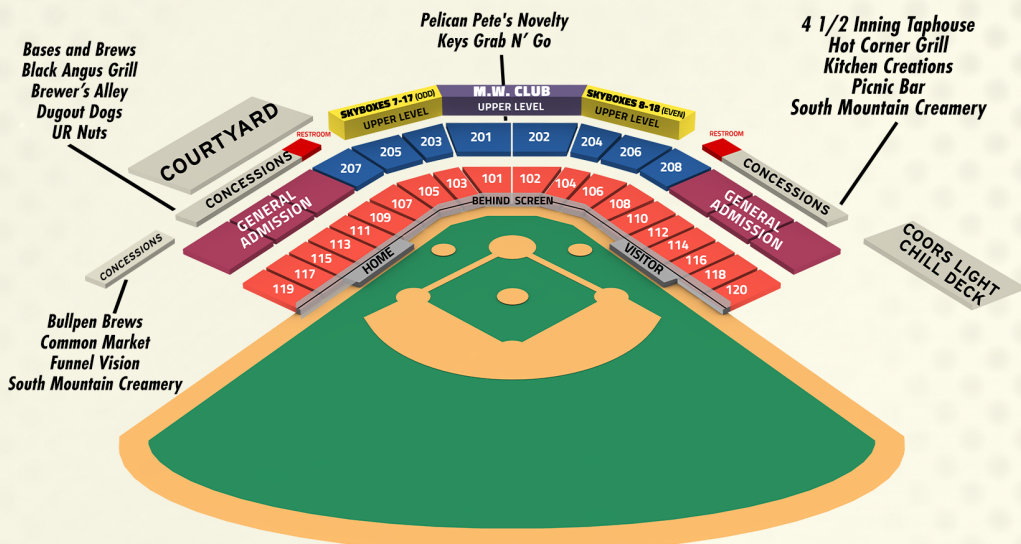



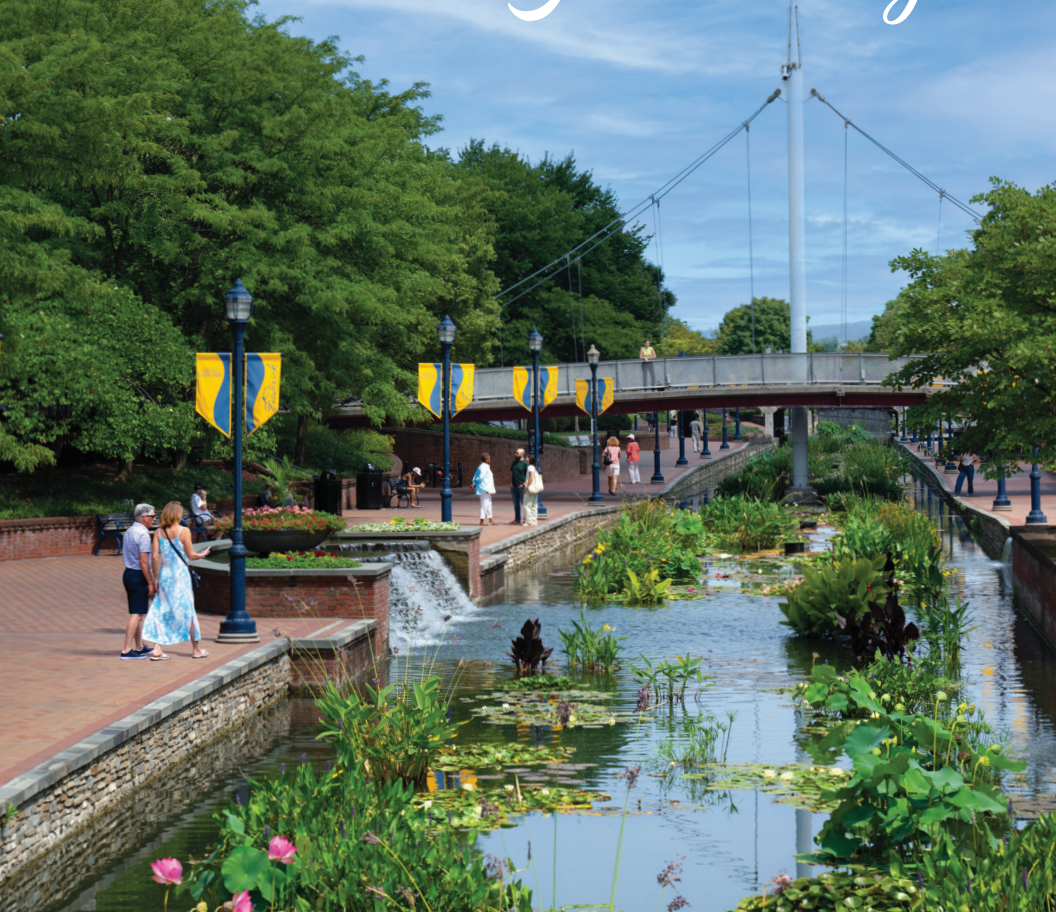

MEET THE MANAGER: COLLIN WOODY

When the Keys take the field this season in their first year back in Birdland, a familiar face will lead the team as former Keys infielder Collin Woody was named the 28th manager in team history on February 3.

Woody, who played in 79 games for the Keys back in 2018, takes over as manager after serving two years as the manager for the Orioles Single-A affiliate Delmarva Shorebirds. During his time in Salisbury, he finished with over 100 wins and led all teams in the Carolina League last year in the second half with 11.1 strikeouts per game.

Prior to his time with Delmarva, he spent two seasons in Sarasota as the FCL Orioles Fundamentals Coach in the 2022 and 2023 campaigns, helping guide a top-ranked Orioles farm system before getting his first taste as manager the following season.

As a player, Woody arrived to the Orioles after being drafted in the 38th round of the MLB Draft following a standout college career at UNC Greensboro. After playing for both the Shorebirds and the former Class A Short Season affiliate Aberdeen IronBirds, he received the call to Frederick where he finished with 10 home runs and 33 RBIs in his 79-game stint in the Key City.

Ever since he changed his career path to the coaching ranks, the Tampa, Florida native has also circled Frederick as a top place for future Orioles prospects to call home.

"I'm excited to be part of the crew that welcomes the Orioles back to Frederick," said Woody. "When I was a player in the system, it was always everyone's favorite affiliate that they talked about. I'm excited to continue to watch the players grow and develop and I think everyone is just as excited as I am and I'm just the lucky one that gets to be there."

As the Keys prepare to enter a new era of baseball beginning this April, Woody feels poised and prepared to take Frederick to new heights, as the Keys are once again back in Birdland.



FORMER KEY TURNED THIRD BASE COACH

Former Frederick Keys infielder Buck Britton is returning to Baltimore this upcoming season under new Orioles manager Craig Albarnaz, where he will serve as the team's third base coach for a second straight season.

