LAST GAME OUT

(Fri, April 5) - The Scranton/Wilkes Barre RailRiders defeated the Syracuse Mets 8-4 on Friday night at PNC Field. The RailRiders set a franchise record with 15 walks in the contest. Jose Rojas and Caleb Durbin each homered in the win.

After Caleb Durbin and Carlos Narvaez drew back-to-back walks in the first inning, Rojas took a cutter 342-feet into right field for his second home run of the year to put the RailRiders up 3-0.

The Mets battled back in the top of the second when Ben Gamel hit a two-run homer into right field. Narvaez ended the frame by throwing out the stealing Rylan Bannon at second base to keep it 3-2.

In the bottom of the frame, Syracuse starter Dom Hamel faced eight Scranton/Wilkes-Barre batters walking four straight scoring. Jordan Groshans and Brandon Lockridge came across the plate to put the home team up by three. The Mets chipped away in the fourth to get down by just one run. Gamel doubled to reach and Austin Allen hit a two-run shot off of Phil Bickford, who was making his RailRiders debut.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre put up some insurance runs in the home half of the sixth. Greg Allen worked a walk and Durbin made it 7-4 with a 346-foot two-run bomb to left field for the RailRiders. It was his first home run of the season. A little later, Durbin led off the eighth with a walk and quickly stole second and third. After Narvaez got a free pass as well, Everson Pereira was hit by a pitch to load the bases. With their franchise record setting 15th walk of the evening, the RailRiders added another thanks to a Rojas walk for an 8-4 victory.

The #18 Yankees prospect Yoendrys Gómez pitched three innings giving up three hits, two runs, and two strikeouts. Cody Morris and Josh Maciejewski (W, 1-0) each had scoreless appearances. Ron Marinaccio slammed the door shut in the ninth.

NEWS & NOTES

WALK THIS WAY - Last night, the RailRiders recorded 15 total walks in the contest to set a new single game franchise-high. Prior to this, SWB had 14 walks in a contest back on August 17, 1998 at Buffalo. Eight of nine starters recorded at least one. Six batters got two free passes and both Caleb Durbin and Carlos Narvaez recorded three.

DURBINVILLE - Caleb Durbin has been electric in his start in Triple-A. With a pair of hits last night, he has had three-multi hit games. Durbin hit his first home run of the season adding another three runs batted in for a team-high eight. The right-hander is batting .526 while getting the start in every game this season. Caleb Durbin has worked a five-game hitting streak in his first few games as a RailRider. The 24-year-old got aboard in all five plate appearances last night, marking nine straight consecutive at-bats where he reached safely. He also has a team-high four stolen bases. Durbin was originally drafted by Atlanta in 2021 but was traded to New York along with Indigo Diaz for LHP Lucas Luetge.

RUNNING MAN - The RailRiders recorded four steals last night with two each from Caleb Durbin and Kevin Smith. Durbin and Brandon Lockridge lead the team with four each. SWB is tied for third in Triple-A with Tacoma having 19. The RailRiders stole a season high 174 bases last summer.

MACIE MAGIC - Reliever Josh Maciejewski has impressed in the bullpen to start this season. He has had back-to-back clean appearances for 4.2 quiet innings of work. Maciejewski has allowed just two hits and a walk. The southpaw has had five total strikeouts and recorded his first win in last night's contest.

BIG LEAGUE BEETER - Starter Clayton Beeter began the season by making his first Opening Day roster. The righty made his New York Yankees debut on March 29 at Houston. He entered in the ninth inning and threw just three innings to confirm the Yankees 7-1 win. Beeter allowed a single to Jose Altuve, got an interesting double play, and then a flyout to end the frame.

NARVI NEWS - Catcher Carlos Narvaez caught his first runner stealing of the season yesterday. With Yoendrys Gómez pitching, Narvaez threw down to second to get Ryan Bannon. Narvi is now 1-5 in nabbing runners.

HOME HELP - The RailRiders won their first home game of the season last night to move to 3-2. Last season, SWB did most of their winning in the confines of PNC Field going 42-32 at home.

DOUBLE DIP - SWB plays its first doubleheader of the season today with the first game beginning at 2:05 PM. It is single admission games with two seven inning contests. This game is the makeup from Tuesday night's rainout.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top outfielding prospect Everson Pereira (#6 per MLB Pipeline) alongside starting pitchers Will Warren (#8), Clayton Beeter (#14), and Yoendrys Gómez (#18).

ORIGINALLY DRAFTED: Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

FUTURE FARMHAND: Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

CAREER:
 • **2023:** In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP... Split the 2023 season with Double-A Somerset (12GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (15G/14GS), combining to go 9-7 with a 3.62 ERA (131.2IP, 105H, 54R/53ER, 75BB, 165K, 18HR) in 27 games (26 starts)... among Yankees farmhands, ranked 2nd in strikeouts, 3rd in starts and 4th in wins, innings pitched and opponents' batting average (.216)... his 165K also ranked eighth among all minor league pitchers... Began the season with Double-A Somerset, going 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA (60.2IP, 44H, 14R/ER, 31BB, 76K, 3HR) in 12 starts... was named the Eastern League's "Pitcher of the Week" from 6/5-11 after going 2-0 and tossing a combined 11.0 scoreless innings over two starts at Hartford on 6/6 and 6/11 (6H, 4BB, 17K, 3HP)... Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
