JACKSONVILLE SPLITS SERIES WITH NORFOLK

Despite tying the game in the top of the third, the Norfolk Tides scored 10 unanswered runs and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 11-2 Sunday. Norfolk regained the lead in the bottom of the third and never looked back. With one out, **Jackson Holliday** drew a walk against Jacksonville reliever **Archie Bradley** (L, 0-2) and **Colton Cowser** singled. Holliday went to third and **Coby Mayo** (10) clubbed a three-run home run to give the Tides a 4-1 advantage.

HIT AND MISS

Jacksonville tallied just 11 total runs, including no more than three runs in each contest, over the entire series with Charlotte (8/29-9/3). The Jumbo Shrimp were just 29-for-155 (.187/.274/.258/.532) with only one home run in the series. Last week against Norfolk, the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .197/.296/.303/.599. After clubbing three big flies on en route to a 9-4 win on Tuesday, the Jumbo Shrimp managed two more wins both within two runs or fewer and in extra innings. Forty-eight men were left on base by Jacksonville but timely hitting helped them split the series. In the late stages, Jacksonville was outscored by Norfolk, 10-9 in the seventh inning or later. Thanks to an 11-inning win on Saturday, the Jumbo Shrimp won the Navy Town Showdown for the third consecutive season.

'PEN PALS

Over the last month, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 29 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 47 runs, 38 earned, on 93 hits (8.2 H/9) in 102.1 innings for a 3.34 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 124 batters (10.9 K/9) against 67 walks (5.9 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 119, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.6 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks tied for third in Triple-A. Over their last 24 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 23 of 27 stolen base attempts (85.2 percent).

THE AMAZING RACE

Somewhat remarkably, the top nine teams in the International League are separated by just 6.5 games entering play on Tuesday. Jacksonville checks in just 5.0 games out of first place, but the logjam means the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting in seventh. Thus, with just 12 games remaining in the regular season, in order to win the IL's second-half championship and earn a playoff berth, Jacksonville would have to make up that 5.0-game deficit while also leapfrogging four other teams. If first-place Durham even finishes the season 5-7, because the club holds the tiebreaker over Jacksonville by virtue of head-to-head record, the Jumbo Shrimp would need to finish 11-1 (.917) while also hoping the six other teams ahead of them do not record a better record down the stretch.

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, **Troy Johnston** has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 40 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 53-for-156 (.340/.412/.571/.983) with 10 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 31 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 114 runs in 120 games this season, which ranks first in MiLB.

JERARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana, D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 33 games, however, the 26-year-old is 27-for-105 (.257/.392/.467/.859) with four doubles, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 24 walks (18.5 BB percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Despite committing an IL worst 28 errors in the last 31 games Jacksonville owns an 18-13 record, tied for the sixth-best record in Triple-A. Their 4.11 ERA T-2nd in Triple-A.

ABOUT CHI CHI

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, GONZÁLEZ attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles.

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame.
