TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, opening a three-game set at New Hampshire.

LAST TIME OUT: Jackson Glenn broke a 2-2 tie in the 6th inning with a 2-run double and the Curve bullpen locked down a 4-2 win on Saturday. Altoona and Erie's Sunday game was rained out and will be made up on August 9 at 12:05 p.m.

EXTRA RUNS: The Curve have allowed the most runs in extra innings this season in the Eastern League, allowing 19 runs in 10 extra innings. Altoona has scored 13 runs of their own and are 5-4 in games that have got to extras.

BAG MAN: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng matched the franchise record with 4 stolen bases on Wednesday, July 5 in an 11 inning win over Erie. Cheng joined **Ray Sadler** (7/10/04 at Portland) as the only players in franchise history to steal four bases in a game. Altoona stole 8 bases in total, matching the franchise record set on August 18, 2005 at Akron, a 9-5 Curve win.

MULTI-MATT: Outfielder Matt Gorski became the fifth different player this season to swat two homers in a game this season on Tuesday, July 4, joining Andres Alvarez, Henry Davis, Mason Martin and Liover Peguero. Three times in team history the Curve Hartford have had seven different players record a multi-homer game in a season, last done so in 2005.

PEGUERO IS LEA-OH-VING: Infielder Liover Peguero was promoted to Triple-A following Altoona's game at Harrisburg on July 3. In 69 games with Altoona this season (210 total), Peguero batted .260/.333/.453 with 20 2B, 1 3B, 11 HR and 34 RBI with 19-22 SB. His 32 Extra base hits ranked 4th in the Eastern League at the time of his promotion and he ranked 8th with 74 hits.

MASONRY: First baseman Mason Martin homered in three straight games at Harrisburg beginning on Friday, June 30. It is the fourth time in his career that he's homered in three consecutive games, he previously homered in five straight games while playing for Greensboro in April of 2019 and homered in four straight games for Altoona in July of 2021.

THE BIG LEFTY: Altoona welcomed lefty Anthony Solometo to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. <u>At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in the Eastern League behind Somerset's Jasson Dominguez (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17.</u> Solometo has a 2.37 ERA in 4 starts for the Curve, he tossed 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings that ended on July 6. His 21 strikeouts since his debut rank T-3rd in the Eastern League. He leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.32 ERA and 89 strikeouts.

OUR NEW LEADERS: Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH) announced its intent to acquire the Curve from long-time owners Joan and Bob Lozinak on Wednesday, June 28. Mr. Bob and Joan brought the team in Altoona to begin play in 1999 owned the team for 18 of their 25 years as a franchise.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 19-of-25 games played. Altoona catchers have a .783 OPS this season, good f<u>or 7th-best among Double-A teams this season.</u>

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Friday, July 14, Altoona has struck out 643 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 6thfewest in minor league baseball.

THE CATS WHO FISH: Managed by Cesar Martin for a third straight season, the Fisher Cats feature several top Blue Jays prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 4 INF Orelvis Martinez, No. 7 RHP Sem Robberse, No. 19 INF Leo Jimenez, No. 23 RHP Adrian Hernandez, No. 25 RHP Trent Palmer, No. 26 INF Rainer Nunez, and No. 29 INF Damiano Palmegiani.

A MEOWMAN: Sem Robberse makes his second start of the season against Altoona, he struck out 8 in 4.2 IP allowing just 1 run against Altoona on Opening Day, April 6. Robberse was born in Zeist, Netherlands and is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 7 prospect in the Jays system. Robberse features a 4-pitch mix including a low-90's fastball that was showcased as a non-roster invitee to Blue Jays Spring Training this year. His younger brother Mees (pronounced "Mays") caught for the Netherlands' U18 team at the U18 World Cup and was invited to the 2022 MLB College Showcase tour.

#### **CAREER NOTES**

**2023:** Began the season with the KT Wiz of the Korean Baseball Organization and went 1-7 with a 5.62 ERA (31 ER / 49.2 IP) in nine starts before his release on June 9... Signed by the Pirates as a minor league free agent on June 30 and placed on the Development List, activated on July 14 and started against New Hampshire...

**2022:** Opened the season in the rotation for Indianapolis before he was selected to the Pirates major league roster on April 24... Made his major league debut April 26 against Milwaukee allowed 2 unearned runs in 2.2 IP of relief with 4 strikeouts... Made MLB debut on same day INF Tucupita Marcano and OF Jack Suwinski were recalled from Altoona to the Pirates roster... Totaled four appearances for the Pirates and allowed nine runs (four earned) in 9.2 IP with ten strikeouts... Was designated for assignment by the Pirates on May 12 and claimed by the Baltimore Orioles... Went on to make six appearances for the Orioles and recorded a 3.55 ERA (5 ER / 12.2 IP)... Spent the rest of the season with Triple-A Norfolk and was designated for assignment on October 14...

Selected to the Pirates roster on April 24, 2022... Designated for assignment on May 12 and claimed by Baltimore... Designated for assignment by the Orioles on October 14, 2022 and was granted free agency... Signed by the KT Wiz of the Korean Baseball Organization and was released on June 9, 2023... Signed to a minor league deal with the Pirates on June 30, 2023...

CURVE CUTS: Beau Grayson Sulser...Attended Ramona High School near San Diego...Played three years at the varsity level...Helped team to conference title as a sophomore and set a state high school record when he hit safely in 30 straight games... Brother, Cole, also pitched at Dartmouth and was a 25th round draft pick by the Cleveland Indians in 2013...
