LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones erased a four-run deficit in the fifth and a two-run deficit in the ninth to defeat the Emperors, 7-6, in Sunday's series finale...With one out in the ninth, 3B **Jefrey De Los Santos** powered a game-tying two-run home run to right...LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a solo home run to secure the walk-off victory...Jefrey De Los Santos picked up a pair of extra-base hits and drove in four, registering a two-run double in the fifth...IB **Kellum Clark** and CF **Nick Morabito** each tallied multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHP **Eduardo Herrera** earned the win in relief, striking out five over 2.0 perfect innings...RHP **Sean Reid-Foley** was taxed for two runs on two hits, walking one, in 0.2 innings during a Major League rehab appearance...RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**'s 18.1-inning streak without allowing an earned run ended in Rome's four-run fifth.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 30, 2006, the Cyclones shut out Aberdeen in both ends of a doubleheader, winning both games, 3-0...RHPs **Nelson Portillo** (6.0 IP) and **Joe Smith** (1.0) combine on a six-hitter in Game 1, while RHPs **Jonathan Castillo** (4.0 IP), **Jeremy Mizell** (2.0), and **José De La Torre** (1.0) unite on a four-hitter in Game 2...In 2012, RHP **Rainy Lara** struck out 10 batters over 7.0 innings of three-hit, one-run ball in a 5-1 win at Mahoning Valley...The 10-plus strikeout performance is Lara's second of the year, becoming just the third Cyclone to accomplish the feat twice in one season...In 2014, LF **Michael Conforto** went 3-for-3 with two runs scored, two runs batted in, and a walk, as Brooklyn used a seven-run second inning to win 9-4 vs. Auburn...In 2023, the Cyclones used nine different pitchers to beat Wilmington, 11-7, in a series finale at Maimonides Park...All nine Brooklyn batters pick up at least one hit in the victory.

EVERYONE RUNS THE BASES POSTGAME

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the third time in the homestand, the second time in the series, and the fourth time this season, the Cyclones walked off winners on Sunday afternoon vs. Rome...Down by two runs with one out in the ninth, 3B **Jefrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins during the homestand on Friday, July 19, on C **Chris Suero**'s game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on Wednesday, July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara**'s walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.66% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses, while earning 11 walk-off wins...28 of Brooklyn's 227 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.33%)...The Cyclones have also earned 22 wins in their last at-bat.

GUESS WHO'S BACK?: The Cyclones reinstated two players off the injured list before Tuesday's series opener...INF **Jacob Reimer** was reinstated off Brooklyn's 60-day injured list, while INF **William Lugo** was activated from the 7-day IL...Reimer has not appeared in a game for the Cyclones this season after suffering an injury during spring training...The Mets' No. 14 prospect per MLB Pipeline and No. 22 by *Baseball America*, appeared in 11 rehab games between the Florida Complex League Mets and Single-A St. Lucie, hitting .250/.400/.313 with a .713 OPS, two doubles, and three runs batted in...Lugo missed a month after being placed on the 7-day IL on June 26...In 59 games with Brooklyn in 2024, the 22-year-old has posted a .179/.347/.296 line with a .643 OPS, 14 extra-base hits, four home runs, and 25 RBI.

LIKE A HAWK: RHP **Dakota Hawkins** became the 13th different Cyclone to be transferred to Double-A Binghamton in 2024 on Monday...In 21 appearances (eight starts) with Brooklyn, the 24-year-old accumulated a 3-3 record with 4.34 ERA (32 ER in 66.1 IP), 61 hits allowed, 20 walks, and 61 strikeouts...Hawkins made history on June 4, starting the franchise's first nine-inning no-hitter vs. Aberdeen...The Chehalis, Wash. native tossed the first 5.0 innings before handing the baton to RHPs **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0 IP) and **Joshua Cornelly** (3.0) to complete the bid.

WALK ALONG THE ALLEGHENY: On Tuesday, LHP **Josh Walker** became the third former Cyclone to be traded by the New York Mets since Friday...The 29-year-old was dealt to the Pittsburgh Pirates in exchange for LHP **Nicolas Carreno** after being designated for assignment on July 26...In 10 Major League games this year, Walker did not have a decision with a 5.11 ERA (7 ER in 12.1 IP), six walks, and 11 strikeouts...The University of New Haven (Conn.) alum made five appearances (four starts) with Brooklyn in the 2019 and 2021 seasons, accumulating a 3-0 record with a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP), 19 hits allowed, six walks, and 26 K's...Walker joined, OF **Rhylan Thomas** and RHP **Tyler Stuart** who were traded to the Seattle Mariners and Washington Nationals for RHP **Ryne Stanek** and OF **Jesse Winker**, respectively.

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has found his stride at the High-A level...The 22-year-old took a perfect game into the seventh on Friday against Rome and holds a minuscule 2.12 ERA over his last six appearances (five starts) dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that span sits at 3-2...He has yielded just 24 hits and 10 walks while striking out 35...Since June 21, Morris has been one of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...The righty is tied for the league lead in wins (3) and tied for second in strikeouts (35)...He is also second in innings pitched (34.0), sixth in batting average against (.192) and ERA (2.12), and eighth in WHIP (1.00)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is third in the league in innings pitched (57.2), fifth in batting average against (.221), tied for sixth in strikeouts (57), and ninth in WHIP (1.16) and ERA (3.43).

vs. ABERDEEN: After a nine-game homestand, Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series since the All-Star break against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds have five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (4), LHP **Luis De León** (15), and RHP **Michael Forret** (24)...RHP **Juan Núñez** (23) and C **Creed Willems** (28) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 at home against Aberdeen this year, but dropped 5-of-6 in the previous meeting at Leidos Field (June 25-30)...Aberdeen leads the season series, 10-8...In 257 meetings dating back to 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 134-123 (.521).

