### RHP THOMAS PONTICELLI (0-5, 15.72) vs. LHP JACKSON WOLF (0-3, 4.56)

TODAY'S GAME: El Paso evened the series last night at two games apiece with a 5-2 triumph, ending the Isotopes seasonhigh two-game winning streak (three times) ... Thomas Ponticelli is slated to start for Albuquerque while Jackson Wolf is scheduled to toe the rubber for the Chihuahuas.

SERIES LEAD: The Isotopes fell to 0-3 when holding a lead in a series, all coming against El Paso. Albuquerque also dropped the contest on April 19, 9-3, with a 2-1 series advantage and April 21, 5-3, with a 3-2 series lead.

SWIPES: Albuquerque stole three bases last night (Julio Carreras, two; Aaron Schunk), the third-straight game the club SWIPES: has swiped multiple bags in a contest, tied for the longest streak on the year (twice, last: April 28-May 1). Over the first four games of the set, the Isotopes are a 13-for-13 in stolen base attempts.

BAGS FOR THE YEAR: The Isotopes 62 steals on the year are second in Triple-A (most: Tacoma, 80).

**STARTERS**: Both starting pitchers completed at least 6.0 innings last night, the second time this year both starters tallied 6.0-plus frames (other: May 4 vs. Round Rock; Josh Rogers, 7.0 IP, and Gerson Garabito, 6.0 IP)

TWO PITCHERS: Albuquerque used just two pitchers last night, the first time the club has needed just two picners last night, the first time the club has needed just two arms to complete a game since Aug. 20, 2023, vs. El Paso (Jeff Criswell, 7.2 IP; Nick Kennedy, 1.1 IP).

BULLPEN: The Isotopes bullpen did not surrender a run for the fifth time this season and first since April 30 vs. Round Rock.

FREE PASSES: Josh Rogers and reliever Jeff Criswell combined to walk just one Chihuahua hitter yesterday, tied for the secondfewest on the year (also: April 28 vs. Oklahoma City).

RISP: Over the Isotopes last seven losses, Albuquerque is a combined 9-for-57 (.157) with runners in scoring position

XBH: Albuquerque tallied just two extra-base hits last night. It's the 7th time the club has registered two or fewer (last: May 4 vs. Round Rock, one). In those seven contests, the Isotopes are 0-7.

**RUNS**: Albuquerque was held to two runs or fewer yesterday for the eighth time this year (last: May 4 vs. Round Rock, one).

THREE-BAGGERS: Coco Montes tripled in the fourth frame Sunday, giving the Isotopes an MiLB-leading 17 three-baggers on the year. They've tallied a triple in 12 of 37 games. TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron's 23 game on-base streak came to an end after going 0-for-4 last night. During the streak he slashed .302/.396/.465 with three doubles, one triple, three homers, 14 walks and 17 RBI. His eight-game hitting streak also ended (second-longest of year; longest: 14, March 31-April 28) ... Since June 25, 2023, has reached base in 67 of his last 74 games.

ON-BASE STREAK: Herron's streak was the third-longest onbase streak in the Pacific Coast League in 2024.

**REAL SLIM SCHUNKY:** Aaron Schunk tallied a hit and stole his ninth bag of the year last night. He has swiped a bag in three-straight games (four) for the first time in his career. Is 7-for-14 over his last three contests with two doubles, two RBI and two homers

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver recorded his third threehit game of the year yesterday (last: April 12 vs. Sugar Land), including mashing his second homer of the season. He has two straight multi-hit games for the first time since Sept. 8-10, 2023. two hits each contest

JC: Julio Carreras connected on a double and also drove in a run last night. He has five RBI over his last four games after tallying four in his first 28 contests.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall registered two hits yesterday, his second multi-hit game of the season (last: April 25 vs. Oklahoma City, five). Has yet to record an extra-base hit in seven games played.

TONY: Drew Romo swatted his second Triple-A homer in his last seven games Thursday. Had zero in his first 24 contests.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard did not collect a base hit for the 10th time this year and third in his last seven contests.

SOUTHPAW: Josh Rogers has completed 5.0-plus innings in five-straight starts for the first time since Sept. 2022 with Triple-A Jacksonville (also five-straight).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 1st in average (.349) and T-9th in doubles (10) ... Aaron Schunk is T-2nd in doubles (12) ... Coco Montes is 2nd in OBP (426), T-6th in hits (40), T-7th in walks (23) and 10th in average (.325) ... Sam Hilliard is T-6th in total bases (73) and hits (40), T-8th in runs (27) and homers (7) and T-10th stolen bases (9) ... Julio Carreras is T-6th in triples

#### **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID:** Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
