ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians brought the go-ahead run to the plate in the top of the ninth but failed to score as their historic winning streak ended after eight games with a 4-3 loss to the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) Friday night.

Trailing 4-1 to start the final frame, Ryan Gold led off the inning with a double to the right field corner. Up stepped Tanner Morris, who launched a no-doubter to the street beyond right field for his first home run of the season to make it 4-3. Sebastian Espino worked a two-out walk later in the inning to put the tying run on base for pinch-hitter Spencer Horwitz, but a groundout ended the game and snapped the streak.

Both teams traded solo home runs in the first two innings. Andy Yerzy went deep with two outs in the top of the first, but Gold wrapped his first Advanced-A homer around the left field foul pole in the second to tie the game 1-1.

Hillsboro used two hits, two walks and six stolen bases – including a steal of home by Ricky Martinez that proved to be the winning run – to plate three in the seventh and take a 4-1 lead.

Right-hander Nick Frazee was excellent for a second consecutive outing. The Dallas, TX native went six innings, allowed one run on three hits, walked two and struck out six for his second quality start (six or more innings, three earned runs or less) of the season but did not factor into the decision.

Three hitters accounted for Vancouver's five hits. Gold and Morris paced the offense with two hits apiece, while Cameron Eden singled in the fourth.

Marcus Reyes worked an inning and a third of scoreless relief. Cobi Johnson (L, 0-1) couldn't escape the seventh after two hits, two walks and two strikeouts.

BATTLE FOR THE BORO: This week marks the first meeting between Vancouver and Hillsboro. The C's and the Hops will match-up in five series this season; three with the Hops as the home team and two with the Canadians "hosting" the Diamondbacks affiliate. Vancouver leads 3-1.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

GET IN THE CAR, FRANK: Last night's 4-3 loss snapped a record 8-game winning streak, Vancouver's longest stretch of consecutive wins since before becoming a Blue Jays affiliate.

LATE LIFE: The C's have outscored their opponents a combined 21-6 in the 8th and 9th innings this season.

MEN IN BLACK: The Canadians are 7-2 in black jerseys this year despite last night's loss.

WALK HARD: Vancouver has worked 92 walks this year, the most in all of Advanced-A. The team's .369 on-base percentage is also the highest at this level.

END OF AN ERA: Spencer Horwitz's team-high 14-game on-base streak came to an end last night when he appeared as a pinch-hitter and failed to reach base. Those 14 consecutive games are tied with Double-A New Hampshire's Otto Lopez, who is in the midst of an identical streak for the Fisher Cats.

ON THE HILL: #9 Blue Jays prospect (MB.com) Adam Kloffenstein is on the hill tonight for Vancouver as he looks to continue his hot start to 2021. The right-hander was dominant in his last start, earning the win with six innings against Spokane on May 16 in which he worked six innings, gave up one run on two hits, walked two and struck out four. He leads the league with a .136 opponent's batting average.

#23 Diamondbacks prospect (MLB.com) Matt Tabor will go for Hillsboro. In his last turn on May 15 in Eugene, the righty went 4.1 innings of relief, gave up five runs (four earned) on four hits, walked three and struck out four but earned the win.