Britton became the interim third-base coach following the promotion of former third-base coach Tony Mansolino to Orioles manager last May. Prior to his position as third base coach for the Orioles, Britton served as manager for the Orioles Triple-A affiliate Norfolk Tides from 2022-24. While there, he guided the Tides to their first International League Championship since 1985. Additionally, Britton was named the 2023 International League Manager of the Year after finishing with a 90-59 record that same season.

Prior to his stint in Norfolk, Britton served as manager for both the Orioles Single-A affiliate Delmarva Shorebirds and the Double-A affiliate Bowie (now Chesapeake) Baysox. During his stint with the Baysox from 2019-2021, he led the team to two appearances in the Eastern League Championship Series and capped off his time in Bowie with 149 wins.

Heading into the 2026 season, Albarnaz had lots of positive remarks regarding Britton, who is one of the returning pieces to the Orioles coaching staff for the 2026 campaign.

"Buck's been awesome this camp," said Albarnaz. "The attention to detail is as high as I have ever seen from a coach. The biggest thing for me is he is the same person every day and that's something that I value on a coaching staff."



Before the start of his coaching career, the Panorama City, California native was drafted by the Orioles in the 35th round in 2008 and went on to play in Frederick from 2009-2011. During his time in the Key City, Britton played 138 games with 99 coming in 2010. His best season came in 2011 when he finished with a .341 average across 25 games with three homers all while driving in 30 RBIs.

As Britton prepares to help the Orioles get back to the playoff race this season, he'll look to lean on his experience from his days as a player and manager to get Baltimore back to where it belongs.

AROUND THE SOUTH ATLANTIC LEAGUE

With the Keys moving back to affiliated baseball in 2026, that means they are moving leagues and will be joining the South Atlantic League. The South Atlantic League has been around since 1963 and has tradition and history going as far back as 1903. 2026 represents the sixth season that the league will feature High-A affiliated teams after much of it's time as a Class A league.



