SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

<u>DESTROYING THE RECORD BOOKS [PT. 1]</u>: **C/1B Wes Clarke** lined an RBI to single to right on Friday, bringing home the Shuckers' 665th run of the year, breaking the single-season franchise record, set at 664 during the 2022 season... 2023 marks the second straight season with 600+ runs.

The Shuckers are on pace for 741 runs, which would break the record for the most runs scored by a Brewers' Double-A affiliate since 2005... The previous record was set by the 2008 Huntsville Stars with 733 runs... The Brewers' all-time Double-A record is 953 runs, set by the 1983 El Paso Diablos of the Texas League.

<u>DESTROYING THE RECORD BOOKS [PT. 2]</u>: RHP Max Lazar recorded the Shuckers' 1,236th strikeout of the year in the ninth inning on Friday, setting a new single-season franchise record... Biloxi ranks sixth among all Double-A teams in strikeouts and third in the Southern League.

<u>CRUISIN' FOR 200</u>: The Shuckers enter today with 199 stolen bases in 2023, one away from becoming the ninth Southern League team since 1980 to reach 200 in a season... Since 1980, the eight teams to reach 200 are the Montgomery Biscuits in 2022 (203) and 2019 (213), the Birmingham Barons in 2002 (220) and 1989 (264), the 2000 Carolina Mudcats (209), the 1994 Knoxville Smokies (203), the 1983 Savannah Braves (203) and the 1981 Nashville Sounds (205).

FOR THE FIRST TIME: RHP Max Lazar picked up his fifth career save on Friday and his first at the Double-A level... Since being promoted to Double-A on June 30, Lazar has a 2.82 ERA in 14 appearances and 22.1 innings... In 10 of Lazar's 13 relief appearances have been scoreless, a 2.18 ERA.

WELCOME TO HISTORY, KID: With a two-run home run on Thursday, OF Jackson Chourio became the first teenager with at least 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season between Double-A and/or Triple-A since OF Delmon Young in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB)... Chourio also set a new career-high with his 21st home run of the year on Friday.

- Chourio also became the third teenager in Double-A/Triple-A to reach 20 home runs in a year since 2005, joining OF Delmon Young (2005, MTG) and 1B Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2018, NH/BUF).
- With the home run, Chourio became the fifth player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to hit at least 20 in a season... He joins OF Corey Ray (27, 2018), C/OF Jakson Reetz (22, 2022), INF Cam Devanney (20, 2022) and teammate C/1B Wes Clarke (22, 2022),

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would make the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division.

The Shuckers are tied with the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with 14 games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... The Shuckers own the second-half head-to-head tiebreaker with the Biscuits... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS (5-10, 7.00)</u>: RHP Christian Mejias makes his 23rd start of the year and his third start against the Smokies... In his last start, Mejias worked into the sixth inning for the first time since July 20 at Montgomery, going 5.1 innings against Pensacola... Over his last seven starts, the Shuckers have won five, including a 14-7 win over the Smokies in the series finale at MGM Park.
