ABOUT THAT LAST ONE...: A run-scoring single with one out in the eleventh proved to be the difference Sunday, as the Vancouver Canadians beat the Spokane Indians (Rockies) 7-6 to win their fifth consecutive game and first walk-off at Ron Tonkin Field.

With the game tied 6-6 and runners on first and second with one out, Cameron Eden laced a game-winning single off the left field wall to score the placed runner from second base.

It was the cherry on top of a banner day for Eden. The Yuba City, CA native finished with four hits – a career high – one RBI, two runs scored and a stolen base.

The teams traded runs throughout the game. Spokane started the scoring with a run in the first before Vancouver answered with two in the home half of the inning. The Indians plated two in the top of the third to retake the lead, but a two-run home run from Ronny Brito – his first of the year – in the bottom of the inning put the Cs' in front 4-3.

Vancouver added another run in the sixth. Brito knocked a rule book double over the left field fence before Andres Guerra brought him in with a single to centerfield.

Spokane plated a run in the seventh before they rallied for two runs in the ninth to take the lead. In that inning, the Rockies affiliate had four consecutive men reach with two outs to go up 6-5.

Down but not out, the Canadians came back to tie it in the bottom of the ninth. Tanner Kirwer started the comeback with a one-out infield single then stole second base before Eden lined a game-tying base hit off the glove of the third baseman.

BATTLE FOR THE BORO: This week marks the first meeting between Vancouver and Hillsboro. The C's and the Hops will match-up in five series this season; three with the Hops as the home team and two with the Canadians "hosting" the Diamondbacks affiliate.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 against Hillsboro as the visitors).

ON LOCK: Vancouver is perfect when leading after the seventh inning or later. The C's are 7-0 when ahead after the seventh and 8-0 when up after the eighth.

RUNNING AMOK: Cameron Eden and Tanner Kirwer lead the High-A West league with nine and eight stolen bases, respectively. Both men have only been caught stealing one time this year. The C's have stolen 22 bases this year, tied for the eighth-most in High-A. Hillsboro leads the level with 32 bags.

ALL ABOUT THAT ON BASE: Spencer Horwitz (11 games) and Phil Clarke (nine games) have reached base in every game they've played in this season. Horwitz leads the league with a .510 on-base percentage and is ranked ninth with a .927 OPS.

HIP BABIP HOORAY: Tanner Kirwer and Spencer Horwitz lead the Canadians in BABIP (Batting Average on Balls In Play). Kirwer is hitting a team-best .423 when he makes contact while Horwitz enters today batting .400 when doing so.

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Sean Wymer returns to the hill for Vancouver in the series opener tonight. In his last turn on May 11 against Spokane, Wymer went four innings, gave up two runs on seven hits, walked one and struck out three. A native of Flower Mound, TX, Wymer is in the midst of his first Advanced-A season. The 24-year-old spent 2019 with Low-A Lansing, where he went 9-11 with a 5.43 ERA in 28 games (26 starts).

#26 Diamondbacks prospect (MLB.com) Conor Grammes gets the nod for Hillsboro. He made his Advanced-A debut in his last start on May 10 in Eugene, when he gave up two runs on four hits in three innings pitched. He walked one and struck out five. Grammes, 23, was selected by Arizona in the fifth round of the 2019 draft out of Xavier. He's from McLean, VA.