The league is also one of three High-A affiliated teams in Minor League Baseball with the other two including the Midwest League and the Northwest League. The Midwest League contains 12 teams and the Northwest League containing six teams.

Frederick will compete alongside several High-A affiliates up and down the east coast, with most of their major league teams residing in the Northeast. The other teams in the league include the Asheville Tourists (Astros), Bowling Green Hot Rods (Rays), Brooklyn Cyclones (Mets), Greensboro Grasshoppers (Pirates), Greenville Drive (Red Sox), Hub City Spartanburgers (Rangers), Hudson Valley Renegades (Yankees), Jersey Shore

BlueClaws (Phillies), Rome Emperors (Braves), Wilmington Blue Rocks (Nationals), and Winston-Salem Dash (White Sox).

The Keys will compete in the North Division of the South Atlantic League with the Cyclones, Grasshoppers, Renegades, BlueClaws, and Blue Rocks. The winners of the first and second half of each division will compete in a best-of-three series to decide who plays in the South Atlantic League Championship Series. The winner of that series wins the overall South Atlantic League Championship and will join last year's winner, the Brooklyn Cyclones, in the record books.

Frederick will have several familiar opponents on their schedule dating back to their time in the Carolina League: the Wilmington Blue Rocks and the Winston-Salem Dash. All the other opponents will be playing against the Keys for the first time.

The first several homestands of the season will have the Keys face off against the Renegades and Blue Rocks in the month of April, with the first South Atlantic League South opponent, the Greenville Drive, coming to town on May 19. Frederick will also host Jersey Shore in the first full week of May beginning on May 5.

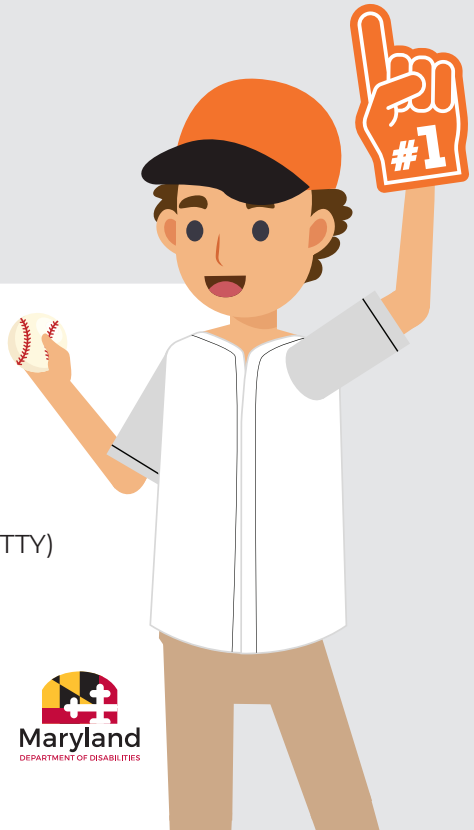

KEYS IN THE WORLD BASEBALL CLASSIC

The World Baseball Classic (WBC) concluded on March 17 with Venezuela taking down the United States in the championship game by a score of 3-2. Throughout the classic, many players displayed their talents, with several players having ties to the Frederick Keys.

Four former Keys players competed in the tournament including: infielders Manny Machado and Zach Dezenzo, left-handed pitcher Alex Wells, and right-handed pitcher Dean Kremer. Additionally, several top Orioles prospects participated in the field throughout the Classic including top-ranked outfielder Enrique Bradfield Jr.

Machado guided the Dominican Republic team to a quarterfinals appearance after recording three hits in four games. Along with his .250 average, he has posted a .526 on-base percentage after drawing six walks while striking out only three times. He ended up going 1-4 in the semifinal game against the United States while playing third base throughout the night.

Wells pitched in two games for Australia during pool play and finished with six innings pitched and allowing only two runs. He also finished second on the team in strikeouts with nine and gave up two walks, helping his home country finish third in Pool C behind Japan and Korea.

