### TODAY'S HEADLINES

#### LAST TIME OUT: It was another close game for the Saints, but they could not get over the hump in a 3-2 loss, dropping their seventh straight game. Caleb Boushley was excellent in his start, throwing 6.0 innings of one-run baseball, striking out eight. The Saints took the lead in the seventh inning, as Diego A. Castillo and Yunior Severino drove in a pair of runs. However Indy answered with two runs in the bottom of the inning, taking a 3-2 lead. The Saints had the tying and go-ahead runs on

ON THE SKID: The Saints have dropped their last seven games, their longest losing streak of the season and tied for their second-longest streak in franchise history. There have been only two other skids of seven-or-more games, the most recent being the franchise-record 11 consecutive losses from May 8-20, 2022. During this six-game skid, the Saints have been out-scored 42-31 and been out-hit 73-55.

base in the ninth, but could not bring them around in the loss.

S All seven losses have been decided by three-or-fewer runs including the last five, which have been decided by two-or fewer. The tying run has been at the plate or on base in six of the seven losses, with the only other being the 6-5 walk-off loss on Wednesday

RETURN OF RANDY: Randy Dobnak will make his first appearance with the Saints today, after his return to the Major Leagues. In four Major League relief appearances, Dobnak was 0-0 with a 5.87 ERA, allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He will look to become the Saints first 10game winner today, currently tied with Caleb Boushley and Chandler Shepherd (2021) for the single-season record at nine wins

FINDING THE GAPS: The long ball has not been much of a factor for the Saints in the month of August, hitting league-low eight homers this month and the second-fewest in Triple-A. However, they have still gotten extra-base hits, hitting 35 doubles in August, most in Triple-A. The Saints' four triples in August are also tied for the fourth-most in Triple-A. The club's .383 slugging percentage this month is good for 11th in the International League

NO VICTORY FIELD: Indianapolis has proved to be a challenging road trip for the Saints this year, going 1-9 in Circle City. Their .100 win percentage is the lowest against any team in a single season since joining the International League in 2021.

Over the course of a season series (minimum six games), the Saints have been held to two-or-fewer wins on three previous occasions: vs Toledo, 2021 (2-9), vs Buffalo, 2022 (2-4) and vs Syracuse, 2024 (2-4) The Saints' .100 winning percentage against Indy is the lowest for any IL team against any opponent in 2024 (minimum six games).

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .430 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 28 of the 32 games he's played in, drawing 17 walks and been hit by a pitch five times. He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .445 across three levels. Of the three players ahead of him, only one has played in Triple-A

**SUMMERTIME SEVERINO:** In Yunior Severino's 59 games since May 21, he has hit .326 (72-for-221), with 12 home runs, drawing 40 walks, owning a .960 OPS. In that time, Severino ranks second in the league in OPS and batting average, third on-base percentage (.422) and in RBI (48), sixth in slugging percentage at .538 and eighth with 72 hits. His 40 walks since May 21 are the ninth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins scored four runs off Rangers' starter Andrew Heany and rode that to a 4-3 victory in Arlington on Friday. Ryan Jeffers and Carlos Santana each homered, accounting for all four runs. Simeon Woods Richardson got his fourth win of the season, allowing two runs over 5.0 innings of work.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 8/6 @ CHC...made third Major League appearance, allowing three runs on 3.0 innings, allowing four hits, walking one and striking one out...entered the game in the sixth inning, walking the leadoff batter before allowing a triple to Dansby Swanson to score a run, then threw a wild pitch that brought Swanson in...retired seven in a row into the eighth inning...allowed three straight singles that scored third run... did not factor into the decision in a 7-3 Twins loss

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny Henriquez.

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2,61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus. Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicoms in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the IISPAE.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his flancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handlwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.

Named starting pitcher on Twins MiLB com organization All-Star team Started Game 2 of the ALDS October 5, 2019 at New York-AL, allowing four runs on six

hits in 2.0 innings pitched. Became the fourth rookie in Twins history (6th occurrence) to start a Postseason game, 18th to ever pitch in one. Prior to Dobnak, the last Twins rookie to start in the Postseason was Brian Duensing in 2009 in Game 1 of the ALDS at New York-AL.
