Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series at the South Bend Cubs. High-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs. These are the only six meetings between the two teams this season. Today is the 11th game and 12th day of the Lugnuts' 12-game, 13-day road trip, wrapping up the 2022 road schedule.

Starting Matchup: 2021 third-rounder Mason Miller, the No. 21 prospect in the Oakland Athletics' system, makes his second Lugnuts start, taking on right-hander Richard Gallardo in his sixth start for South Bend.

(Adam Jaksa was in Stillwater, Okla., watching the Central Michigan Chippewas battle gamely in a 58-42 loss to the OSU Cowboys.)

Last Night: Cubs 2, Lugnuts 1. 19-year-old shortstop Kevin Made lined a two-run homer in the fifth inning and that proved enough for South Bend to hand the Lugnuts a fourth straight defeat. The game was played in one hour and 59 minutes.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap up the series with the Cubs tomorrow, followed by a six-game homestand with the Dragons at Jackson Field to end the 132-game Midwest League season.

With a Win Today... the Lugnuts would notch their 1800th win as a franchise and halt a five-game losing streak. That would be nice.

Today's Transaction: Pitcher Shohei Tomioka was reinstated from the Covid IL.

Nailbiters: 12 out of the last 16 Lugnuts' road games have been decided by two runs or fewer, including the first four games of this series; Lansing has a record of 7-5 in those games, 0-4 at South Bend.

High Quality: Each of the last two nights has featured a Lugnuts quality start, with Joey Estes tossing six innings and allowing two runs on Thursday and Kyle Virbitsky following up yesterday with an identical two runs allowed over six innings. For each pitcher, it was his second quality start on this road trip and his third quality start of the year with Lansing. The Nuts have had 10 different pitchers record quality starts this season.

#### **Organizational Report:**

- At the Major League level, the Athletics lost to the Orioles, 5-2, though Norge Ruiz (2021 Lugnut) tossed 2/3 scoreless innings.
- In Triple-A, the Aviators beat the Aces, 5-2, with a debuting Jake Walkinshaw (2022 Lugnut up until a few days ago) recording a four-inning save, allowing two runs (one earned) on two hits in four innings.
- In Double-A, the RockHounds beat the Travelers, 2-1, thanks to eight brilliant shutout innings from Jack Cushing (2021), allowing five hits and one walk on 95 pitches. The Travs had scored 38 runs in the prior two games.
- In Single-A, the Ports lost to the Giants, 13-5. Future Lugnut Junior Perez homered in the loss.

- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall

To the Show: Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018), catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019) and pitcher Max Castillo (2018); M's reliever Danny Young (2016); Red Sox pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) and Marlins pitcher Jake Fishman (2017).

Skipper for the Series: When Phil Pohl went on scheduled vacation from August 16-21 vs. Great Lakes; Veronica Alvarez stepped in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Athletics. Alvarez went 2-4 with the Nuts against the Loons.

Inside the Park and Out of This World: On August 2-3, 2022, CF Denzel Clarke joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

#### **Today in Lugnuts History**

2016: All-Star first baseman Juan Kelly reached base in all five appearances to extend his on-base streak to 34 games: HBP in the 1st, BB in the 4th, 1B/R in the 6th, 1B/R in the 7th, and 2B in the 8th. Justin Maese combined with two relievers on a two-hit shutout in a 6-0 win at Classic Park over Lake County. Maese struck out seven in 5 2/3 innings, allowing two singles, and Kirby Snead and Geno Encina combined for 3 1/3 perfect innings of relief. Secretly, both Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., joined the Lugnuts on the road in Lake County, taking batting practice with the team in preparation of the Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance on September 6th.

Welcome to the Lugnuts! Miller began the season on the Lugnuts' 60-man Injured List with the expectation that he might be ready sometime in May... as it turned out, he rehabbed with one appearance in the Arizona Complex League on August 23, impressing by touching 102 mph while striking out five in two perfect innings against the Cubs, and was sent right up to Lansing on August 25... in his first MWL appearance, he allowed a leadoff home run to Ben Metzinger on a 100-mph fastball before overwhelming the next six batters, recording four strikeouts.

