YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels blanked the Fightin Phils, 6-0, in the series opener to win their first game of the season's second half. **Andy Thomas** opened the scoring with a two-out, two-run triple in the top of the first, the first three-base hit of his professional career. **Brandon Martorano** followed with an RBI single to extend the lead to 3-0. In the second, **Vaun Brown** clubbed a three-run homer to open a 6-0 lead. Richmond starter **Ryan Murphy** threw four perfect innings and struck out five. **Parker Dunshee** tossed three frames and set a season high with six strikeouts. **Blake Rivera** navigated the final two innings to finish the shutout, striking out two.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies. This series is the second of the year between the two teams. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with a three-game sweep against the Fightin Phils at The Diamond on April 8 and 9.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 33-36 in the second half, finishing in fourth place in the Southwest Division. They were 14-7 through their first 21 games but are 19-29 since May 3, but have won five straight, their longest winning streak of the year. It is their longest winning streak since they won seven straight from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last five games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .314 (49-for-156) with four homers, 12 doubles and have scored 29 runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.80 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 250.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 353.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.28 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and is fifth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors. Richmond has played the second-most one-run games in the league this year (24) behind Harrisburg (25), and are tied for the most one-run losses (16) with Harrisburg.

THE FIGHTIN PHILS were 28-40 in the first half of the season, which was last in the Eastern League. Last week, Reading won four-of-six at Portland, including three straight wins to open the series, which tied their longest win streak of the season. The Fightin Phils opened the season 0-5, including a three-game sweep at The Diamond to begin the year. The Reading offense leads the league in batting average (.265), hits (620), total bases (1010), triples (15), OBP (.352), SLG (.431) and OPS (.783). Reading's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Mick Abel (No. 2), RHP Griff McGarry (No. 4), OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 11), OF Carlos De La Cruz (No. 17) and OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 22). McGarry is rated by Baseball America as having the best fastball, Ortiz is rated as having the best outfield arm and Baron Radcliff is rated as the best power hitter. MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospect list includes Abel (No. 2), McGarry (No. 4), Rojas (No. 6), De La Cruz (No. 9), Wilson (No. 14) and Ortiz (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his 10th Double-A start and his second against the Fightin Phils. He last pitched on Friday against the Senators and allowed two runs over four innings. He faced Reading as Richmond's Opening Day starter on April 8 at The Diamond in game one of a doubleheader and allowed three runs (one earned) over four innings. He leads the Eastern League and ranks tied for seventh in the minors (min. 50 IP) in HR/9 (0.17). The only homer he has allowed this season was on April 13 at Harrisburg to Frankie Tostado. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

FOR READING: Right-hander **Mick Abel** makes his 13th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he threw five innings and allowed three runs (two earned) at Portland last Wednesday. After posting a 7.45 ERA in the month of May over four starts, he has a 3.00 ERA in his four June starts. For the year, he has held opposing batters to a .198 average, which is the second-lowest in the Eastern League. Abel pitched at The Diamond in the second game of a doubleheader to open the season on April 8 and left after throwing 33 pitches in the first inning, issuing four walks and allowing two runs while recording two outs. Abel was the top-ranked high school pitching prospect in the 2020 MLB Draft and was selected in the first round (15th overall) by the Phillies out of Jesuit High School in Beaverton, Oregon, opting to sign instead of attending Oregon State. He was the first high school pitcher from Oregon taken in the first round since 1994. Abel is rated by MLB.com as the No. 2 Phillies prospect and the No. 45 prospect in baseball. He is also rated as the No. 2 Phillies prospect by Baseball America and is No. 30 on their Top 100 Prospects list.

RETURN OF THE MECKLER: In Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game, joining **Conor Gillaspie** (2010), **Nick Noonan** (2010), **Juan Perez** (twice, 2011 and 2012), **Kelby Tomlinson** (2014), **Rando Moreno** (2015), **Austin Slater** (2016), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (2022), **Jacob Heyward** (2022) and **Patrick Bailey** (2023). On Friday, Meckler set a new career high for hits and tied his career high with four RBIs. On Wednesday in the first game of this week's series, he reached base four times with two walks and two hits. Meckler has now reached base in all 17 of his Double-A games, including 24 hits and 24 walks. His on-base streak is the third-longest active streak in the league and the second-longest by a Richmond player this season. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 160 PA) this season with a .417 batting average and third in OBP (.488).

I LOVE LUCI: On June 4, **Marco Luciano** hit a grand slam and a two-run homer in the Flying Squirrels' 11-2 win. It was the fourth multi-homer game of his career. He went deep again with a two-run homer on Sunday afternoon and added a 432-foot, opposite-field two-run shot last Wednesday at Bowie. Luciano leads the team with 10 homers this year. He went on a five-game hit streak from June 10-14, during which he hit .588 (10-for-17) with four homers, a double, five walks and 10 RBIs. After going 1-for-20 over his next five games, Luciano has picked up six hits in his last four games, including going 4-for-4 on Saturday and hitting a solo home run on Sunday.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: In his last three games since Saturday, **Andy Thomas** has driven in seven runs. On Saturday, he hit a two-run double in the first inning and added an RBI single in the seventh. On Sunday, Thomas again opened the scoring with a two-run double in the third inning. In the first game of this week's series on Wednesday, he hit a two-run triple in the first inning, the first triple of his professional career. For the year, Thomas leads the team with 34 RBIs. He has driven in three-or-more runs three times, including a season-high four RBIs on May 28 at Binghamton.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 10 games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 17 times, posting a .447 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up seven hits, walked eight times and been hit by a pitch twice in 38 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and tied for seventh in walks (43). He is also second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year.

OLD FRIENDS: Reading's roster includes former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Matt Seelinger**, who played with Richmond in 2021. The reliever spent that entire season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was selected by the Phillies in the minor-league phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. With Reading last year, Seelinger pitched against Richmond twice, both at The Diamond, and allowed one unearned run over 2.2 innings of work with four strikeouts. Seelinger is one of four former Richmond players in the Eastern League this year. **Frankie Tostado**, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is playing with the Senators. **Diego Rincones**, who was with the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for the Erie SeaWolves. Pitcher **Grey Fenter**, a member of the 2022 Flying Squirrels, is now with the Somerset Patriots.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Hayden Cantrelle** is sixth in OBP (.395) and tied for seventh in walks (43). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for third in triples (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for ninth in strikeouts (68). **Mason Black** is tied for first in games started (14).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
