JUMBO SHRIMP DROP 7-6 NAILBITER IN DURHAM

Peyton Burdick doubled, homered, drove in two and matched a career-high with four runs scored on Thursday, but Jacksonville fell 7-6 in a seesaw battle with Durham. Thanks to Burdick's RBI double in a two-run first and homer in the third, the Jumbo Shrimp jumped out to a 3-0 lead. However, the Bulls scored two in the third and three in the fourth to grab the lead. Nick Fortes doubled in a run in the fifth and Charles Leblanc tied the score in the seventh with a sacrifice fly. After Durham regained the lead in the bottom of the seventh. Erik González's RBI double knotted things at sixth in the eighth. The Bulls scratched out another tally in the bottom of the eighth to win 7-6.

RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp rank sixth in the International League in runs per game at 5.1 runs per game, accomplishing that feat despite ranking in the middle of the pack of the circuit in most offensive categories.. The biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting just .217/.316/.343, producing a .659 OPS that ranks 15th in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .268/.335/.472, with the resulting .807 OPS placing fourth in the circuit. Perhaps the club's true talent level is somewhere in the middle of these two ends; Jumbo Shrimp hitters have totaled a .279 BABIP with the bases empty but .320 with runners on base. Both figures are far from the baseball-wide .300 batting average on balls in play.

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 11-for-36 to begin the campaign, slashing .303/.350/.500/.850 with a double, two home runs, nine RBIs and five runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, is 10-for-his-first-33, compiling a batting line of .303/.425/.606/1.031 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and 13 runs. Thus, of the 46 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks sixth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 28 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs by the pair), a ratio of 60.9 percent.

AND ISN'T IT IRONIC, DON'T YOU THINK?

Despite getting outscored during the 2021 season, the Jumbo Shrimp finished with a 75-55 (.577) record in large part due to the club's success in close games. Jacksonville went a whopping 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the second-best record in the league in contests determined by those slim margins, including a 27-18 (.600) mark in one-run affairs. Thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have been unable to equalize their success in narrowly-decided contests in 2022, with the club posting an 0-3 record in one-run games thus far.

LEBLANC OF THE BALL

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Charles Leblanc walked three times in Thursday's loss to Durham, continuing his sizzling start to the season. The native of Laval, QC in Canada is 10-for-23 (.435) to begin the season. Of those 10 hits, five have gone for extra bases with his three doubles and two home runs. Leblanc leads the International League in slugging (.826) and OPS (1.359) while ranking in a tie for first in batting average. He has reached base in 16 of his 30 plate appearances to place fourth in on-base percentage (.533).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 10 home runs thus far, tied for eighth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

SHRIMP SKEWERS

Jacksonville outfielder Peyton Burdick matched a careerhigh on Thursday with four runs scored. With a leagueleading 13 runs on the season, he has totaled more than a quarter of the Jumbo Shrimp's 46 tallies... Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded at least five runs in four consecutive games entering play on Friday. They have ceded four or more runs in six of the club's last seven games... The Jumbo Shrimp have gone four games in a row without an error, totaling 29 straight miscue-free innings.

ABOUT JORDAN

-Selected by the Marlins in the 20th round of the 2017 draft, Holloway opted to sign with Miami for a reported \$400,000 to forgo a commitment to play college baseball at the University of

-Holloway underwent Tommy John Surgery in June of 2017. During his rehabilitation, he lived with fellow Marlins prospect Braxton Garrett, who had the procedure done during the same

-Marlins prospect Matt Givin, who also required Tommy John Surgery after suffering a torn UCL, credits Holloway for taking him "under his wing" during the recovery process.

2022 SEASON

2021 SEASON

-Holloway began the season in the Marlins' bullpen but transitioned into a starting role on May 10 at Arizona. In that game, his first major league start, he ceded four runs, three earned, on five hits in 3.2 innings to suffer the loss. He started again five days later at the Dodgers, and yielded two runs on three hits in 3.0 innings, again being charged with the loss. All told, Holloway's numbers as a starter with Miami are 0-2 with a 10.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 14 H. 16 R. 14 ER. 16 BB. 12 K).

-As a reliever in the majors, Holloway did not allow a run in any of his six appearances, surrendering only four hits and three walks against 11 strikeouts in 11.0 frames. Opponents were batting just .108 against him. In nine overall appearances, he is 2-1 with a 0.75 ERA (24.0 IP, 9 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 10 BB, 24 K).

2020 SEASON

-Holloway made his major league debut on July 26, 2020 at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia when the Marlins played at the Phillies. He pitched just one-third of an inning, but was not charged with a run despite allowing two hits and one walk.

2019 SEASON

-In 10 starts before the All-Star Break, Holloway went 2-3 with a 2.62 ERA. He yielded just 25 hits in 44.2 innings, strikiing out 51 against 30 walks. However, in 11 starts after the All-Star Break, Holloway was just 2-8 with a 6.08 ERA. He surrendered 52 hits in 50.1 innings, fanning just 42 against 36 walks.

-Holloway held right-handed hitters to a .630 OPS in 218 plate appearances. Lefties posted a .705 mark against him in 204 plate appearances.

2018 SEASON

-Holloway's first outing since undergoing Tommy John Surgery in June of 2017 came on June 21, 2018, when pitching for the GCL Marlins against the GCL Astros. He went two-thirds of an inning, but then did not appear in a game until August 17.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Ralston Valley High School (Colo.), Holloway went 6-1 with a 2.60 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 43.0 innings to earn a spot on the Denver Post All-Colorado team..
