Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain on the road and continue a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. It is the ninth-of-12 games between the teams this season and third-of-six at FNB Field. Harrisburg took the series between the teams from Apr. 29-May 4 in Reading, 4-2 and leads the season-series 6-2. Reading won the 2024 season-series over Harrisburg 7-5, including a 3-3 record in the Capital City.

Game 51 Recap

The Fightin Phils once again fell to Harrisburg in heartbreaking fashion, with a 7-6 final, on Wednesday night. The Senators took advantage of a sloppy first inning by Reading to plate the game's first two runs. Braeden Fausnaught hit three batters and committed an error, which was one of two Fightin Phils errors in the first inning. Fausnaught did settle in though, posting zeros in the second through fifth innings. Felix Reyes reached on an error in the second and Seth Beer worked a 10-pitch walk, which was followed by a three-run home run from Paul McIntosh to make it 3-2, Fightin Phils. Reading scored two more in the sixth when Keaton Anthony launched the third home run of his season to left field to make it 5-2. Harrisburg got the first two runners on in the bottom of the sixth, ending the day for Fausnaught. Josh Hejka entered and allowed one run to score on a double play to make it 5-3, but was able to minimize the damage from there. Reading scored another in the eighth on a Beer sac fly to extend the lead to three. But, Andrew Walling struggled with command in the home half of the eighth, issuing two walks and was lifted after two-thirds of an inning. An error on a pick off from John McMillon played a role in two Senators runs scoring in the eighth to cut the Reading lead to one. Up 6-5 in the bottom of the ninth, Carlos De La Cruz launched a two-run walk-off home run for the second-straight night to give Harrisburg the 7-6 victory, just like they did on Tuesday.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller had two hits, a run, three RBI and two stolen bases on Tuesday night. It was his first game as the leadoff hitter this season. When leading off an inning this season, Miller is slashing .300/.400/.467 (.867 OPS). After hitting just .203 in April, Miller posted a .284/.364/.432 (.796 OPS) slash line over 24 May games, along with 11 runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI. Miller has proved to be a threat on the bases this season as well, as he ranks third in the Eastern League with 18 stolen bases.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

After two more hits and a home run on Wednesday night, Phillies Minor League Hitter of May Keaton Anthony enters today with a team-best 12-game hit and 20-game on-base streak, both of which are season highs for Anthony. Both of those streaks are the second-longest active in the Eastern League. His 20-game on-base streak matches Otto Kemp's 20-game on-base streak from July 27-August 21, of last season. His two 12-game hitting streak is the longest by a R-Phil since Carlos De La Cruz had a 15-game hitting streak from May 23-June 9, of the 2023 season. Anthony enters today with the best average amongst all qualifiers in the Eastern League at .342 and doubles with 20. His other Eastern League ranks are: 5th OBP (.393), 2nd SLG (.534), 4th OPS (.927), 3rd hits (55), T-1st XBH (24) and T-3rd TB (86). Since May 1 (25 games), Anthony is slashing .400/.449/.633 (1.082 OPS), with 13 runs, 13 doubles, one triple, two home runs and 15 RBI. Anthony has also recorded four-straight two-hit games, the most since Trevor Schwecke did it from Aug. 15-18, of the 2024 season.

Terrific Tommy

Since returning from Jersey Shore (A+) on May 1, Tommy McCollum has been excellent out of the bullpen. After two-perfect innings on Tuesday night, McCollum now has a 0.68 ERA (1 ER, 13.1 IP) over eight appearances. He has also struck out 10 and now issued a single walk yet. McCollum has not allowed a run over his last six outings (11.1 IP) and has allowed a run in just one of his eight appearances so far. Since May 1, McCollum has the fifth-lowest ERA amongst Eastern League relievers who have made at least eight appearances.

Old Friend turned Villain

Carlos De La Cruz, who played 232 games for Reading between 2022-24, has hit a walk-off home run against his former team in back-to-back games. On Tuesday, he hit a two-strike, two-out, home run to flip it from 6-5, Reading, to a 7-6 Harrisburg win. On Wednesday, it was a one-out two-run home run that flipped the score from the same 6-5 to 7-6 for Harrisburg.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 5, 1994: At Reading, Mariano Rivera makes his Double-A debut for Albany-Colonie but does not get the decision in the Yankees' 7-4 win over the Phillies. In fact, Rivera (7.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 6 K) is on the hook for the loss until Tate Seefried's grand slam in the 9th off Ricky Bottalico gives Albany the lead.

To the Capital City

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 26-27 record, which is third in the Southwest Division and 10 games out of first place. The Senators were in Richmond last week and took four-of-six games at the league-worst Flying Squirrels. After this week, Harrisburg heads back south to take on the Chesapeake Baysox. Harrisburg's roster has five players on the Nationals' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Jarlin Susana (2), Seaver King (4), Cayden Wallace (10), Tyler Stuart (14), and Kevin Made (26).

Pitching for the Senators

Righty, and Nationals' No. 14 prospect, Tyler Stuart starts tonight for Harrisburg. It will be Stuart's first start with Harrisburg this season as he's been on the injured list and rehabbed with the FCL-Nationals (ROK) and Wilmington (A+). Stuart split 2024 between the Mets' and Nationals' organizations, as he was traded to Washington for Jesse Winker. In total, Stuart went 4-8, with a 4.12 ERA over 25 starts in 2024. He has faced Reading before with Binghamton (AA), going 1-0, with a 3.60 ERA over three outings. The 25-year old was a sixth round pick by the Mets in 2022 out of Southern Mississippi.

Neunborn entered the game in the top of the sixth inning for Jean Cabrera. It was an uncharacteristic appearance for Neunborn out of the bullpen. He inherited two runners from Cabrera and surrendered a home run to Eliezer Alfonzo, a three-run shot on the first batter he faced. Following a strikeout and walk, Neunborn surrendered back-to-back home runs to Carlos Mendoza and Thayron Liranzo. It was a season-high in runs allowed (4) and also a career-high in home runs surrendered (3) by Neunborn. Neunborn was relieved by Nelson Alvarez in the top of the seventh.
