LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox defeated the Patriots 3-2 in front of over 6,800 on Navy Night on Friday. **Samuel Basallo** collected three hits and knocked in two runs, including a solo homer in the fifth and a go-ahead RBI double in the seventh. **Frederick Bencosme** tallied two more hits and **Alfredo Velasquez** recorded his first three-hit game at Double-A. **Cam-eron Weston** threw 5.1 innings of one-run ball, **Lincoln Henzman** threw two perfect innings of relief and **Keagan Gillies** earned his sixth save of the year.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the 7th-most hits in the Eastern League (90) and is 4th in total bases (148). Last night, Basallo recorded his fifth three-hit game of the season, the most on the team. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 3rd-most homers by a teenager in MiLB (14) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit homers in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in '18.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-hit game at Double-A on Wednesday and collected two more hits on Friday. The Orioles No. 24 prospect is on a nine-game hitting streak. During his hit streak, he's batting .455 (15-for-33) with four doubles, a homer and five RBI. In the series, Bencosme is 10-for-15.

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is the Eastern League's active leader in home runs and is tied for fifth in all of Double-A after hitting his 16th of the season on Tuesday. The O's No. 8 prospect has 31 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** registered his first multi-homer game of his career last Wednesday in Akron with his 10th and 11th homers of the season, matching his season total from last year. The 22-year-old has reached base in 68 of 85 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (45) and stolen bases (24), tied for 6th-most and tied for 3rd-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B/OF **TT Bowens** delivered arguably his best performance of his career on Wednesday. The 26-year-old recorded his first multi-homer game, his first grand slam and his first six RBI game of his career. His 52 RBI and 32 extra base hits this season are 9th-most and tied for 8th-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .360 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .529 and OPS of .969. The 23-year-old has RBI in two of the three games in this series and has collected a hit in four straight contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 20 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

PREVIEWING THE PATRIOTS

Entering this week, the Somerset Patriots are 0.5 game out of the Northeast Division lead with a second-half record of 16-11. The Patriots share the league lead for the most homers this season and own the third-best OPS. Six of the Yankees top 30 prospects are on the Patriots active roster - OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), RHP Chase Hampton (No. 3), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 19), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 20), IF Tyler Hardman (No. 25), RHP Danny Watson (No. 27)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Ben Shields makes his fifth start of the season for the Patriots. The 25-year-old is in his first professional season after spending the last five seasons in college. He spent three years at UMass and two at George Mason. The southpaw began his pro career with High-A Hudson Valley and posted a 2.75 ERA in 52.1 innings with 71 strikeouts over 10 walks. In four starts with Somerset, Shields has a 2.08 ERA in 21.2 innings.

Owns a 5.56 ERA in six second half starts. Recorded a 4.08 ERA in the first half. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 4.86 ERA in nine home starts. Baysox are 5-14 when Bright starts. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
