

TRIPLE-R INFORMATION

On February 12, 2021, Major League Baseball announced its new plan for affiliated baseball, with 120 Minor League clubs officially agreeing to join the new Professional Development League (PDL).

In total, the new player development system includes 179 teams across 17 leagues in 43 states and four provinces. Including the AZL and GCL, there are 209 teams across 19 leagues in 44 states and four provinces. That includes the 150 teams in the PDL and AZL/GCL along with the four partner leagues: the American Association, Atlantic League, Frontier League and Pioneer League.


The long-time Triple-A structure of the International and Pacific Coast Leagues have been replaced by Triple-A East and Triple-A West. Triple-A East consists on 20 teams; all 14 from the International League, plus teams moving from the Pacific Coast League, the Southern League and the

independent Atlantic League. Triple-A West is comprised of nine Pacific Coast League teams and one addition from the Atlantic League.

These changes were made to help reduce travel and allow Major League teams to have their affiliates, in most cases, within 200 miles of the parent club (or play at their Spring Training facilities).

Due to COVID-19, the Toronto Blue Jays will play their home games at their Spring Training home in Dunedin, Florida, and at Buffalo's Sahlen Field. While the Blue Jays are utilizing the ballpark in Buffalo, the Bisons will call Trenton their temporary home. The Bison will play as the Trenton Thunder during home games, but use their own marks when traveling. Gregg Caserta will broadcast the Thunder/Bison game this season while Pat Malacaro remains in Buffalo to assist the Blue Jays.

Trenton was home to the Yankees' Double-A affiliate from 2003 until 2020. In 2019, the club won the Eastern League title. During the reorganization of Minor League Baseball, Trenton joined the MLB Draft League, which is slated to run from May 24 through August 13.

The RailRiders and IronPigs compete yearly in the "IronRail Series", complete with a trophy which spends the year in the front office of the victorious team. Despite Scranton/Wilkes-Barre owning a 107-82 lead in the all-time series, the rivalry has been particularly intense lately, with the trophy changing hands in four straight seasons. SWB claimed the trophy in the 2016 and 2018 seasons, while Lehigh Valley took home the Iron Rail in 2017 and 2019.

The IronPigs and RailRiders have also met in the Governor's Cup Semifinals three times -- 2016, 2017 and 2018. The RailRiders claimed all three of those series, sweeping the IronPigs in 2016, and winning the best-of-five series 3-1 in both 2017 and 2018.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Rochester Red Wings were the only team in the IL North to sweep the RailRiders in two series during the 2019 season. Despite compiling a stellar 53-39 record against divisional foes, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had difficulty solving Rochester, posting an 8-11 overall record -- and a dismal 1-7 record at Frontier Field. However, there is an asterisk next to the two sweeps for the Red Wings, as both came in two-game series at Rochester (6/24-25, 7/31-8/1).

LHP Daniel Camarena saw both sides of the series in 2019, making his first appearance of the season on April 24 for Rochester against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After allowing three runs on five hits in 4.1 innings, striking out six and issuing no walks in what would be his only appearance with the Red Wings, Camarena was released and signed with the Yankees. He made two starts for SWB against his short-time teammates, going 0-1 with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER/12.2 IP, 15 H, 3 BB, 13 K).

DID YOU KNOW?

Though they are now affiliated with the Mets and part of a heated I-81 rivalry with the RailRiders, the Syracuse franchise in the International League has a storied history as a New York Yankees affiliate. From 1967-77, the Syracuse Chiefs were the Triple-A affiliate of the Yankees, and won three International League titles -- 1969, 1970 and 1976. Syracuse has not won a Governor's Cup since 1976, the longest league championship drought of any team in Minor League Baseball.

Notable Yankees to suit up for the Syracuse Chiefs during this era include Thurman Munson (1969), Ron Blomberg (1970-71), and Ron Guidry (1975-76). Future Hall of Fame manager Bobby Cox not only played for Syracuse under its Yankees affiliation in 1970, but went on to manage the club from 1973-76. Cox was then promoted to first base coach on the Yankees MLB staff under Billy Martin in 1977 before being hired for his first managerial stint with the Atlanta Braves in 1978.


