TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves and Biscuits continue a six-game series tonight with game two of a six-game series at Riverwalk Stadium, the second of 24 meetings between the teams this season. The two teams next meet for a six-game series from May 27 to June 2 at Trustmark Park. This series is the second leg of a 12-game road trip. The M-Braves went 1-5 against the Birmingham Barons last week, April 16-21, at Regions Field.

BRING ON THE BISCUITS, LET'S COOK: Mississippi went 11-19 against Montgomery last season, 4-8 at Riverwalk Stadium, and 7-11 at Trustmark Park ... Montgomery has won the season set against Mississippi in 14 of 18 seasons since 2005 ... The M-Braves are 143-194 all-time against the Biscuits franchise ... The Biscuits have played the most games against the M-Braves since 2005, with 337 total meetings.

<u>ABOUT LAST NIGHT:</u> The Mississippi offense scored a season-high eight runs in the 8-4 win over Montgomery, taking 12 innings on Tuesday at Riverwalk Stadium. Drake Baldwin had three of the M-Braves' 11 hits, adding two doubles and an RBI. **Tyler Tolve** hit a two-run home run, and **Geraldo Quintero** and **Cody** Milligan added two hits each. Nacho Alvarez Jr. picked up the game-winning hit with a two-run single in the bottom of the 12th. The Mississippi pitching staff struck out a season-most 19 batters, with eight coming from starter Ian Mejia over the first five innings. Parker Dunshee, pitching for the second-straight game, got the win with 2.0 scoreless innings in the 11th and 12th.

CLOSING IN ON 1,200 FRANCHISE WINS: Mississippi's next win will be the 1,200th in franchise history. It took the M-Braves until the sixth game of the inaugural season in 2005 to win the first game in club history, which was a 7-4 win over the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx in game two of a doubleheader at Pringles Park on April 12, 2005. Jeff Francoeur was 0-for-3, with a walk, and RBI, in the game, using a five-run sixth, fueled by RBI's by Scott Thorman, Francoeur, and Derrick Gibson. Brian O'Connor got the win for Mississippi.

NEED FOR SPEED: The M-Braves lead all of Double-A baseball with 36 stolen bases (36/39) through 16 games. Rocket City is second with 35. Justin Dean is T-2nd in the league with nine steals, and Cody Milligan is 4th with eight. Mississippi had 157 (1.1 per game) stolen bases last season and is on pace for 311 (2.3 per game) in 2024. The most by an M-Brayes team was 159 in 2007.

"NACHO" AVERAGE SHORT STOP: Atlanta's top-ranked position player prospect, Nacho Alvarez Jr., is on a nine-game on-base streak, batting .294 with 10 hits, three RBI, five walks, and a .385 OBP. The 21-year-old ranks among the circuit leaders in walks (1st, 12), hits (T-4th, 16), OBP (9th, 406), and steals (10th, 6).

DRAKE IS "TOO GOOD": Atlanta's top catching prospect, Drake Baldwin, has reached base safely in nine straight games from April 11 to 23. Baldwin hit his first home run in game two of Sunday's doubleheader in Birmingham.

Over the nine games, Baldwin is slashing .313/.405/.500, with 10 hits, three doubles, a home run, three RBI, five walks, and two runs. Over his last two games, is 5-fo-7, with a homer, three doubles, two RBI, and two walks.

THERE'S JUST SOMETHING ABOUT THE NAME NIEKRO: JJ Niekro, the son of Joe Niekro and nephew of Phil Niekro, is trying to create his legacy. The 26-year-old made his first two Double-A starts during the opening homestand and went 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2), two walks, and eight strikeouts. Niekro won during the home opener on April 9 with 6.0 shutout innings in the 2-0 weather-shortened contest. The Plant City, FL native ranks among the Southern League leaders in innings pitched (10th, 15.2) and WHIP (9th, 1.02).

GIVE ME FIVE: The M-Braves are 5-3 when their starters go 5+ innings and 0-8 when starters go less than 5.0 innings. In the eight games with 5+ innings, they have combined for a 1.60 ERA (8 ER/45.0 IP). In the seven losses, the starter's ERA is 7.90 (24 ER/27.1 IP).

