Quad Cities River Bandits (10-15, 42-49)

Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the second game in a six-game series against the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. These are the Nuts' first games at Modern Woodmen Park since July 19-21, 2017, when the River Bandits took two of three games (winning 20-3 via six home runs and 14-3 via scoring in each of the first seven innings to bookend a Lugnuts 3-2 victory). In 2019, Quad Cities hosted Lansing at the University of Iowa due to the Mississippi River flooding the area.

Yesterday: River Bandits 3, Lugnuts 1. In front of 2,293, Mason Barnett allowed six singles in the first three innings before settling in to strike out the final seven batters he faced, totaling 10 strikeouts in five innings, and Cayden Wallace delivered RBI singles in the third and fifth innings to lift Quad Cities to the series-opening victory. The Lugnuts' only run came via Colby Thomas in the ninth inning, who singled, moved to second on a groundout, stole third, and scored on a groundout.

On the Air: Kyle Kercheval delivers the call on Bally Live and MiLB TV, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler delivering an audio-only call via StreamGuys.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits wrap things up Sunday, and then the Nuts continue this 12-game road trip to Cedar Rapids for a six-game series next week.

Among the Midwest League Leaders: Mac Lardner is tied for 2nd in wins (6); Daniel Susac is 5th in hits (86), 4th in batting average (.295) and tied for 5th in triples (5); and Junior Pérez is tied for 4th in stolen bases (27).

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense turned another double play last night thanks to an outfield assist from Danny Bautista, Jr. and now leads the league with 84 total double plays, achieved in 90 games. That's nine more than second-place South Bend and and 41 more than 12th-place Quad Cities. The Nuts' offense, meanwhile, has grounded into only 40 double plays this year, second lowest in the MWL to Dayton.

Thievery: Colby Thomas swiped third base in the ninth inning last night, giving the Lugnuts a league-leading 139 stolen bases this year, leading by two steals over the Great Lakes Loons. The next closest team, Peoria, is 18 stolen bases behind the Nuts and 16 behind Great Lakes.

Hit Machine: With a two-hit game yesterday, outfielder Colby Thomas now has four two-hit games with the Lugnuts in 13 games played since getting called up from Stockton. Overall, Thomas has hit safely in 12 of those 13 games and has base hits in 29 of his last 32 games and 33 of his last 36 games.

Mr. Wright: Infielder Joshwan Wright also went 2-for-4 last night, just like Thomas, and is slashing .289/.372/.421 in 10 games since returning to the Lugnuts. Wright had been placed on the Injured List in early May before receiving a trip to Double-A Midland to provide emergency depth.

Welcome to the Pros: In the Arizona Complex League last night, eight 2023 Athletics draft picks (Jacob Wilson, Ryan Lasko, Nate Nankil, Cole Conn, Luke Mann, Jonah Cox, Will Simpson and Colby Halter) along with two undrafted free agents (Nick Schwartz and Casey Yamauchi) made their professional debuts.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Facing the Clinton LumberKings on Summer Fun Day, Brad Glenn became the fifth Lugnut in team history, and the first since Travis Snider in 2007, to hit for the cycle, leading the way in a 9-5 victory. The Oklahoman singled in the 1st, homered in the 3rd, doubled (sun-aided) in the 5th, and snapped a 4-4 tie with a two-run triple in the 7th inning.

2018: Graham Spraker twirled seven scoreless innings en route to a 2-1 Lugnuts win at the South Bend Cubs. Combined with gems from Jordan Barrett (7 innings) and Maximo Castillo (6 innings), Lugnuts starters had worked 21 consecutive scoreless innings, a streak stretched to 23 innings by Kyle Weatherly before it ended on July 27th.

2022: Tyler Soderstrom homered twice and drove in four runs and Jake Walkinshaw struck out seven Great Lakes Loons in five scoreless innings in a 6-0 win at Dow Diamond.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the current campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... lefties batted .260/.302/.380 while righties batted .269/.321/.359... coaxed six double-play balls... avg./OBP by inning: .143/.200 in the 1st, .133/.188 in the 2nd, .188/.188 in the 3rd, .357/.419 in the 4th, .150/.190 in the 5th, .476/.522 in the 6th, .286/.375 in the 7th, .286/.375 in the 8th... opponent base stealers were successful in all four of their attempts.
