# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (7-7, 37-41)

**Visalia Rawhide (9-5, 38-41)**

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a nine-game, 11-day road trip tonight, with the rubber game of a threegame set against the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks). After tonight's game, the Quakes will get two consecutive days off, before opening a six-game series on Tuesday in Stockton.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 18th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the ninth of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Quakes are 9-8 against the Rawhide in 2024, 5-3 here in Visalia. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 at Valley Strong Ballpark.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes dominated in a 10-0 victory over the Visalia Rawhide on Friday night at Valley Strong Ballpark. Five Rancho pitchers combined on a one-hit shutout, as Luke Fox, Dodgers' rehabbing right-hander Joe Kelly, Moises Brito (1-0), Reynaldo Yean and Noah Ruen helped the Quakes end a three-game skid. The only Visalia hit came from Angel Ortiz, a clean single to open the fifth inning. Rancho's Juan Alonso (5) smacked a three-run homer to cap a five-run second, helping the Quakes take a 5-0 lead against starter Wilkin Paredes (3-3). Sean McLain had a career-best four hits, while Carlos Rojas had three hits and two RBIs.

**ROSTER MOVES:** On Saturday, the Quakes activated RHP Gabe Emmett from the Injured List. RHP Eriq Swan was placed on the Injured List on Friday, his second stint on the IL this year. Left-handed pitcher Moises Brito was added to the Rancho roster from the Arizona Complex League on Thursday, where he was 0-0 with a 6.35 ERA over eight appearances, allowing eight runs on nine hits over 11.1 innings.

**JOE KELLY:** Joe Kelly of the Los Angeles Dodgers made his second rehab appearance on Friday night, using 13 pitches to throw a scoreless fifth inning. Kelly started and threw one scoreless inning, using just five total pitches on Tuesday. Kelly has been on the Injured List since early May. In 15 games this year, Kelly was 0-0 with a 4.73 ERA for the Dodgers across 13.1 innings. Kelly pitched for the Quakes on rehab assignment on two occasions in 2021 and then again in 2023, when he made two more appearances. Kelly, who won a World Series with the Dodgers in 2020, is currently in his second stint with the Dodgers, after spending 2022 and part of 2023 with the Chicago White Sox. Kelly was originally drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals in the third round of the 2009 draft out of UC Riverside.

**ROQUE GUTIERREZ:** Right-hander Roque Gutierrez makes his third start of the year and his 18th overall appearance, his fifth appearance and second start against Visalia. In three appearances against the Rawhide this year, he's 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA, allowing five runs (four earned) on ten hits over 12 innings. In his last outing, he made a spot-start at Lake Elsinore on June 30, where he allowed two runs on four hits over four innings in a no-decision. Gutierrez was signed by the Dodgers out of Guasave, Mexico in 2020.

**ADONYS PEREZ:** Lefty Adonys Perez will make his 14th appearance and 13th start of the year, his third start against the Quakes. In two games against the Quakes, he's 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA, allowing four runs on six hits over ten innings. In his last outing, he allowed four runs on nine hits over five innings in a win at Inland Empire on June 30. The Diamondbacks signed Perez in 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.

**SECOND HALF STUFF:** In order to make the playoffs in 2024, the Quakes must win the second half, or else finish second in the South Division's second-half race, while having the first-half champion Storm win the division again. The Storm will meet the second-half winner or the team with the next best second-half record. Lake Elsinore last went to the playoffs in 2022, when they won the Cal League title. Modesto won the North Division First Half Title.
