INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Liover Peguero crushed a go-ahead solo home run in the top of the ninth inning, lifting the Indianapolis Indians to a 3-2 defeat of the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp on Friday night at 121 Financial Ballpark. Tied 2-2 in the top of the ninth, Peguero launched his fourth home run of the season to give the Indians an advantage. The solo shot was Peguero's second round-tripper in as many days after hitting a solo homer in Thursday night's victory. Indianapolis opened the scoring with a two-run second inning courtesy of a Matt Fraizer single to score Malcom Nuñez and Canaan Smith-Njigba. The trio combined for four of Indy's five hits in the contest, with Nuñez's 2-for-4 performance leading the pack. The Jumbo Shrimp responded in the bottom half to tie the game with a pair of RBI singles from Jonathan Davis and Javier Sanoja.

WON WITH ONE RUN: Last night's one-run victory marked the Indians first one-run win on the road since April 10 at Toledo. They are now 8-13 in one-run games with a 2-10 record in those contests on the road. Last night was also the Indians first win in their last offensive inning on the road since Billy McKinney singled home Nick Gonzales in the top of the ninth inning on April 10.

BACK-TO-BACK: The Indians have now won consecutive games at Jacksonville with a 4-1 victory on Thursday and 3-2 win last night. It was the first time they have won back-to-back games since May 26 at Iowa and May 27 vs. Omaha, the first time they have done so against the same opponent since winning three straight vs. Buffalo from April 30-May 2.

WELCOME, WOODFORD: Right-hander Jake Woodford tossed 6.0 two-run innings with no walks and seven strikeouts last night in his Pirates organization debut. The 27-year-old was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10. He began the season with Charlotte and went 1-3 with a 5.26 ERA (29er/49.2ip) and 42 strikeouts in 10 games (10 starts). His best start of the season came on May 12 at Gwinnett, when he tossed 7.0 shutout innings with a season-high tying eight strikeouts. Woodford made two starts with Chicago (AL) before being designated for assignment and released. In 73 Triple-A appearances (71 starts) since 2018, he is 19-24 with a 4.19 ERA (169er/363.0ip) and 305 strikeouts.

ROLLING WITH THE PEN: The Indianapolis bullpen has been nearly untouchable this week, allowing just one run in 12.0 innings across the first four games at Jacksonville. Since Brady Feigl allowed one run in the series-opener on Tuesday, Nick Dombkowski (2.2ip, 0h), Geronimo Franzua (1.1ip, 4k), Chris Gau (1.2ip), Brent Honeywell (2.0ip, 1sw, 1h) and Connor Sadzeck (2.0ip, 1h) have shut down the Jumbo Shrimp offense.

LIOVER LAUNCHES ANOTHER: Liover Peguero launched his fourth home run of the season and second in as many days last night in the ninth inning at Jacksonville to give the Indians a series-knotting victory. It was the first time he hit homers in back-to-back games since Aug. 28-29 with High-A Greensboro at Asheville, having done so in three times that season including a career-high four-game home run streak from July 29-Aug. 1. The solo homer was his second hit of the series, marking his fifth game in eight June contests with at least one hit — four of those six hits have come for extra bases.

CANAAN FOR A COUPLE: Canaan Smith-Njigba has been an extra-base hit machine this season and especially in the month of June, with five of his six hits in 12 games coming for extra-bases. He has scored a run, doubled and drawn a walk in each of the last two games at Jacksonville, leading to Indy tying the series at two games apiece.

MALCOM FOR TWO: Malcom Nuñez recorded his third multi-hit performance of June and 15th over the course of the season in last night's win over Jacksonville, marking the only multi-hit game by an Indians batter. He singled and scored a run in the second inning on Matt Fraizer's two-run base knock, coming around to plate the Indians first run of the contest. He's been true to his average during the month, hitting .257 (9-for-35) across 12 June games, while his batting average for the season sits at .255 (53-for-208) in 60 games.

TONIGHT'S PROBABLES: In the fifth game of the six-game series between the Indians and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp at 121 Financial Ballpark, the Indians will send RHP Luis Cessa (2-2, 3.89) in his Pirates organization debut after being signed by a minor league free agent on June 10. He made one start against Jacksonville with Omaha earlier this season, tossing 3.2 four-run innings (three earned) with four strikeouts on May 9. It was his first career start vs. Jacksonville. Countering for the Jumbo Shrimp will be RHP Jonathan Bermúdez (1-0, 6.75) for his second appearance (first start) with Jacksonville this season.

AFFILIATES TO ADVERSARIES: This week marks the first time the Indians have played a team from Jacksonville since they last faced a different franchise in the International League during the 1963 season. The current Jacksonville franchise served under Indianapolis as the Double-A affiliate to the Montreal Expos from 1985-90, with a roster boasting future Hall of Famers Randy Johnson and Larry Walker before they became Indians. With the realignment of Minor League Baseball in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp moved from the Double-A Southern League to the International League.

THIS DATE IN 1997: The Indians and Western Division leading New Orleans battled it out in a 14-inning marathon that lasted just three hours and 41 minutes. Despite Indy outpitching New Orleans, 10-9, the Zephyrs came back from a 1-0 deficit in the bottom of the 14th with a two-run home run off the bat of catcher Randy Knorr, who came off the bench in the middle of the game. Scott Service took the loss after surrendering two hits in the 14th without getting an out.