**Highly Regarded:** MLB Pipeline ranks Miller the No. 21 prospect in the A's organization and the No. 7 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 70, Slider 50, Changeup 45, Control 50, Overall 45... his scouting report: "Miller is a power arm that can light up the radar gun as high as 100 mph and also holds what at times can show up as a wipeout slider. His mid-80s changeup has shown promise but needs to develop more consistency in order to solidify his pitch arsenal. Miller has a big league arm that can throw a ton of strikes. The question is what role awaits him. The A's could choose the long route to build him out as a starter or fast track him in a bullpen role. His big body suggests a starting role could suit him well, even if it means slightly decreased velocity, but that would only come if he can fully develop the changeup as his third pitch."

**Quoting Keith Law for The Athletic (placing Miller at No. 14):** "Miller was touching 97 and sitting 94-95 from his 6-5 frame, and the A's had him close to 100 mph after he signed. He needs to tighten up his slider and could move quickly in a relief role. If not, at least he got his MBA."

The Fangraphs' Skinny (placing Miller at No. 16): "His age (nearly 23 on draft day) and mechanical violence pushed him squarely into the relief bucket as a draft prospect, but Miller's velocity (up to at least 98 at G-W) made him an early Day 2 selection anyway. He dominated the Complex Level for a handful of innings then came out during instructs sitting 97-99 with two viable breaking balls: a plus mid-80s slider and a fringe low-80s curveball. The latter can be used as a change-of-pace pitch, dumped in for strike one, while the slider has nasty bite and could be a bat-missing weapon at peak. Miller's delivery (violent, low-ish slot) creates tailing action on his fastball and he's apt to break a lot of bats, but might not miss as many as you'd guess given his velocity. He projects as a fast-moving reliever with a shot to be a late-inning arm."

A Remarkable Turnaround: Quoting Pipeline, "Miller's path to the professional ranks is truly inspirational. Battling Type 1 juvenile diabetes he was diagnosed with in 2018 and weighing around 150 pounds, he worked hard to transform his body. Discovering the right diet and strength program, he bulked up to 220 pounds and transferred from Waynesburg to Gardner-Webb University." Miller had been an ineffective pitcher at D-III Waynesburg, with an ERA over 7.00. But then came the word about his medical condition. He told WBTV, "Not an incredibly common diagnosis especially at my age. It's usually a childhood diagnosis. So I sat there asking myself, why me?" Following his work and drastic change, he saw immediate results on the mound. "I went to a (Pittsburgh) Pirates work out and afterwards they told me I was 92 to 94 MPH. I was like 'holy cow!' I was throwing mid 80s less than a year ago and now, it's coming out like that." With the jump in pitching effectiveness, he took his grad transfer year and pursuit of his MBA to Gardner-Webb University. "I wasn't [going to have a chance at pitching pro baseball] until this past year and I think it's invigorating to know that I have that chance now," he said to WBTV. "I have that fire inside of me where somebody else might be burning a little dim. Mine's is as strong as it has ever been."

**Gardner-Webb...** or **Webb-Gardner?** Gardner-Webb University was named in honor of North Carolina Governor O. Max Gardner and his wife Fay Webb-Gardner on June 15, 1942, honoring the work that the couple was doing for the institution... at the time, it was a Junior College, ascending to College in December 1971, and then to University status in January 1993... the university's sports teams are known as the Runnin' Bulldogs.

(Runnin') Bulldog on the Mound: Miller excelled in his only season, 2021, at Gardner-Webb. He was named 2021 Big South All-Conference First Team after going 8-1 with a 3.30 ERA in 92 2/3 innings, striking out a school record and conference-leading 121 strikeouts and posting a school record .210 batting average allowed.
