Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Comeback Kids: Syracuse came back to win the first three games this series. Since June 2nd, Syracuse is 16-11, which is tied for the most wins in the International League since that point. During that stretch the Mets have 12 come-from-behind wins and are second in the league with 6.30 runs scored per game.

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets rank 15th in the 20-team International League with a .250 batting average but rank third with 206 runs scored in 35 games. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Streiking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 33 of his last 38 games, including hits in 29 of 38. During his last 38 games since May 12th, Blankenhorn is hitting .341 with 25 RBIs, five home runs, 13 doubles, 14 walks, 32 strikeouts, and a .413 on-base percentage.

From the start of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, four homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 on-base percentage.

Power Surge: Since May 2nd, Mark Vientos is hitting .296 with 29 RBIs, 13 home runs, three doubles, 19 walks and a .391 on-base percentage in 35 games. Vientos was on Syracuse's 7-day Injured List from June 3rd until he was activated on June 12th, hitting four home runs in his first three games back.

From the beginning of the season to May 1st, Vientos was hitting .164 (9-for-55) with seven RBIs, a home run, four doubles, a triple, nine walks, 22 strikeouts, and a .288 on-base percentage in 18 games.

Last week at Rochester, Vientos went just 3-14 but still found a way to get on base often, walking six times in the series overall.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, Daniel Palka has reached base in 21 out of the last 22 games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .365 (31-for-85) with 20 RBIs, five home runs, six doubles, 16 runs scored, nine walks and a .426 on-base percentage.

From the beginning of the season to April 29th, Palka hit .288 (15-for-52) with 20 RBIs, six home runs, five doubles, 13 runs scored, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts, and a .413 on-base percentage.

From April 30th to May 28th, Palka hit .150 (12-for-80) with seven RBIs, four home runs, ten runs scored, nine walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .236 on-base percentage.

Man with the Flow: Nick Meyer has hits in six of his last eight games, including multiple hits in five of those games. Since June 17th, Meyer is hitting .423 (11-for-26) with 12 RBI, four doubles, six runs, five walks, three strikeouts, and a .515 on-base percentage.

Finding His Stride: Since returning from Double-A Binghamton on June 19th, Quinn Brodey has hit .296 (8-for-27) at the plate with five extra-base hits in seven games. The former Stanford Cardinal had an RBI double in Wednesday night's win. In Brodey's first 27 games with Syracuse this season, he hit .152 and had six extra-base hits.
