LAST TIME OUT: Rocket City got a two-hit performance from Mitch Nay and three big insurance runs in the seventh inning to defeat Tennessee 6-3 on Thursday night. The Trash Pandas scored three in the first on a two-run single from Nay. He advanced to third on a single from Izzy Wilson, then scored after Wilson got caught in a rundown between first and second on a pickoff attempt to give the Trash Pandas a 3-0 lead. The Smokies responded with two in the third, however Rocket City put the game away with an RBI single from Michael Cruz in the seventh, which was followed by a two-run moonshot by Ray-Patrick Didder to make the score 6-2. Cruz also picked off Zach Davis of the Smokies at third base in the top of the inning when he represented the tying run. Tennessee added an unearned run in the eighth for the final margin. Getting the win for the Trash Pandas was starting pitcher Jhonathan Diaz after he allowed two runs on four hits and struck out eight in five frames. The duo of Ryan Clark and Oliver Ortega limited the Smokies to an unearned run on five hits over four innings with seven strikeouts. Everyone in the Rocket City lineup had at least one hit with Nay leading the way by going 2-4 with a single, double, two RBI and a run scored. There were 29 strikeouts in the game with Trash Pandas hurlers registering 15 of them.

GETTING K'S: The pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 702 batters through the first 66 games. That is good enough for first in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 19, which happened on 6/26 against Chattanooga when former starting pitcher Reid Detmers set a new season-high for Rocket City pitchers with 16Ks followed by reliever Ryan Clark who punched out three more Lookouts. Twice the Trash Pandas have struck out 16 batters. First on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. The also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5, then 15 more on 7/22 against Tennessee. Detmers leads the way with 97K's after his 16-strikeout performance. He and closer Oliver Ortega combined to strike out 15 Biloxi batters in the seven-inning game as Ortega tossed a 1-2-3 seventh for the save with one strikeout. The Trash Pandas also struck out 14 Birmingham hitters on 7/16 and appeared to be well on their way to setting a new season-high before rain shortened the game to seven innings.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City moniker by launching 102 homers, which is tops in all of AA. 12 of those dingers came in the first Tennessee series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Another 12 came in the series against Montgomery (7/6-7/10) with six provided by infielder Luis Aviles Jr. Rightfielder Izzy Wilson and third baseman Mitch Nay lead the way with 15 dingers, which is tied for a four-way league lead. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Designated hitter Ibandel Isabel and outfielder Orlando Martinez are tied for eighth with 11. Rocket City became the first AA team to hit 100 homers in 2021 on 7/21 when Brendon Davis slung a solo-homer over the elevator shaft in left field in the seventh inning.

TEEING OFF ON TENNESSEE: Of the 102 homeruns hit by Rocket City this season, 62 have come against the state of Tennessee. The Trash Pandas have 36 homers this season against the Smokies, the most against any team.

PANDAS POUNCE AT HOME: Toyota Field has become quite the launching pad for the Trash Pandas. Of the 102 homers hit on season, Rocket City has blasted 59 of them at home. After hitting 12 in the first series against Tennessee, the Trash Pandas hit 18 dingers during an 11-game homestand against Chattanooga and Birmingham. In fact, the home team had at least one homer in 10 of the 11 games. Rocket City has tied the 12-homer mark with a dozen in the series against Montgomery, six by Luis Aviles Jr.

DETMERS DONE: The Trash Pandas highest-rated prospect Reid Detmers is moving on from Rocket City. On 7/22, the south-paw was promoted to AAA Salt Lake after going 2-4 with a 3.50 ERA in 12 starts. He struck out 97 in 54 innings of work. Those 97 Ks were a league lead and second for all of AA at the time of his promotion.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Making his AA debut tonight for the Trash Pandas will be RHP Cristopher Molina. Called up to AA on 7/22 from High-A Tri-City, Molina went 4-2 with a 3.27 ERA in 19 appearances and two starts with the Dust Devils. He also saved two games while striking out 59 in 52.1 frames with a .253 opponents' batting average. Signed by the Angels in 2014 as an international free-agent, Molina has a career 18-30 record and 4.67 ERA. Opponents are batting .253 against him and he has 437 strikeouts in 439.1 innings pitched.

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds. More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far

- the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021


Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE MOLINA FILE: RHP Cristopher Molina will make his Double-A debut for Rocket City tonight after a promotion from High-A Tri-City on July 22. He has spent his entire career with the Los Angeles Angels organization after signing as an international free agent in 2013. Molina went 4-2 with a 3.27 ERA in 19 games (two starts) for Tri-City. He also recorded two saves in relief while striking out 59 over 52.1 innings. His longest outing came on July 10 vs. Hillsboro, when he earned the win in his second start of the season after giving up two earned runs on seven hits with two walks and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings. For Tri-City, he was 4-0 with a 1.76 ERA (6 ER/30.2 IP) over 11 home outings and 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (13 ER/21.2 IP) in eight road appearances.

VS. TENNESSEE: Making his Double-A debut, Molina will face the Smokies for the first time in his career tonight at Toyota Field.

MORE NOTES

<u>ALL-STAR</u>: In 2019, Molina was named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star for Class-A Burlington after going 3-5 with a 2.69 ERA (19 ER/63.2 IP) along with 23 walks and 65 strikeouts in the first half of the season for the Bees. After the All-Star Game, he was promoted to High-A Inland Empire and finished the season with the 66ers.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: On August 26, 2018, Molina was named Pioneer League Pitcher of the Week for Rookie-Level Orem after earning the win with 5.0 scoreless innings with one hit against, no walks, and six strikeouts at Helena on August 21. The award is the only weekly honor of his career to date.
