NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Sunday night, it was announced that top Royals prospect **Jac Caglianone** was to be promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... "Cags" has gone 4-for-13 over his first 3 Triple-A games.

✦ Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.

✦ In 38 games in Double-A, Cags hit .322 (49-for-152), with 8 doubles, 9 homers, 43 RBI and a .947 OPS ... he ranked 1st in the Texas League in RBI, hits (49), total bases (84) and runs scored (32), tied 2nd in extra-base hits (17), 3rd in homers and average, 4th in slugging percentage (.535) and OPS.

✦ Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 44 RBI and tied 6th with 91 total bases and 10th in the Minors with 53 hits.

✦ Including Double-A games, Cags enters today's game on a 16-game hitting streak, a stretch where he's batting .343 (23-for-67) with a 1.031 OPS since May 3, tied for the 4th-longest active streak in the Minors ... he's reached base in his last 23 games, going back April 25, with a .352 average (32-for-91) and 1.009 OPS.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 72 bases this year, and only been caught 10 times ... 72 steals rank 4th both in the International League and among Triple-A teams.

✦ 72-for-82 in steal attempts is a 87.8% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 94.1%, 32-for-34).

✦ **John Rave** leads the team with 16 steals, while **Nick Loftin** is 2nd with 12 stolen bases.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 444 strikeouts this season ... that is 3rd in the league and 4th at the Triple-A level.

✦ Over 401.0 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.21 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 444 strikeouts through 46 games, an average of 9.87 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,438 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

✦ Yesterday Rave snapped a career-best 16-game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest streak in the International League this year ... he hit .406 (26-for-64) with a 1.214 OPS from May 3 to 21 ... Rave also scored a run in all 16 games of that hitting streak, with 23 runs scored in the stretch, also a career-best and new modern Omaha record, passing his 14-game scoring streak, from June 17 to July 6, 2023.

✦ Rave leads the Minors in run scored (42) ... he leads the IL in triples (4), is 4th in total bases (84), 4th in steals (16), tied 7th in hits (48) and tied 7th in extra-base hits (18) ... additionally, he is 2nd on the Storm Chasers in homers (7) and 3rd in RBI (22).

✦ Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 40 of 46 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 16 of 40 games (.400 OBP leading off the 1st inning) ... that includes 10 hits (4 singles, 3 doubles, 3 homers), 5 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 3 leadoff homers this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues.

BAM BAM CAM

Since joining the Storm Chasers last season, shortstop **Cam Devanney** has been one of the top run-producers in the International League, but this year has been one of Omaha's top hitters overall.

✦ Devanney has homered in the first 3 games of this week's series vs. Salt Lake, to lead the Storm Chasers with 10 homers this year, tied 5th at the Triple-A level.

✦ Going back to the start of the 2024 season, Devanney has driven in 112 runs for Omaha, the 2nd-most of any International League player in that span, trailing only **Johnathan Rodriguez** of the Columbus Clippers (113 RBI).

✦ In 2025, Devanney is tied 2nd in home runs (10) and tied 4th in RBI (34) ... he is also 3rd in slugging percentage (.627) and 5th in OPS (1.015)

✦ Devanney's 3 grand slams this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, all coming in the month of May ... he is 4-for-6 when batting with the bases loaded and his 13 total bases and 15 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded both lead the Triple-A level, ranking 2nd and 3rd in the Minors, respectively.

✦ Cam has hits in 23 of his 31 games that he's started this year, with an RBI in 19 of 31 games ... his 6 games with 2+ RBI are tied for the 2nd-most on the Chasers.

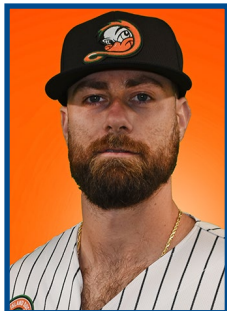

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **1st start with Omaha** this season ... last week, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his 13th professional season this year ... Royals are Gant's 4th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins, as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals and has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Last pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.

CAREER NOTES

SINCE 2022

- Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
- Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
- Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025 with the Long Island Ducks.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- In 2019, was just the 5th pitcher in MLB history with a perfect record and at least 7 wins prior to the All-Star Break, while making all relief appearances.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.

- July 24, 2015:** Acquired by the Atlanta Braves with RHP Rob Whalen from the New York Mets in exchange for INF Juan Uribe and INF/OF Kelly Johnson.
- December 1, 2016:** Acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals with RHP Chris Ellis and INF Luke Dykstra from the Atlanta Braves in exchange for LHP Jaime Garcia.
- July 30, 2021:** Acquired by the Minnesota Twins with LHP Evan Sisk from the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ ... Sisk has pitched 128 games for Omaha and is currently in the Royals' Major League bullpen.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
