<u>TODAY'S GAME:</u> The Mississippi Braves and Montgomery Biscuits begin a six-game series tonight at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves are on a seven-game winning streak, and will have a day off on Tuesday. This is the second of four series between the two teams in 2024 and the seventh of 12 overall meetings. The two will play next at Trustmark Park, June 25-30.

HOW SWEEP IT IS: The M-Braves finished a six-game sweep of the Chattanooga Lookouts on Sunday with a 6-5 victory at AT&T Field. Cade Bunnell went 3-for-4 with two doubles, three runs, and an RBI in the win. Mississippi erased a 3-0 deficit and used a four-run sixth inning to spur a comeback. Bunnel scored the winning run after a double and two Chattanooga errors in the eighth.

<u>ABOUT THE SERIES SWEEP:</u> The six-game sweep was the second by an M-Braves team, and first since a six-game sweep of Rocket City July 12-17, 2022. The M-Braves scored 39 runs over the six games with no home runs but 18 doubles, one triple, a 299 batting average, and a 371 OBP. **Nacho Alvarez** hit .370 (10x27) with a double, two RBI, four runs, walk, and three steals ... **Cal Conley** hit .368 (7x19) with four doubles, six RBI, two walks, and three runs ... **Tyler Tolve** hit .300 (6x20), three doubles, six RBI, and four runs ... **Drake Baldwin** hit .292 (7x24) with a double, RBI, and four runs ... **Keshawn Ogans** hit .286 (6x21) with two doubles, six RBI, three runs, and a walk. The pitching staff went 6-0 with **Hurston Waldrep** and **Spencer Schwellenbach** combining for 13.1 shutout innings, 16 strikeouts to one walk.

<u>MAY BE A SEASON TURNING AROUND:</u> After going 7-15 in April, the M-Braves are 15-8 so far in May, and on a season-high seven game winning streak. The M-Braves are 11-2 over their last 13 games and are in third place in the Southern League's South Division, three out of first place. The 15 wins are T-3rd-most in Double-A this month.

<u>WINNING STREAK:</u> The current seven-game winning streak is the longest for the M-Braves since winning seven straight July 12-22 vs. Rocket City and Montgomery. The M-Braves matched a club record with an eight-game winning streak, August 6-14, 2021 vs. Birmingham and Biloxi.

MC HAMMER WOULD BE PLEASED: Mississippi hurlers rank 3rd in the Southern League, 6th in Double-A, and 9th in minor league baseball with a 3.36 ERA as a staff. The staff is 6th in Double-A with 423 strikeouts. In May, the M-Braves rank 4th in Double-A with a 3.15 ERA. In 18 home games, the Mississippi pitching staff has a 2.47 ERA.

HIS FIRST TWO DOUBLE-A STARTS WENT SCHWELL: Atlanta Braves No. 3 overall prospect Spencer Schwellenbach was promoted to Mississippi on May 14 from High-A Rome. Over his first two starts, the 2nd-round pick in 2021 out of Nebraska is 2-0 and hasn't allowed a run over 13.0 innings, striking out 17 and walking just two. He made his Mississippi debut in game two of the May 15 doubleheader against Biloxi, striking out a career-high nine punchouts over 6.0 shutout innings on three hits, issuing just one walk. In his second start on May 22 at Chattanooga, striking out eight and walking none, ceding two hits over 7.0 shutout innings. In eight starts between Mississippi and Rome, Schwellebach is 4-1 with a 1.80 ERA (9 ER/45.0 IP), 10 walks, and 51 strikeouts.

<u>WINNING WALDREP:</u> RHP **Hurston Waldrep**, the Atlanta Braves' 1st-round pick in 2023 (24th overall), has won three straight starts and earned his first professional win on May 2. He is 3-0 with a 0.71 ERA in May, with 24 strikeouts to five walks. Waldrep tossed a Southern League-high second complete game in a doubleheader in game one on May 15 vs. Biloxi with a career-high 8.0 innings, scattering six hits, one run with no walks, and eight strikeouts. ... In his last two starts, Waldrep has given up one run over 14.1 innings with one walk to 16 strikeouts. Over his past six outings, he has a 0.96 ERA in 37.1 innings pitched, 10 walks, and 34 strikeouts. Waldrep now ranks among the league leaders in complete games (1st, 2), ERA (2.84, 12th), strikeouts (41, 11th), and innings pitched (8th, 44.1).

MEJIA TOSSES FIFTH NO HITTER IN M-BRAVES HISTORY: RHP Ian Mejia's seven-inning no-hitter in game two of the Friday, May 17 doubleheader vs. Biloxi was the fifth no-hitter in M-Braves history, and first individual one since Tommy Hanson's nine-inning no hitter on June 25, 2008 vs. Birmingham at Trustmark Park. The M-Braves beat the Barons 6-0, and Hanson walked three and struck out 14 in the game. There have been three combined nine-inning no-hitters in team history (Julio Teheran & Tyrelle Harris, 8/2/10 vs. Mobile, lan Anderson & Jeremy Walker, 6/28/19 vs. Jackson (TN), and Bryce Elder & Daysbel Hernandez, 7/10/21 vs. Pensacola.

<u>THE MEJIA MAGIC:</u> When lan Mejia took the mound, the Mississippi Braves were 7-1 in his eight starts. The Braves promoted Mejia to Triple-A Gwinnett on Thursday. Mississippi's opening-day starter is second in the league and ranked T-5th in Double-A with 54 strikeouts. Mejia ranked among the league and Double-A leaders in ERA (1.69, 2nd SL, 4th AA) in innings pitched (42.2 IP, 12th SL), wins (4, T-5th SL), BAA (.160, 1st SL, 3rd, AA), and WHIP (0.94, 5th, SL, 9th AA) ... Mejia did not allow a run over his last 22.2 innings pitched. Mejia was 3-0 in May and allowed no runs over 19.2 IP, five walks. and 27 strikeouts.

