NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Akron Rubber-Ducks, 9-5, on Thursday night at Canal Park. Rowdey Jordan homered for the third-straight game, with a two-run shot in the seventh. Omar De Los Santos and Nolan McLean also hit homers. Every hitter in the Ponies' lineup reached base. Brandon Sproat earned the win, after going six innings. Binghamton has taken each of the first three games this series.

JORDAN'S BRAND: Infielder Rowdey Jordan has homered in three-straight games with nine runs batted in over that span in this series, after drilling a two-run homer in the seventh on Thursday. Jordan is now tied for the second-most homers on the team with seven. In three games this series, Jordan has seven hits, three homers, nine runs batted in, and four runs scored, including a grand slam on Wednesday, along with three multi-hit and multi-RBI games. Jordan is riding an 11-game hitting streak, hitting .386 (17-for-44) with a .438 OBP, 1.142 OPS, four home runs, 13 RBIs, and 11 runs. He is the first player to hold at least a 10-game hitting streak for Binghamton this year. Jordan is red-hot, after he was in the midst of an 0-for-20 stretch in the six games before his 10-game hitting streak.

**CLIFFORD IS A MACHINE:** Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 75 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** drew a walk on Thursday and leads Minor League Baseball with 57 walks this season, across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton. He has now reached base in 19-straight games and in 24 of his last 25 games. Clifford has drawn a walk in 22 of his 30 games at the Double-A level. Over his 19-game on-base streak, Clifford has a .443 on-base percentage and a 1.110 OPS with six homers, six doubles, 16 runs batted in, 21 walks and 17 strikeouts. In 30 games in Double-A, Clifford has 18 hits, including 15 extra base hits (8 2B, 7 HR).

**SCHWARTZ THE FORCE:** First baseman **JT Schwartz** singled on Thursday to extend his hitting streak to seven games. He is hitting .385 (10-for-26) with a .467 OBP, a .967 OPS, three doubles, two runs batted in, four walks, and just one strikeout in that span. The former fourth-round pick has seven hits over his last four games and is also riding a 10-game on-base streak.

JACKSON #5: Infielder Jeremiah Jackson doubled on Wednesday to extend his hitting streak to six games. Over his six-game hitting streak, he is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a 1.080 OPS, two homers, three doubles, four RBIs, and three multi-hit games. Jackson has two doubles and a homer across the first two games in the series at Akron.

**LIGHTNING MCLEAN:** Mets No. 19 prospect **Nolan McLean** is slated to start on the mound for Binghamton tonight. McLean has a 16-to-3 strikeout-towalk ratio over 13.1 innings in his last three starts. He went a career-high 5.2 innings and threw a career-high 82 pitches in his last start on Saturday against Somerset. As a designated hitter, McLean belted his third home run of the season with a two-run opposite-field home run in the eighth inning on Thursday night. McLean has three homers as a hitter and holds a 25-to-5 strikeout to walk ratio on the mound at the Double-A level in 22.1 innings. The 22-year-old is averaging 10.07 K/9 with Binghamton.

-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

YEAR WITH BNG: 2nd YEAR WITH NYM: 3rd -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.