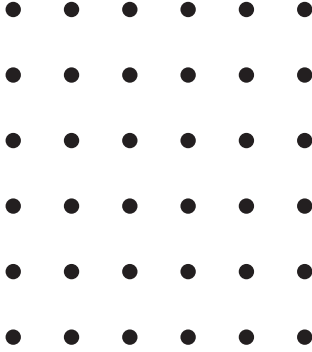
Kremer finished the World Baseball Classic with one start on his tab and helped record the first shutout in Team Israel history, throwing 4.1 innings scoreless against Nicaragua on Sunday night. He also recorded four strikeouts and allowed one walk and was the lone starting pitcher on the Israel roster to record a 0.00 ERA.

As for Dezenzo, he played an integral role helping his home country of Italy finish with a 4-0 record in pool play, which included a historic win over the United States on Tuesday, March 10 in Houston. In four games, he has recorded three hits and an RBI, but most importantly provided insurance in the middle infield alongside star infielders Vinnie Pasquantino and Andrew Fischer. In their team's semifinal loss to Venezuela, Dezenzo went 2-4 while scoring in a run off a bases-loaded walk, and served as the team's designated hitter.

The next World Baseball Classic has not officially been announced, but will take place in 2029 or 2030. More information about the tournament is set to be released in the months and years ahead.



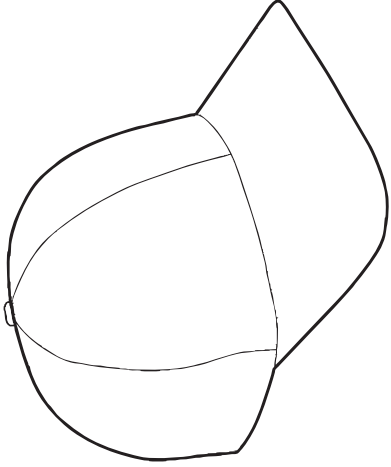
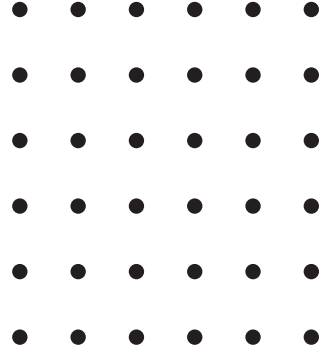

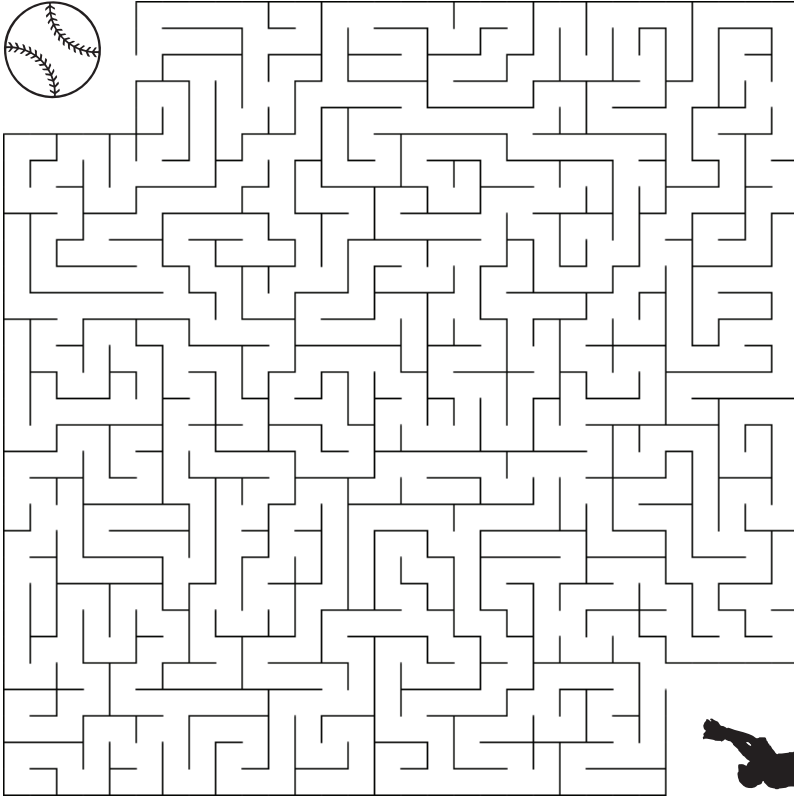

TOP PROSPECTS COMPETE IN SPRING BREAKOUT

The Baltimore Orioles held their annual Spring Breakout Game back on March 20 at Ed Smith Stadium in Sarasota, Florida, taking down the Boston Red Sox top prospects by a score of 3-1.