<u>HAYDEN HARRIS ON A ROLL:</u> LHP **Hayden Harris** has a 0.62 ERA over 12 relief outings and 14.1 IP, five walks, and 24 strikeouts. The Augusta, GA native is 1-0 with four holds and 1-for-1 in save opportunities. Over the last two seasons Harris's 37.5% strikeout rate ranks fourth in minor league baseball (min 70 IP).

<u>NEED FOR SPEED:</u> The M-Braves are T-2nd in Double-A behind Birmingham in stolen bases with 84 (84-for-98) through 45 games. The club has five players who have reached double-digit steals. **Geraldo Quintero** leads the way and ranks 5th in the league with 17. **Justin Dean** and **Nacho Alvarez** rank 6th with 16, and **Cody Milligan** is T-9th with 15. **Cal Conley** has 12 ... The M-Braves logged a stolen base in each of the first 14 games of the season. Mississippi had 157 stolen bases last season and is on pace for 258 (1.9 per game) in 2024. The most by an M-Braves team was 159 in 2007.

"NACHO" AVERAGE SHORT STOP: Atlanta's top-ranked position player prospect, Nacho Alvarez Jr., went on a 13game on-base streak from April 13 to May 1, the longest by a Mississippi player this season. The 21-year-old leads the club and ranks 4th in the Southern League with a .388 OBP ... He also ranks among the league leaders in walks (T-3rd, 24), steals (T-7th, 15), and hits (T-8th, 42).

**QUINTERO LLEGANDO A LA BASE:** Geraldo Quintero has reached base safely in 10-straight games, posting a .432 OBP during the streak, which began on May 15.

<u>GIVE ME FIVE</u>: The M-Braves are 17-11 in games when starters go 5+ innings and 5-12 when going less than 5. In the 28 games with 5+ innings, they have combined for a 2.05 ERA (38 ER/166.2 IP). In the 17 games of less than 5, the starter's ERA is 6.72 (48 ER/64.1 IP).

<u>TOP PROSPECTS:</u> According to MLB Pipeline, the M-Braves have six of Atlanta's Top 30 prospects. RHP **Hurston Waldrep** (No. 2), RHP **Spencer Schwellenbach** (No.3), SS **Nacho Alvarez Jr.** (No. 6), C **Drake Baldwin** (No. 11), LHP **Luis De Avila** (No. 20), and INF/OF **Geraldo Quintero** (No. 28) are included. In Baseball America's Top 30, OF **Cody Milligan** (No. 27), RHP **Ian Mejia** (No. 28), and INF **Keshawn Ogans** (No. 30) are included.



### ATLANTA'S NO. 2 PROSPECT (MLB), NO. 2 PROSPECT (BA)

#### **TODAY'S GAME**

- Atlanta's first round selection in 2023, Hurston Waldrep makes his ninth start of 2024, and 17th of his career in the series opener. This is Waldrep's 10th Double-A start, making three for the M-Braves in 2023.
- Waldrep is 3-0 with a 0.71 ERA in May, five walks, and 24 strikeouts over 25.1 innings.

#### LAST TIME OUT

 Waldrep notched his second-straight win, and third in May last Tuesday in the 5-3 series-opening win in Chattanooga. Over 6.1 scoreless innings, he gave up four hits with one walk, and eight strikeouts.

#### **VS. MONTGOMERY**

 This is Waldrep's second start against the Biscuits, taking a no-decision on April 26 at Riverwalk Stadium in the 3-2 loss. Waldrep gave up one run on three hits with four walks, and five strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

#### **2024 NOTES**

- Tossed 6+ innings, and was credited with a complete game on 4/20 at BIR in G1 of a doubleheader (6 IP/1 ER/8 H/1 BB/5 SO).
- Earned his first professional win in his 13th career start on 5/2 vs. Pensacola (5.2 IP/0 ER/4 H/1 BB/5 SO).
- Set a new career-high with 8.0 innings pitched, and logged his second complete game in a double-header in game one of the 5/15 twin bill vs. Biloxi. (8.0 IP/1 ER/6 H/O BB/8 SO)

#### **2024 SPRING TRAINING**

 Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings over two appearances for Atlanta in Spring Training, striking out five, and walking four.

#### **2023 NOTES**

- Cruised through four levels of the Braves organization during his professional debut ... Made eight starts in total, ranging from 3.0 to 4.2 innings.
- Assigned to Augusta on August 2 ... Transferred to Rome on August 8, to Mississippi on August 29, and to Gwinnett on September 23.
- Made his first start with Class-A Augusta on August 5 vs. Columbia (ND, 3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 SO in 5-4 win) ... Notched his season-high for innings (4.2) and strikeouts (10) in the same outing, August 26 with High-A Rome vs. Greensboro (3 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 0 BB in 4-2 win).
- In three starts for the M-Braves, posted a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP), seven walks, 11 strikeouts, and held opponents to a .216 batting average. Waldrep had a solid showing in his first crack at Double-A, striking out four batters across three scoreless innings on September 2 against Rocket City at Trustmark Park.
- Joined the Stripers for one start, September 23 vs. Durham ... Tossed 4.1 scoreless innings (4 H, 3 BB, 5 SO) to lead a combined six-hitter in a 2-0 victory.
- In making his Triple-A debut in just his eighth pro outing, it marked the first time a Braves player had reached Gwinnett in the same year he was drafted