MR. MEJIA: After struggling in his first start, Ian Mejia has allowed just one run over his previous two quality starts, including 12 innings, one run allowed, four walks, and 13 strikeouts. Mejia set a new career high with nine strikeouts in his start on April 17 at Birmingham. Mejia ranks among the league leaders in strikeouts (T-1st, 22), innings pitched (2nd, 18.2), and opponents' average (9th, .203).

OPENING DAY ROSTER FEATURES FOUR TOP-20 ATL PROSPECTS/17 RETURNERS: Mississippi returns 17 players from last season's club and four of the Atlanta Braves' Top 20 prospects. The Top 20 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline, include RHP **Hurston Waldrep** (No. 2), INF **Nacho Alvarez Jr.** (No. 6), C **Drake Bald**win (No. 11), and LHP Luis De Aviia (No. 20). RHP Ian Mejia (No. 28), and INF Keshawn Ogans are part of Baseball America's Top 30 prospects ... The 17 returning players include pitchers De Aviia, RHP Domingo Gonzalez, RHP Patrick Halligan, LHP Hayden Harris, LHP Jake McSteen, RHP Trey Riley, RHP Hurston Waldrep, RHP Peyton Williams, and position players Baldwin, C Tyler Tolve, C Javier Valdes, INF Cade Bunnell, INF Cal Conley, INF Bryson Horne, OF Justin Dean, OF Cody Milligan, and OF Brandon Parker.

COACHING STAFF WITH A NEW FLO: After spending one season as manager of the Braves High-A affiliate Rome Braves (Emperors), **Angel Flores** will take the reins for the first time at the Double-A level, succeeding Kanekoa Texeira. Texeira was promoted to manager of the Triple-A Gwinnett Stripers after Matt Tuiasosopo was named to the Braves' Major League coaching staff for 2024. Flores returns to Mississippi, where he served as bench coach in 2022. Flores took over as interim manager from April 26 to May 15, 2022, while Bruce Crabbe took a leave of absence from the club. During the 18-game stretch, the M-Braves went 10-8. During his first season as a full-time manager last year, Flores led the R-Braves to a 34-32 record in the second half and an overall 64-68 mark. Overall, he holds a 74-76 record as a manager.

ABOUT LAST SEASON: The club finished with a 62-75 overall record, 33-35 in the first half and 29-40 in the second half. The M-Braves were 32-36 at Trustmark Park and 30-39 on the road. The M-Braves went 19-32 in July and August but finished with a franchise record nine wins in September.

FINAL SEASON IN MISSISSIPPI: On January 9, it was announced that after 20 years, 2024 will be the M-Braves' final season in Pearl, MS. As of the start of the 2025 season, the Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves will be relocating to Columbus, GA.

TODAY'S GAME

The 2023 Southern League All-Star makes his fourth start of 2024, and 29th for the M-Braves. This is his sixth career start against the Biscuits, and third at Riverwalk Stadium.

LAST TIME OUT

De Avila turned in his first quality start, but suffered the loss in last Thursday's 2-0
defeat in Birmingham. In 6.0 innings, the 22-year-old gave up two runs (one earned)
on nine hits with two walks, and five strikeouts.

VS. MONTGOMERY

 The southpaw went 1-3, with an 8.27 ERA, 12 walks, and 19 strikeouts over five starts against Montgomery last season.

2023 NOTES

- The two-time Southern League Pitcher of the Week, made a career-high 26 starts in 2023, going 6-10 with a 3.28 ERA over 123.1 innings with 125 strikeouts to 61 walks in 25 Mississippi starts. Was named a Southern League All-Star.
- Combined to make 26 starts between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Finished among the Southern League leaders in ERA (2nd), starts (4th), innings pitched (5th), opponents average (3rd, .223), strikeouts (8th), and WHIP (8th) ... Ranked among the top 10 Atlanta farmhands in starts (1st, 26), ERA (2nd, 3.26), innings (T-2nd, 127.0), BAA (2nd, .224), strikeouts (3rd, 128), and WHIP (8th, 1.32) ...
- Over his final three starts with the M-Braves, he threw 14.0 scoreless innings, striking out 16 and walking just four.
- During the club's successful June, De Avila was somehow denied the Southern League Pitcher of the Month award after finishing 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28 innings over five starts.
