## **CHARLOTTE EDGES JACKSONVILLE 5-4**

Despite a two-run home run by Jacob Amaya, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 5-4 to the Charlotte Knights Thursday evening in front of 6,760 fans. Jacksonville (21-25) put up a pair of runs in the opening frame to take an early lead. Brian Miller reached on an infield single, and Amaya (4) lifted a high fly ball over the right-field bleachers to put the Jumbo Shrimp ahead 2-0. After a back and forth game Victor Reyes tied the game with a solo homer in the eighth. Stephen Piscotty homered in the ninth, putting the Knights ahead for the final time.

### 'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a sevengame stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 24 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 46 runs, 39 earned, on 88 hits (6.5 H/9) in 122.2 innings for a 1.83 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 137 strikeouts (10.1 K/9) against 69 walks (5.1 BB/9) during this recent run.

## WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 190 free passes over the last 38 games since April 11, a figure that ranks fifth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 12.7 percent of their plate appearances. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games of 2023.

### **AUSTIN POWERS**

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 17 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 19-for-58 (.328/.409/.724/1.133) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, eight walks and 12 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances in 2022, Allen has whiffed just 18.3% of the time this season. His .173 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 178 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

### KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot since then. Over the last 23 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 22-for-75 (.293/.459/.440/.899) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBIs and a remarkable 23 walks. On the entirety of the 2023 campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (35) nearly as much he has struck out (39). Leblanc ranks fourth in the International League in walk percentage (21.2 percent) and in total walks (35). His swinging-strike rate of 7.9 percent is tied for the 25th-lowest out of the IL's 178 qualified hitters.

### THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 44-for-142 (.310/.344/.444/.788) with 10 doubles, three triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, six walks and 13 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 178 qualified players in the IL, Mangum is tied for the seventh-highest line drive rate (32.1 percent) and eighth-highest opposite-field rate (42.1 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

### **NOT THIS WAY**

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightly of late. Over their last 18 games, they've combined to surrender 73 runs, 70 earned, on 88 hits (13.3 H/9) in 59.2 innings for a 10.55 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 45 (6.8 BB/9) against only 41 strikeouts (6.2 K/9).

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost 11 of their last 15 games, including seven of their last nine affairs... The Jumbo Shrimp have fallen four games below .500 since starting the 2022 campaign 3-7. Prior to that, Jacksonville hadn't been four games below .500 since 2019.

## ABOUT JEFF

- -A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.
- -Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.
- -An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

## 2022 SEASON

-Lingren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoo's between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lingren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

### 2021 SEASON

- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.
- -Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).
- -When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

## 2019 SEASON

- -With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.
- -With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

## **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
