TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue the second half of their season with a three-game set at Harrisburg.

LAST TIME OUT: The Curve dropped the fifth of six games with Akron to begin the seires. The Curve are now 1-11 against Akron at PNG Field this season.

THIS MONTH'S LEADERS: On their way to securing a winning record in the month of June (14-12), several Curve players ranked among the Eastern League leaderboards: INF Joe Perez ranked 4th in RBI (22), RHP Bubba Chandler ranked 7th in ERA (2,49), 2nd in W (3), 4th in WHIP (0.87) and T-2nd in strikeouts (35), Yoyner Fajardo ranked 9th in batting average (.324), and T-2nd in SB (8), and RHP Po-Yu Chen tossed a league-high 36.2 IP.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run four times in his last six outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.88 ERA (13 ER / 40.2 IP) with 31 strikeouts.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: On Thursday, June 27 at PNG Field, Bubba Chandler struck out a career-high 11 batters in 6.2 innings against Akron. One start after striking out 7 straight hitters and retiring 16 straight, Chandler struck out five in a row twice during his outing on Thursday. Chandler's second straight strikeout performance was just the third time in franchise history that a Curve pitcher had struck out 10-or-more batters in back-to-back outings joining Tyler Glasnow (7/21/15 vs Erie, 7/26/15 vs Akron) and Roansy Contreras (5/4/21 vs Bowie and 5/11 at Binghamton).

Chandler and **Braxton Ashcraft**'s combined four 10-strikeout games this season make the Curve one of six teams, and the lone team at Double-A or Triple-A, to have two pitchers strikeout 10 or more in a game twice.

Since his return from the IL on May 29, Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 29.1 IP with 38 strikeouts, recording a 3-2 record with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER / 29.1 IP) with a 0.89 WHIP. Chandler was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23), the first to receive the honor since **Mike Burrows** and **Quinn Priester** took home weekly honors during the 2022 season.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 6-of-7 games joining the Curve, batting 280/.438/.680/1.118 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 7 BB, and 5 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (82), 2B (17), RBI (55), T-1st in SB (15), and 1st in OPS (1.003), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

FEELING PEACHY: Infielder Kervin Pichardo turned in a massive effort at the plate on Thursday, June 20 at Bowie, aiding the Curve to a 10-8 win in 12 innings. Pichardo picked up a career-high 4 hits as part of a 4-for-5 day at the plate with a homer and 3 RBI in the win. Pichardo picked up a hit in 12 straight games from June 12-26, the 4th-longest streak in the Eastern League this season (.400/.438/.511/.949 with 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 RBI) and ranked 11th in the league in batting average (.317), 12th in hits (26) and T-7th in runs (16) during the calendar month.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo has reached base safely in 14 straight games, during which he's batting .351/.424/.386 with 2 2B, 5 RBI, 8 BB, 8-9 SB. His .324 batting average in June ranks 7th in the Eastern League during the calendar month.

K SPELLS TROUBLE: Altoona has struck out at least 10 times at the plate in a game 37 times this season in 75 games.

THE MEN FROM THE UPPER CHAMBER: Delino DeShields is back for his second season managing the Washington Nationals Double-A affiliate. Harrisburg features the next wave of Nationals stars highlighted by outfielders Robert Hassell III (IL), and Brady House. OF Dylan Crews was promoted to Triple-A with 6 games remaining in the first half and the Senators narrowly missed out on the SouthWest Division title.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Kyle Luckham makes his third start against Altoona this season. In two outings this season against Altoona, he's allowed 5 runs in 9.0 IP with 10 K's, starting on April 9 and May 4 against the Curve. Luckham was Washington's 15th round pick in 2022 out of Arizona State and Spent all but one game of his season last year at Wilmington, making one start for the Senators at the end of the season. Luckham began his collegiate career at CSU-Fullerton and finished at ASU in 2022. Luckham told Fullerton Sports Information that he models his game after former Nationals RHP Max Scherzer.

CURVE CUTS: Drake Robert Fellows... Went 13-2 with a 4.09 ERA in his final season for the NCAA Champion Vanderbilt Commodores... Majored in sociology at Vandy... He has been hit harder and battled his control more than in his first two seasons.
