SUBWAY SERIES: The Hudson Valley Renegades welcome in the Brooklyn doubles during this span in all of Minor League baseball. Cyclones to Heritage Financial Park for the second and final time this season. The Cyclones have won the first two series by winning four out of the six games in each meeting. Although, the Renegades clinched the South Atlantic League North First Half Championship on June 20 in Brooklyn after no-hitting the Cyclones through 8.1 innings. The Renegades make one more trip to Maimonides Park in August.

Valley Renegades fell to the Brooklyn Cyclones 8-7 on Friday night. Hudson a season-high three in Brooklyn on June 21st. Valley jumped out to a 3-1 lead early, highlighted by a Spencer Henson solo-home run. After the Cyclones took a 4-3 lead in the seventh, Spencer Jones and Christopher Familia recorded a pair of run-scoring singles to take a 5-4 lead. In the eighth, after the Cyclones tied the game at five, the Brock Selvidge allowed two runs on eight hits while striking out three.

SUNDAY'S BEST: RHP Drew Thorpe has been the Renegades' Sunday starter for most of the season and has been lights outs. The former 2nd round pick currently ranks first in wins (9) & IP (91.1), second in strikeouts (111), ERA (2.27) & WHIP (1.06), and fifth in AVG (.209) in the South Atlantic League. Among Yankees' Minor Leaguers, Thorpe leads all qualified pitchers in ERA and wins while he sits second in strikeouts only behind Chase Hampton (SOM--AA). His nine wins are tied for the most in single-season franchise history with Josh Maciejewski (2021) and Mike Venafro (1995).

INTO THE TOP 100: Baseball America released its in-season Top 100 Prospects list update on Friday, and the Yankees claimed six players on the list. 2023 Renegades Chase Hampton (#60) and Spencer Jones (#98) entered the list for the first time. They were joined by former Renegades Oswald Peraza (#56), Jasson Domínguez (#71), Austin Wells (#86) and

WALKTHIS WAY: Rafael Flores became the 10th Renegade this season to walk three or more times in a contest on Friday night versus Brooklyn. He joins **Spencer Jones** as the second player this homestand to do so. Jones 'Gades retook the lead on a Jones fielders choice. The Cyclones mounted walked three times last Friday against Bowling Green and was the first player a three-run ninth and outlasted the Renegades 8-7. In his High-A debut, to accomplish this feat since Ben Cowles on May 17 vs Brooklyn. Since the second half began on June 20th, Jones leads the team with 14 walks in 84 plate appearances which is also good for sixth in the South Atlantic League.

> THE K-ZONE: The Hudson Valley Renegades pitching staff has been dominant all season long at getting swings-and-misses and they have been rewarded for it. The 'Gades currently own the second-highest strikeout total in all of Minor League Baseball. The Chattanooga Lookouts (CIN--AA) have struck out 998 batters compared to 988 for Hudson Valley this year. The Renegades tied their season-high with 19 strikeouts against the Wilmington Blue Rocks on July 2nd. The mark also tied their franchise record, which they recorded earlier this season on April 23rd versus the Rome Braves.

> FORMER 'GADES IN THE BRONX: On Sunday, the New York Yankees recalled Oswald Peraza from Triple-A Scranton. Peraza played in 28 games for the Hudson Valley Renegades in 2021 before making his Major League debut last season. Peraza joins Anthony Volpe as the two former Renegades currently on the Yankees Major League roster.

DREW THORPE · RHP · 6'4" · 190 LBS · 22

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe had one of his toughest starts in nearly two months last Friday against Bowling Green and still managed to toss 7.0 innings and strike out 10 while allowing three run on six hits, walking two. Thorpe allowed home runs to Dru Baker and Dominic Keegan, the first time in his career that he allowed multiple home runs in a start. He also saw his incredible run of one run allowed in 46.1 innings come to an end, but he still turned in a quality start and picked up his SAL-leading ninth win.

THOU SHALL NOT PASS: After allowing three runs in 7.0 innings against Bowling Green on July 15, Thorpe saw one of the most dominant runs in MiLB this season come to an end. From the time he allowed a home run Wilmington's Trey Lipscomb in the third inning on May 28 through a Carson Williams RBI double in the top of hte third on July 15, Thorpe allowed just one run in 46.1 innings, good for a 0.19 ERA.

YANKEES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON THORPE: "The first thing that sticks out in my mind about Thorpe is he's just YANKES DIRECTOR OF PITCHING SAM BRIEND ON HORPE: The first thing that sticks out in my mind about inorpe is ne's just a competitor. You always want those kinds of guys. New York is a really tough place to play so you want to draft and sign guys that have a makeup that says that this guy is going to be able to handle pitching there and Thorpe hands down has that. He's really impressive out there, nothing rattles him. And then on top of that the secondary pitches are great. The changeup was a weapon to both hands in college, he's a high raw spin guy, the slider is disgusting. He throws two kinds of sliders – he does throw the sweepier one and he has the shorter, tighter one and he just has such command of the zone with those offspeed pitches. It makes it really tough when you've got three different shapes there that are all going in different directions and he can move them around in the zone. As a hitter you can't really sit on anything and it's been awesome to watch.
