committed an error in the loss: catcher **Dylan Fien**, first baseman **Daniel Bucciero**, second baseman **Gunner Gouldsmith**, shortstop **Ali Camarillo** and third baseman **Jared Sprague-Lott**.

On the Air: Chris Mehring and Jonathan Timm deliver the call on Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler can be heard via milb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play at the T-Rats through Sunday, next returning home for a six-game series from August 4-9 against Lake County.

Welcome Back, Jack: Appleton's own **Jack Mahoney** (Appleton West H.S.) is freshly back from the Injured List (July 1-25) right on time for a homecoming. Mahoney's most recent appearance came on June 30 vs. Dayton, allowing three unearned runs in 2/3 IP. The Wisconsin-Milwaukee product has a 4.50 ERA in 21 relief appearances this year, limiting lefties to a .200 average this year (2 walks, 11 strikeouts), while right-handers are batting .294 against him (12 walks, 10 strikeouts). Before Mahoney, the last Lugnuts player to hail from Appleton was 2015 catcher **Danny Jansen** (currently on the Rangers' 10-day Injured List).

Breaking Out: Infielder **Gunner Gouldsmith** was hitting just .133 (6-for-45) in July before going 3-for-4 yesterday with a double and two singles. Gouldsmith was batting .310 with a .455 OBP on May 26 (his 26th game) after going 2-for-4 vs. West Michigan, but had slumped to a .184 avg / .255 OBP in 37 games since.

Patience, Please: Infielder **Ali Camarillo** drew two walks for the second straight game, giving him 14 walks (compared to eight strikeouts) in his last 21 games. Over that stretch, Camarillo is hitting .342 (27-for-39) with a .448 OBP.

Two by Two: Infielder **Jared Sprague-Lott** drew a walk in the 1st inning and delivered an RBI single in the 2nd inning last night, marking the 11th consecutive game that Sprague-Lott has reached base at least twice (begun on July 11). During the 11-game stretch, Sprague-Lott is 15-for-41 with 11 walks, a .366 avg. and .500 OBP.

A'round the Org:

- 2025 Lugnuts **Gage Jump** and **Tommy White** starred in a 4-3 Athletics win over Boston; Jump fired six scoreless innings, allowing three hits and four walks while striking out seven, and White went 4-for-4 with four singles and two runs scored to lift his batting average to .359.
- In Triple-A, 2022-23 Lugnut **Max Muncy** drew four walks and 2022-24 Lugnut **Brayan Buevas** hit a three-run homer to help the Aviators beat Oklahoma City, 8-6. Las Vegas clinched the first half PCL West title and has burst out to an 18-10 division-leading record to open the second half.
- In Double-A, 2026 Lugnut **Devin Taylor** went 2-for-4 with a walk and a three-run homer and fellow 2026 Nut **Zane Taylor** allowed two runs in four innings, striking out three, in an 8-6 RockHounds win over Arkansas. Midland is 14-14, in a three-way tie for the Texas League South second half playoff berth.
- In Single-A, 18-year-old **Breyson Guedez** went 2-for-4 with a single, a double and a run scored in Stockton's 6-1 loss to Lake Elsinore. Guedez is batting .383/.426/.594 with 67 hits in 42 games since May 30.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted Sunday into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

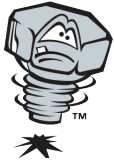

JULY 29 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Trailing 10-8 to South Bend in the bottom of the 9th, the Lugnuts loaded the bases with none out. Kevin Patterson and K.C. Hobson struck out, but Kipp Schutz – a minor league free agent – came through with a three-run double to walk off the Silver Hawks, 11-10. South Bend starter Archie Bradley struck out 11 batters in 4 2/3 innings, but also gave up five hits, four walks and five runs, plus two HBPs and one balk. The game had 34 total hits (19 by South Bend) in addition to 21 total runs.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom hit his 20th and final home run with the Lugnuts, a tie-breaking shot in the top of the sixth, but José Ramos answered with a two-run homer to give the Great Lakes Loons a 4-2 victory at Dow Diamond.

In a Nutshell: Welcome to Lansing, Devin Kirby! The right-hander with the seven-pitch arsenal (including a knuckler) became the 12th different Lugnut to start a game this season on July 23 vs. Great Lakes, the 26th different pitcher (including position-player/pitcher Gunner Gouldsmith), and the 1,007th player in Lugnuts history... Kirby opened the year with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs (5 GS, 1-0, 3.09, 23 1/3 IP, 11 BB, 22 K) before his contract was purchased by the A's on May 22... he made four appearances with the Complex League A's and six appearances with Single-A Stockton before he was called up to replace the promoted Ben Hansen and Zane Taylor.

Hometown Hero: Ukiah is located just south of Redwood Valley in northern California, 115 miles north of San Francisco... Aaron Rodgers spent several years of his youth in Ukiah... the iconic Don Mossi lived in Ukiah after retiring... Kirby was a two-time First Team All-Conference at Ukiah High School, 2016-2017.

College Life: Kirby spent 2019 with Santa Rosa Junior College and was named First Team All-American, All-Conference, All-State and All-Region, posting a 1.09 ERA with 79 K in 49 2/3 IP, 17 SV, 28 games pitched... transferred to UConn and missed the 2021 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery... returned in 2022 as UConn's relief ace, recording the final five outs to beat Xavier to win the Big East championship... in 2023, went 7-1, 4.35, 49 2/3 IP, 43 K, as the Huskies won the Big East regular season championship.

Off to Pro Ball: Spent 2023-2025 in the Twins' organization... pitched in the 2024 Arizona Fall League (6 G, 9.53 ERA, 11 1/3 IP, 11 H, 13 BB, 8 K)... released May 28, 2025... signed with the Orioles on June 6, 2025... released by the Orioles on August 2, 2025... signed with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs to open 2026... signed with the A's, May 22... moved up to Lansing, July 22.
