

Leading Off

Tonight, Reading finishes its six-game series with Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies have won four-of-five so far and Reading will look to salvage a second win. Josh Hendrickson gets the ball for Reading, opposite Junior Santos for the second time this week for Binghamton.

Looking Back

Reading fell in both games of yesterday's doubleheader, 4-1 and 8-5 respectively. Reading had leads in both games, but ultimately surrendered them in defeat. In game one, Griff McGarry went five no-hit innings but the combined no-hitter was lost in the seventh. In game two, Reading surrendered a 5-1 lead, but Johan Rojas chipped in three hits including a two-run triple.

De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 25-game on-streak, but his 15-game on-base streak was snapped in game one last night. Over the 15-game hitting streak, De La Cruz is hit .349. He had back-to-back three-hit games.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he is hitting .429 this week and had three hits and a triple in game two last night. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks ninth in the Eastern League with a .299 average.

Reading and Binghamton played in their third-straight extra-inning game with two last night. The last time that happened was from May 5-7 in 2019 at Akrona. Dating back to 1992, the Fightin Phils have not played in four-straight extra-inning games.

Bullpen Blues

This week's series features the two bullpens with the highest ERA in the Eastern League. Reading enters tonight ranked 11th with a 5.42 ERA, and Binghamton is 12th with a 5.45 ERA. In wins this season, Reading's bullpen holds a dominant 2.39 ERA, but in losses, the bullpen's ERA is up to 7.46 after allowing five-earned runs over 5.2 innings in the two games.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies fell 9-0 to the Dodgers last night and finish a three-game series today. Lehigh Valley swept a doubleheader at Syracuse and finish up the series up north today. Jersey Shore fell 4-0 to Hudson Valley. Finally, Clearwater clinched a first-half title with a 8-4 win over Fort Myers last night. The Threshers are now 40-15, which is the best record in all of affiliated professional baseball.

June 11, 2004: At Reading, Carlos Ruiz singles home Kevin Barker with two outs in the 9th to complete a 7-6 comeback win against Altoona. The Phils scored three in the 8th to tie the game.

Ponies Rumbling into Reading

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Binghamton. The Rumble Ponies sit in fourth in the Northeast standings, sixgames ahead of Reading. The Ponies entered the series losers of five straight since winning game one at Altoona next week. After this week, Binghamton returns home to welcome Portland after finishing off a 12-game road trip.

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Junior Santos gets the start tonight for Binghamton. Santos pitched against Reading on Tuesday and went six innings, alowing nine hits and five-earned runs with two walks and strikeouts a piece. He did earn the win. On the season, he has 10 starts and is 3-4 with a 6.18 ERA over 51 innings. Santos has allowed 64 hits and 22 walks, with 33 strikeouts. Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 at 16 years old out of the Dominican Republic. He spent all of 2022 at high-A Brooklyn, going 8-13 with a 4.47 ERA over 26 games and 23 starts.
