YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Sea Dogs, 12-4. Nathan Hickey opened the scoring in the first with a three-run double. Victor Bericoto hit a solo homer in the top of the second to cut the score to 3-1. In the bottom of the second, Chase Meidroth hit a two-run single and Blaze Jordan hit a two-run homer to open a 7-1 lead. Jimmy Glowenke hit a solo homer in the third, but Meidroth answered with an RBI single in the bottom of the inning and the Sea Dogs scored four more runs in the fifth to pull ahead, 12-2. In the top of the ninth with two outs, Logan Wyatt hit a two-run homer.

TŪDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth and sixth of a six-game road series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series marks the second time these two teams have faced off this season. They met at The Diamond from July 25-30, with Richmond winning five-of-six. The Flying Squirrels needs to win both games to get a split in this week's series. Richmond is 2-8 in Portland over the last two seasons. This afternoon's doubleheader serves to make up Friday's rainout.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 33-23 in their last 56 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, but have gone 1-3 in this week's series. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.91 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 430.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 589.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.75 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 11th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DIGS entered their series at The Diamond on July 25 with the best record in the Eastern League and led the Northeast Division in the second-half standings. Since then, they have gone 10-18, the worst record in the league in that span. Portland's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1, No. 15 overall), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 5), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 8), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), SS Brainer Bonaci (No. 11), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 14), 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 15) and RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospect list includes seven Portland players, including Mayer (No. 1, No. 11 overall), Yorke (No. 6), Gonzalez (No. 9), Bonaci (No. 11), Jordan (No. 12), Hickey (No. 15) and Meidroth (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack takes the mound for his 13th start of the year and his second since being reinstated from the injured list on August 20 after missing three weeks in Game 1. In his first game back from the IL last Sunday, he worked 1.1 innings and allowed one run. Over his last five starts since July 5, Zwack is 1-1 with a 4.74 ERA (10 ER/19.0 IP/24 SO/4 BB). Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his eighth Double-A start and his second third the Sea Dogs in Game 2. In the opener of the series on Tuesday, Bertrand allowed three runs over five innings in a loss. He previously pitched against Portland on July 29 at The Diamond and surrendered three runs (two earned) in five innings in a no-decision. In his last four starts, since August 4, Bertrand has a 2.70 ERA (6 ER/20.0 IP/18 SO/6 BB). He has allowed two-or-less earned runs in five-of-his-seven Double-A starts. During his time with the High-A Eugene Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furnan before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page three.

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Wikelman Gonzalez makes his seventh Double-A start and his second against Richmond. Gonzalez last pitched last Saturday at Binghamton and allowed a Double-A-high four runs over 2.2 innings in a loss. He made his third Double-A start at The Diamond on July 29 and surrendered two runs over five innings, working around four walks. On the year, he ranked second in the Red Sox system in strikeouts (146), tied for eighth in wins (7) and eighth in innings pitched (92.1). Gonzalez began the season with High-A Greenville and went 6-3 with a 5.14 ERA in 15 starts before being promoted to Double-A on July 14. Gonzalez signed as an international free agent with the Red Sox in 2018.

Right-hander Sterling Sharp starts in Game 2, his 16th start of the season and his second against Richmond. He last pitched on Wednesday out of the bullpen and surrendered one run over two innings with four walks. He also made a start at The Diamond on July 26 and allowed six runs over 4.1 innings in a loss. After going 0-4 with a 12.74 ERA (25 ER/17.2 IP) in four July starts, Sharp is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in his last three outings since August 2. Sharp was selected in the 22nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. He first reached Double-A in 2018 with Harrisburg and pitched parts of three seasons with the Senators. Sharp was selected in the 2019 Rule 5 Draft by the Miami Marlins and made his MLB debut in 2020. He was returned to the Nationals in August 2020. Sharp signed with the Red Sox as a free agent last August and made his Boston organization debut at Hadlock Field against Richmond on August 13, allowing two runs in five innings. In five career starts against the Flying Squirrels dating back to 2018, Sharp is 1-3 with a 7.03 ERA (19 ER/24.1 IP).

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 20 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in third place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, a half-game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and the Bowie Baysox. Harrisburg is four games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

THOMAS TRENDING UP: In this week's series, Andy Thomas has reached base eight times in 12 plate appearances. On Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer and worked a walk in his three plate appearances. On Wednesday, Thomas walked three times and had two hits, including a three-run double in the first inning. He has also hit safely in five straight games since Saturday. On the year, Thomas is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs and leads Richmond with 57 RBIs.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 53 times in his last 27 games since July 25 (29 hits, 24 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .302 (29-for-96) with five homers, six doubles, two triples and 21 RBIs adding a .440 on-base percentage. In last week's series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. Last Tuesday night against the Senators, Matheny homered twice, a three-run shot in and a solo home run, and added a double in a three-hit, four-RBI performance. It was the third two-homer game of his Richmond career, joining performances on May 1, 2022 against Bowie and May 12, 2022 at Harrisburg. On Thursday, he entered off the bench and collected a pinch-hit, RBI single in the seventh. On Saturday, he hit a three-run homer and added a sac fly, his second four-RBI game of the series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 131 walks, ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last seven games since August 16, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .370 (10-for-27) with two homers, three doubles and seven RBIs. He went 2-for-4 last Thursday, including a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback in the last inning, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On Thursday at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs on the night. He added another homer on Saturday. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 21 homers (16 with Eugene and five with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 70 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt hit a three-run homer on Sunday afternoon, his 13th home runs this year between Richmond and Eugene, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants organization this year. Over his last nine games since August 15, Wyatt is batting .303 (10-for-33) with two homers, four doubles, two walks and eight RBIs. He has four multi-hit games in his last 10 games played.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glownke is has picked up seven hits and five RBIs in his last three games, batting .637 (7-for-11) with two homers, a double and two walks. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the season, Glowenke is batting .315 (28-for-89) in road games, including all six of his Double-A homers. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .302 (35-for-116) with six homers and 25 RBIs in 35 games.

PRDSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28), Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).

THIS DATE IN SOUIRRELS HISTORY


