#### LAST TIME OUT

**St. Paul, MN (April 22, 2023)** -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the St. Paul Saints 11-6 in Saturday's afternoon contest. The RailRiders added two homers for 33 on the season, good for second in all of Triple-A.

The RailRiders got on the board first with a solo shot from Rodolfo Duran in the second inning.

Elijah Dunham started the fourth with a double. Andres Chaparro singled him home for a 2-0 lead. Jake Bauers followed with a double to plate Chaparro and a sacrifice fly sent in Bauers himself for a 4-0 advantage.

In the bottom half, Mark Contreras walked to reach and Andrew Stevenson was hit by a pitch. A three-run homer from Ryan LaMarre chipped away at SWB's lead. Another homer from Hernan Perez sent in two more, a five-run frame and took back the lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tied it up in the fifth. Dunham doubled and back-to-back walks loaded the bases. Duran was hit by a pitch to bring a run home to make the score five apiece.

Once again, the Saints added two more for the lead in the fifth, seventh, and eighth. The Saints capitalized on three RailRiders errors and nine walks throughout the contest. SWB outhit St. Paul 12-7.

SWB started attempted to start a rally in the ninth with a leadoff homer from Wilmer Difo. The RailRiders loaded the bases, but couldn't bring a run across ending it 11-6 Saints.

Sean Boyle pitched the first three frames quick and clean. In the fourth, the starter let up five runs on three hits and three walks. Shawn Semple (L, 0-1) made his season debut getting out of the fourth with a strikeout. Semple let up two runs both unearned. Matt Krook also allowed two unearned runs, but struck out the side in the sixth. Matt Bowman tossed 1.2 innings giving up two runs, one earned.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**FILLED UP** - After playing down a man or two for the past few contests, the RailRiders are now back to a full roster. Colten Brewer was added to the bullpen on April 19 alongside Shawn Semple who joined the squad yesterday. With a total of 28 players, 16 are pitchers and 12 are position players, including three catchers.

**FIELDING FAUX PAS** - The RailRiders have made errors in four straight contests after not recording one in the opening game in St. Paul despite the freezing weather. The RailRiders are first in all Minor League Baseball with 29 miscues made. The have had only seven error free games of the season. Earlier this summer they did have a five-error game. The Stockton Ports are second with 28, two teams have made just five total miscues this summer.

**LOSEKE LEFT STANDING** - Barrett Loseke remains the only member left of the pitching staff to not have given up an earned run in 2023. Last night, he tossed one clean inning of work allowing just a walk and a hit, but recording two strikeouts. The righty has only made four appearances after being called up on April 8 before having an outing in Double-A. He has totaled five innings, letting up four hits and four walks, while striking out five. Loseke was originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 17th Round in 2018 out of the University of Arkansas.

**HOMER HEAVEN** - The RailRiders have had twelve different players launch a home run this season with Wilmer Difo launching his first yesterday. The team has compiled 33 long balls in twenty contests, tied for second in all of Minor Leagues. Andres Chaparro leads the way with seven homers, while Jake Bauers has six. Michael Heramosillo and Jamie Westbrook each have three of his own. The Albuquerque Isotopes lead all farm teams with 33. The Saints batters have amassed just twenty home runs by twelve different hitters. Four have had a pair each, but Mark Contreras leads the way with three after his grand slam Tuesday.

**STEALING SITUATION** - The team has combined for 21 total steals on the season. Although not currently on the roster, Oswald Peraza leads with five to his name. Elijah Dunham has four total, while Jake Bauers has three swipes. Nine different players have recorded a steal and the RailRiders have only been caught four times.

**BREWER'S BACK** - The RailRiders have added pitcher Colten Brewer to the roster, totalling now 15 arms on staff. Brewer returns after being selected by New York on April 1st. The righty made three appearances out of the bullpen before being designated for assignment. Brewer cleared waivers and was outrighted to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on April 17 and joined the roster the next day. The 30-year-old joined the Yankees after being traded from the Tampa Bay Rays for cash at the end of Spring Training.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#18 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

**LAST OUTING OUT:** Vasquez allowed at least one run in every frame he pitched against Syracuse. Aa leadoff homer in the first, a hit batter and a double in the second, and a pair of singles, a walk, and an error in the third. Errors did not help him out in the fourth as Mets #8 prospect Mark Vientos mashed a three-run shot. Vasquez left with a runner on.

**SPRING START:** For the second year in a row, Vasquez recieved the invite to Major League spring training and appeared in Grapefruit League contents. This spring he went 1-0 in three appearances with one start. He tossed 7.0 innings allowing four runs on 10 hits. He struck out seven and walked four.

**PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION:** On 4/1/23, Vasquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Got the ball on Opening Day, Recorded 2 pickoffs on 3/31
