**HOME RUNS APLENTY BUT LATE SEA DOGS RALLY DOWNS 'CATS:** Samad Taylor and Chavez Young both homered, but the Fisher Cats gave up four runs in the top of the ninth to snatch defeat from the jaws of victory. The Fisher Cats were held to just three hits on the evening as the Sea Dogs took game five of the series.

**SEA DOG DAYS ARE OVER, FOR NOW:** The Fisher Cats are facing the Sea Dogs for the 12<sup>th</sup> time in 18 games today, and hold a record of just three wins and eight losses against their New England rivals. The Sea Dogs and Fisher Cats will meet for a whopping 24 more games over the course of this season.

**THE STREAKS:** Otto López went 1-for-3 to extend his hit streak to Double-A Northeast-leading fifteen games....Gabriel Moreno, recently added to *Baseball America's* Top 100 Prospects list, has now reached base in a career-best 12 straight games. He lost his 11-game hitting streak last night, but did reach base via a walk to extend his on-base streak.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** May 23, 2019—the Fisher Cats completed a three-game sweep of the Altoona Curve with a 7-2 win at Delta Dental Stadium. Patrick Murphy allowed one run over six innings to pick up his third win. He struck out seven batters. Kevin Smith drove in three runs and Alberto Mineo homered.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays dropped their second straight to the Rays, losing 3-1. The Bisons fell to Worcester, 7-4, as Jarren Duran had a five-hit, two home run game for the WooSox. Dunedin dropped a 5-3 contest to Clearwater, and Hillsboro rode Massachusetts native Matt Tabor's stellar start to victory over the Vancouver Canadians.

**COMING UP:** Next week, the Fisher Cats will head to New Jersey to wrap up the season series with the Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees Double-A affiliate). Following that, the Fisher Cats will return home to Delta Dental Stadium to face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (New York Mets) starting on June 1.

**ON THE HILL:** Elvis Luciano will look to pick up his first win of the season, facing the Sea Dogs for the third time of his four starts. He will be going against Josh Winckowski, who has a stellar 1.88 ERA and is limiting opposing batters to just a .132 batting average.