During the nine-inning showcase, the Orioles found their offense late, which was led by a two-run bottom of the seventh inning off two RBIs from designated hitter Wilfri De La Cruz, as they held on to the two-run lead in the final two frames to win their Spring Breakout game in Sarasota.



Throughout the night, a total of 21 prospects suited up for Baltimore including third-ranked Orioles prospect and outfielder Nate George, who finished 1-3 with a double in the top of the order. Infielder Aron Estrada brought the home team their first run of the night in the bottom of the sixth on an RBI groundout, as Baltimore finished with three runs on nine hits en route to the home victory.

Other notable standouts include rising star and outfielder Vance Honeycutt, who earlier in Spring Training made

headlines after homering in his first four at-bats to begin the 2026 campaign strong. Outfielder Reed Trimble finished his evening 2-3 at the dish and guided the Baltimore defense to not allowing an error throughout the night.

On the mound, 14th-ranked Orioles prospect and left-handed pitcher Joseph Dzierwa earned the win after throwing three innings of scoreless ball to close out the game, capping off his outing by recording eight strikeouts on only 46 pitches. Reigning Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Year and right-hander Trey Gibson started the night off strong after only allowing one hit and no runs in three innings pitched.

Along with three innings of one-run ball thrown by right-handed reliever and 12th-ranked Orioles prospect Nestor German, the pitching staff combined to record 14 strikeouts while not allowing any walks throughout the evening.

The Orioles concluded Spring Training play with a record of 13-13-3 prior to Opening Day which placed them sixth in the Grapefruit League Standings. The Atlanta Braves ended up finishing first in the same league with a record of 20-17-2 on the year.

FREDERICK KEYS FAN BEHAVIOR POLICY

The Frederick Keys are committed to creating a family-friendly and welcoming environment at the ballpark for all guests. As part of that commitment, we have adopted this written policy addressing fan behavior. The policy includes a Fan Code of Conduct, which is fan-facing and describes how fans are expected to behave.

All Frederick Keys staff, including game-day staff, must receive a copy of this policy before working any games. In addition, all staff must receive annual training on this policy, the substance of the Fan Code of Conduct, and how to respond to prohibited fan behavior. All training will be documented.

A copy of the Fan Code of Conduct can be found at any entrance gate to the ballpark, at any guest services booth, on www.FrederickKeys.com, and in the official game program.

Fans will be notified before and during the game through public service announcements (“PSAs”) on the main video board that summarize the Fan Code of Conduct, the penalties for violation, and how to report prohibited behavior.

Reporting An Incident

Any game-day staff member who witnesses or receives a report of prohibited fan behavior by a fan must report the incident to a Club security supervisor. This can be done by contacting your immediate supervisor, notifying a nearby security staff member, or by contacting (301) 662-0013.

Use of derogatory language by a fan toward a player, umpire, Club staff, or their family members must be documented by the Club and reported to the Club’s General Manager and to the Commissioner’s Office via email to PDLsecurity@mlb.com. Clubs must seek to collect the name and identifying information of the fan and must include in their report a description of how the Club addressed the incident and any planned discipline.

Fan Code of Conduct

In order to provide a welcoming experience for all, the Frederick Keys have implemented a Fan Code of Conduct. Out of respect for fellow guests, players, coaches, and ballpark staff, all guests are prohibited from:

- Trespassing on the playing field at any time;
- Interfering with baseballs that are in play;
- Throwing or tossing objects;
- Using foul, obscene or derogatory language (see below) or gestures;
- Misusing or overconsuming alcohol, including, underage consumption;
- Behaving in a manner that is disruptive, unruly, or abusive;
- Accessing areas of the ballpark without a proper ticket, pass, or credential;
- Misusing tickets, passes, or credentials in any way; or
- Bringing prohibited items into the ballpark.

Derogatory language is defined as offensive language concerning a person’s race, ethnicity, gender, religion, disability, age, sexual orientation, or national origin, and anyone using such language is subject to automatic ejection from the ballpark.

Violations of the Fan Code of Conduct will not be tolerated and may lead to ejection from the ballpark, a ban on attending future games, or other consequences. Guests who are found to have used derogatory language will be ejected from the ballpark.

Guests are encouraged to report violations of the Fan Code of Conduct to the nearest ballpark staff member. This can be done in person, at the nearest Guest Services location, directly with Ballpark Security or by calling (301) 662-0013.
