## TEERING OFF

- **LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Having dropped five straight for just the second time this year, Augusta turns to Jeremy Reyes to continue his late-season run of strong starts.
- **I FALL APART:** The Jackets have lost 8 of their last 9 games, despite having a lead in 6 of 8 losses. Holding an advantage late has been an uphill battle for this remodeled bullpen late in the year.
- **RANK 'EM:** Six players from MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Braves Prospects are currently on Augusta's roster, as of the midseason update. The highest regarded is #1 prospect LHP Cam Caminiti, along with INF Tate Southisene (#3), INF John Gil (#14), OF Luis Guanipa (#21), RHP Ethan Bagwell (#28), and RHP Rayven Antonio (#29).
- **GO JOHNNY GO:** Infielder John Gil has lit up the box score as of late, hitting .346 with a 1.023 OPS in the month of August, including four home runs over 19 games.
- **G.I. JOE:** Joe Olsavsky is 18-50 (.360) in his last 15 starts, currently riding a career-high 11-game on-base streak. Olsavsky's on-base percentage is nearly .500 this month, as he forces his way into the lineup and provides quality at bats for the Jackets.
- **ALL NATURAL GAINS, BOYS:** After a league-worst 49-80 record last year where Augusta set organizational lows in a number of offensive categories, Wynston Sawyer's squad has improved dramatically this year. The Jackets eclipsed last year's win total on July 31st, and numbers are up across the board on both sides of the ball.
- **BRING EM HOME:** Augusta has seen its team average with runners in scoring position rise over the last few weeks, up to .240 after falling below .225 at the middle of July. The Jackets have fell back to Earth of late, hitting just 13-69 w/ RISP in the last 9 games.
- **STRONG START:** The Jackets' starting pitchers have been rock solid as of late, especially at home. Augusta's starters have allowed more than two earned runs just twice in the last 22 home games, continuously keeping the team in the game early.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Logan Forsythe makes his first professional start, matching up with Charleston native Trey Pooser as the latter continues his return from the IL.

**CAREER:** Signed by the Braves in January of 2023 out of Turmero, Venezuela... had incredibly short debut in 2023 with the DSL Braves, going 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA in just 8.2 innings across 5 appearances... struggled with command in 2023, improved in FCL in '24... was promoted to Augusta on June 7, made 4 starts and went 1-2 with a 3.00 ERA before a shoulder injury ended his season on July 2nd... placed on IL again in April 2025, missed about a month... high-powered fastball flirts with the upper 90s, learning to harness breaking pitches... addition of cutter in last two starts has led to uptick in command and better sequencing to hitters of both sides... career high 10 Ks in 6.2 innings w/o an earned run 8/15 @ Kannapolis

Nina was previously with the FCL Braves for the last two seasons, also as pitching coach, and served in the same role for Augusta in 2021. A native of San Cristobal, Nina played collegiately at both Northeastern Oklahoma A&M and Oklahoma State before being drafted in the 17th Rd of the 1997 Draft by the Oakland Athletics. Nina played 9 seasons in the minors across 5 organizations, while also seeing time in the Chinese Professional League, the Mexican League, and the Atlantic League. The righty began his coaching career with the Helena Brewers from 2009-2013, and also coached in the Pirates' system.

## GARRETT WILKINSON

## CO-HITTING COACH

One of two newcomers working with the hitters in 2025, this year marks a homecoming of sorts for Wilkinson, who returns not only to the team where he began his coaching career, but also the area he grew up in. The Evans, GA native starred at Evans HS before a lengthy collegiate career that spanned time at East Georgia State College, Gordon State College, Florida A&M, and Mercer University. He began his coaching career with a video and hitting analytics role for the 'Jackets in 2021, followed by stops with the FCL Braves, Rome Braves, and Mississippi Braves, the last two of which he was the hitting coach.

## RUBEN GOTAY

## CO-HITTING COACH

Joining Wilkinson to work with the hitters, Ruben Gotay begins his first year as a coach in the Braves organization, having spent last year coaching in the Mexican League with the Caliente de Durango. Gotay brings a wealth of additional experience coaching in MiLB, having spent 2023 with the Indianapolis Indians, 2021-22 with the Greensboro Grasshoppers, and 2018-19 with the Clearwater Threshers. The Puerto Rican product played professionally for 17 seasons, including parts of four years in the majors with the Royals, Mets, and Braves.

## BRAD STOLL

## COACH

2025 marks the first year coaching in professional baseball for Brad Stoll, who joins the Braves' system following nearly 20 years coaching at Lawrence High School in Kansas. During his time with the Chesty Lions, Stoll won a 6A State Championship in 2009 and saw two former players go on to play in Major League Baseball: Garrett Cleavinger and Bryce Montes de Oca. Stoll's additional experience lies in the Cape Cod League, where he was an assistant with the Falmouth Commodores from 2009-15 and again in 2024.
