Louisville Bats (Cincinnati Reds) at Coolray Field. It is the first of nine meetings between the two clubs this year, all to be played in Lawrenceville. Tonight is Memorial Day featuring Postgame Fireworks. The Stripers will wear Gwinnett Peaches Specialty Jerseys (celebrating the women who played professionally during WWII).

VS. LOUISVILLE: Gwinnett is 28-21 (.571) in 49 games vs. Louisville at Coolray Field dating back to 2009. The Stripers have won three straight home games over the Bats dating back to 5/14/21 (outscoring LOU 18-6 in that span), and have won the season home series over Louisville in each of the last four seasons (13-3 in that span).

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 506 in 48 games (10.54 SO per game). That's 14 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 492 SO in 48G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (3rd, 56) and Touki Toussaint (T-8th, 48) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 5/29.

**ON THE OFFENSIVE:** Gwinnett leads the International League in team batting since 4/24, hitting .268 (271-for-1,011, 59 2B, 3 3B, 31 HR, 154 R, 143 RBI) over 31 games in that span. That's just ahead of Nashville, which ranks second at .268 (270-for-1,009) in 30 games since 4/23.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Following his two-double game in Norfolk yesterday, Phil Gosselin has notched hits in 16 of 19 games in May (.338, 24-for-71, 7 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 11 R, 11 RBI, 2 SB, .999 OPS). Overall, he has reached base safely in 35 of 39 games, hitting .306 (44-for-144, 10 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 22 R, 19 RBI, 3 SB, .871 OPS).

**GWN Career:** Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .297 (299-for-1,008, 61 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 135 R, 101 RBI, 10 SB, .774 OPS) with 83 multi-hit efforts in 274 games

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters enters play riding a fourgame hitting streak, batting .333 (5-for-15, 4 2B, 3 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB) in that span. Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, he is batting .297 (19-for-64, 5 2B, 2 HR, 10 R, 7 RBI, 1 SB, .787 OPS) in 16 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .252 (145-for-575, 32 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 97 R, 55 RBI, 32 SB, .719 OPS) in 145 games.

PROSPECTING: MLB.com Braves Top 30 Prospects with Gwinnett (6): OF Drew Waters (2), LHP Kyle Muller (3), RHP Bryce Elder (4), SS Braden Shewmake (5), LHP Tucker Davidson (No. 7), and RHP Victor Vodnik (12).

TONIGHT: The Stripers begin a six-game series vs. the A JOLT FROM JENISTA: After going homerless for 28 games from 4/12-5/25, Greyson Jenista has homered in two of his last four games (#5-6). His solo clout (off LHP Zac Lowther) helped Gwinnett to a 3-2 win in game two of Thursday's doubleheader, and his three-run blast (off RHP Conner Greene) staked the Stripers to a 5-0 lead on Saturday night. Gwinnett is 5-0 when Jenista homers this season.

> TROMP MASHING IN MAY: Since 5/1, Chadwick Tromp ranks among IL leaders in home runs (3rd, 8), RBI (T-3rd, 22), slugging percentage (6th, .658), extra-base hits (T-9th, 12), total bases (10th, 48), and OPS (15th, .961).

• Power Restored: In Game 2 on Thursday, he blasted a game-winning solo homer (#9) off LHP Kevin Smith for a last-at-bat 3-2 victory, his first clout since the final game of his 13-game hitting streak (.385 from 4/24-5/12), 11game RBI streak (23 RBI from 4/28-5/12), and ninegame extra-base hit streak (11 XBH from 5/1-5/12).

STREAK ENDS FOR VODNIK: Victor Vodnik allowed his first run of the season on Saturday (1.1 IP, 2 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO). He had posted 10 consecutive scoreless outings (11.0 IP, 4 H, 6 BB, 17 SO) between Double-A Mississippi and Gwinnett from 4/26-5/26, going 2-for-2 in saves.

• Triple-A Debuts: Vodnik is the sixth player to make his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett in 2022, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, SS Braden Shewmake, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP Willilam Woods.

**DELINO DE-STEALS:** Delino DeShields Jr. drew three walks and stole two bases in a game for the second time this season on Saturday (also did it on 5/10 at DUR). He currently ranks among IL leaders in on-base percentage (7th, .402) and steals (T-12th, 10). DeShields has reached base safely in 29 of 35 games overall, batting .252 (26-for-103, 4 2B, 13 R, 10 RBI) with a team-high 24 walks.

**<u>DEMERITTE RETURNS:</u>** On Saturday, the Braves optioned Travis Demeritte back to Gwinnett. Demeritte hit .213 (19for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with Atlanta from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 161 of 189 games (85.2%) since 2019, batting .284 (185-for-651, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 126 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .946 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons (20 in 2019, 21 in 2021), joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

#### MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) .. In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryce Elder makes his fifth Triple-A start and ninth overall start of the season in the opener of a six-game series vs. Louisville.

- GWN Career: Makes his 12th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 3-4 with a 3.99 ERA (26 ER in 58.2 IP), .169 BAA, 29 walks, and 65 strikeouts since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.
- Triple-A Splits: Makes his seventh career Triple-A road start (2-3, 5.12 ERA, .173 BAA) and second career Triple-A daytime start (0-0, 2.25 ERA, .143 BAA).
- Vs. Louisville: Faces the Bats for the first time since his Triple-A debut at Louisville Slugger Field on 8/20/21 (win, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 SO in 10-5 victory).

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (Kyle Muller is No. 3).

**2022 WITH GWINNETT:** Began the season on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... 5/18 vs. MEM: Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 (was his first win with Gwinnett since 9/9/21 at Columbus).

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made his MLB debut with Atlanta on 4/12 vs. Washington, earning the win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO) in the Braves' 16-4 rout ... Became the 107th former Gwinnett player to reach the Majors and the first Braves starter to win his MLB debut since Ian Anderson (8/26/20 at NYY, won 5-1) ... Went 0-3 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) in his next three starts, walking 14 and striking out eight ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1.

2021 SEASON: Earned the Braves' Phil Niekro Award for Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 11-5 with a 2.75 ERA, 1.10 WHIP, and .193 BAA in 25 starts across three levels (High-A Rome, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett) during his pro debut ... Ranked among MiLB pitching leaders in innings (1st, 137.2), starts (T-2nd), wins (T-6th), and strikeouts (10th, 155) ... Named Double-A South Pitcher of the Week for 7/5-7/11 (2-0, 0.75 ERA, 0.67 WHIP, .061 BAA in 2 starts) and Double-A South Pitcher of the Month for July (4-1, 2.73 ERA, 0.88 WHIP, .140 BAA in 5 starts) ... Won eight of nine starts between 7/4 and 8/20 (8-1, 2.84 ERA, 1.04 WHIP, .179 BAA).
