Over the last few years, the Rocket City Trash Pandas have had the opportunity to work with many amazing non-profit organizations in the Northern Alabama community. While continuing to strengthen these relationships, we also hope to establish new ones. Listed below are some of the programs that will be available to non-profit organizations for the upcoming 2022 baseball season:

Community Spotlight – Organizations can be highlighted during each of the Trash Pandas' home games. A space is setup on the main concourse where non-profit organizations will be given the opportunity to promote their cause, recruit volunteers and raise awareness. \*Selling items or soliciting donations is prohibited. \*

Collection Drives – This program is designed to provide local nonprofits with resources that they may not have access to. The Trash Pandas will be hosting 4 collection drives for various items such as toys, canned food, toiletries, and school supplies during home games throughout the season.

**Dog Days** – The Trash Pandas will host 10 Dog Days throughout the summer, and animal related non-profits will be chosen to help with these furry friends in the ballpark. Each selected non-profit can set up a table and help collect entry fees. The organization will be able to keep the proceeds from their night.

Jersey Auctions – The Rocket City Trash Pandas will host 6 auctions throughout the 2022 season. Players will wear special jerseys, unique to each theme. They are then auctioned off immediately following the game. The proceeds from the auction are split between the benefactor and the Rocket City Trash Pandas Foundation. In order to become a benefactor, organizations must submit the application included in this packet **no later than March 25, 2022**.

**Concessions Fundraising**- BallCorps Food and Beverage, the provider of food and beverage at Toyota Field, is looking for enthusiastic and dedicated organizations wanting to help enhance the guest experience in our Concessions Department while also generating revenue to support their cause. This is an exciting and entertaining opportunity to fundraise using a captive audience and have fun at the same time!

To be considered for any of these programs, you must complete the enclosed request form for the program(s) you are interested in along with the information sheet and 501c3 determination letter. Requests will be granted on a first come, first serve basis. Any requests made without the appropriate forms will not be considered. You will be notified if your application is accepted.

### **Concessions Fundraising**

### **Eligibility of Participants**

- Volunteers must be at least 16 years old to fundraise.
- Groups must be at least 6 people and a maximum of 30, and volunteers must be available for 4-6 hours during a game.
- 21 and older can operate a cash register and serve alcohol.
- Commitment to work a set number of games, to be determined by a BallCorps Food and Beverage representative.

#### **General Terms**

- Must provide 501c3 IRS determination letter and W9.
- \$1,000,000 general liability insurance per occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate per year.
- Non-profit groups will be paid a competitive rate determined by the number of volunteers per event and the number of games committed to.
- Group volunteers will be needed for 4-6 hours per event.
- Volunteers are expected to follow the food and beverage dress code (khaki pants/shorts, closed-toe shoes). No jeans or leggings.
- Groups can coordinate some aspects of their uniform. For example, all group members can wear shirts and caps emblazoned with their organization's name and logos. These will need to be approved by a Ballcorps Food and Beverage representative.
- Duties include taking customer orders, handling cash, processing payments, and serving food to the customer. Stand/location set-up and clean up are also part of the event duties.
- Pre-season training will be provided prior to scheduled shift.
- Alcohol training (Responsible Vendor) is required for all volunteers over 21 that will be serving alcohol.
- Willingness to give great customer service and create memorable experiences for our fans.