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 28th multi-hit game of the year in Sunday's win...The McLean, Va. native is tied for ninth in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (43)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (73), is second in stolen bases (32), tied for sixth in runs scored (43), and eighth in batting average (.287) and on-base percentage (.369)...The former second-round selection is fifth in the SAL in stolen bases (32) and on-base percentage (.369), and sixth in batting average (.287) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.313), stolen bases (43) and on-base percentage (.411)...He is also tied for first in hits (104) with Triple-A Syracuse's INF **Luisangel Acuña**, second in runs scored (57), tied for fourth in walks (48), fifth in OPS (.803), and tied for fifth in triples (3) and total bases (130).

GRAB A PINT-ARO: RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** has been on a tear over the past month or so...Despite an 18.1-inning streak without allowing an earned run coming to a close on Sunday, the Pelham, Ala. native has been one of the South Atlantic League's best pitchers in July...Over his five July outings (four starts), the veteran has a 0.49 ERA (1 ER in 18.1 IP), with 10 hits, three hit batters, five walks, and 19 strikeouts...Among South Atlantic League pitchers, Pintaro is tied for the league lead in ERA (0.49) and is fourth in batting average against (.154) and fifth in WHIP (0.82) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.83 ERA across seven starts, while giving up only one earned run over 71 frames in two relief appearances...Unfortunately, the Shorter University product has not received a lot of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump across his seven starts this season.

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 13 games...Since July 6, he is hitting .391/.440/.435 with a .875 OPS, seven runs scored, two doubles, and three runs batted in over 13 games...Clark leads the South Atlantic League in batting average (.391) and on-base percentage (.440) since that date, in addition to sitting tied for fifth in hits (18).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on Sunday and has now homered in five of his last nine games since July 13 at Wilmington...Four of those five home runs have either tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...In that time, Omar is hitting .273/.314/.758 with a 1.072 OPS, nine runs scored, a double, five homers, and eight runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer**'s (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is sixth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Even after suffering a loss on Thursday, the 21-year-old is 2-2 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), allowing only 18 hits and nine walks, while striking out 40 over his last six starts since June 20...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit in strikeouts (78)...If he had logged enough innings to qualify, Tong would be fourth in batting average against (.212), sixth in ERA (3.36), and seventh in WHIP (1.25)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.07), tied for fourth in strikeout rate (35.4%), and 10th in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Kade Morris** (26), and RHP **Jack Wenninger** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list...Plus seven of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (21), **Wilfredo Lara** (22), OF **Nick Morabito** (24), and Morris (25)...Ziegler is on the full-season injured list.

LAST TIME OUT: Collected a no-decision last Wednesday afternoon vs. Rome...Did not allow a run on one hit over 5.0 innings in his Maimonides Park debut...Walked a season-high-tying three and struck out four...Threw 76 pitches and 41 strikes (53.95%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** to start the top of the sixth and the game scoreless...Contest remained scoreless into extra innings...After the Emperors took the lead in the top of the 10th, the Cyclones tied it on a wild pitch and won on SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off RBI single, 2-1.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Wenninger is ranked as the New York Mets' No. 30 prospect at mid-season by *Baseball America*.

FLORIDA STATE FIRE: Wenninger was among the best pitchers in the Florida State League prior to joining the Cyclones on July 8...At the time of his promotion, the 22-year-old ranked second in the FSL in strikeouts (89)... Wenninger was also tied for fifth in innings pitched (71.2), seventh in WHIP (1.26), eighth in batting average against (.238), and ninth in ERA (5.02)...He was also first in xFIP (3.06), third in strikeout rate (28.7%) and strikeout-to-walk rate (21.3%), sixth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Wenninger signed with the Mets for \$225,000 on July 14...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 22...Tossed a scoreless inning of relief, striking out one, that day at the FCL Cardinals...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 5...Started vs. Daytona that day...Took a no-decision after allowing two runs on one hit, walking two, and striking out three, in 1.1 innings.

ILLI-NOISE: Wenninger had an outstanding final campaign at the University of Illinois, transferring in after spending his freshman season at Murray (Ky.) State University in 2021...During the 2023 season, the Barrington, Ill. native posted a 6-4 record with a 4.59 ERA (41 ER in 80.1 IP), 28 walks (8.30 BB%), and 76 strikeouts (22.55 K%) in 15 appearances (14 starts) for the Fighting Illini...Wenninger was All-Big Ten Second Team in 2023.

MLB DRAFT LEAGUE: Prior to being drafted by the New York Mets, Wenninger made three starts for the Williamsport (Pa.) Crosscutters in the MLB Draft League in 2023... The Crosscutters were a former foe of the Cyclones in the New York-Penn League...The 22-year-old accrued an 0-1 mark with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP), seven walks, and 19 strikeouts.

FAMILY TREE: Wenninger is far from the only member of his family to play collegiate baseball...Jack's grandfather, **Robert Eckl Sr.**, and his uncle, **Robert Eckl Jr.**, both played baseball at the University of Wisconsin...The Badgers' baseball program, however, was discontinued following the 1990-91 school year.
