REHABBING TYLER MAHLE TOSSES PAIR OF SCORELESS INNINGS IN 6-1 LOSS:
The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 6-1 on Tuesday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (8-5, 52-30) starter and Major League rehabber **Tyler Mahle** worked a pair of scoreless, one-hit innings while striking out two. **Josh Stephan** (2-5) needed just seven pitches to down the Naturals (6-7, 41-41) in the top of the third, but Northwest Arkansas opened the scoring with a two-run homer by Josh Lester in the top of the fourth. In the top of the sixth inning, the Naturals extended their lead as Rodolfo Duran drove in Tyler Tolbert with a single. Luca Tresh delivered an RBI single to plate Duran, giving the Naturals a 4-0 advantage. Northwest Arkansas tacked on a pair of runs in the top of the seventh, using a two-run double by Duran to push the lead to 6-0. Stephan finished after 4.2 relief innings, surrendering six runs on ten hits and no walks with four punchouts. **Andy Rodriguez** worked 2.1 scoreless frames, retiring all seven batters he faced while striking out one. The RoughRiders found the scoreboard in the bottom of the eighth inning on a leadoff homer by **Alejandro Osuna**, cutting the Naturals lead to 6-1. Offensively, the Riders managed just six hits with **Liam Hicks** collecting the lone multi-hit performance. The top four in the lineup provided five of the six bits collecting the lone multi-hit performance. hits, going 5-for-15.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 28-11 at Riders Field this season. Their 28 wins and .717 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and second among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +65 run differential, a 3.50 ERA and is averaging 5.5 runs per game with a .735 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 24-19 with a 3.45 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .631 OPS. **Cody Freeman** is slashing .353/.400/.602/1.002 at home this season with seven of his 10 home runs. His .353 batting average is the best in the Texas League play a player at their home stadium. In their series against Arkansas, the Riders went 1-2 in North Little Rock, being outscored 7-5 in their three games. At home in three games, Frisco outscored the Travelers 22-9.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:
Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In eight games, he is hitting .371 (13-for-35)/.389/.800/1.189 with five doubles, two triples, two home runs and seven RBIs. During a five-game hitting streak, he is batting .455 (10-for-22)/.478/1.045/1.523 with three doubles, two triples, two home runs and seven RBIs. On Friday, he went 2-for-5 with a triple and a home run, tying his career-high with five RBIs. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game. In the first inning, Osuna is hitting .571 (4-for-7) with three doubles for the Riders.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh last Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has clubbed four home runs in his last 13 games with two of them being game-winners. In July, he is batting .296 (8-for-27)/.321/.481/.802. This season, he has a career highs in average (.278), slugging percentage (.465) and OPS (.795) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (68) and home runs (18).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (47) while also ranking first in fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 81 double plays are the most in the Texas League, second among non-Triple-A teams and seventh in all of Minor League Baseball. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (58), throwing out 25 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.97 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their series opener against Northwest Arkansas on Tuesday, the bullpen allowed six runs (all from normal starter Josh Stephan, who worked out of the bullpen because of rehabber Tyler Mahle). Those six runs were the most the the bullpen had allowed in a game since April 23rd against Amarillo. That tied for the second-most allowed, with nine runs allowed in the second game of the season (4/6 at Wichita) marking the most. In their last six series, spanning 38 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 2.19 ERA (35ER/143.1IP).

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 28 games, the Riders have allowed just 75 earned runs over 256.1 IP (2.63 ERA). Two Saturdays ago, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 14 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 37 game (5/23 vs. MID). In their last 40 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 14 times and 11 times in the last 28

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

WERE GOING DANCING:
Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a 1.60 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning completegame, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA).

-Tossed first QS of the year on 6/19 at MID, allowing two-run single on final pitch of the outing before the batter was backpicked at first to end the inning.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
