LUG•NOTES

Quick Starts: Buckle up! The Lugnuts have scored in the 1st inning in each of the first four games of this series.

Streak... Over: **Euribiel Ángeles** went 0-for-5 last night, ending his team-high hitting streak at 12 games. In addition, at the Triple-A level, 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher **Grant Holman** had his scoreless innings streak end at 30 straight scoreless frames to open the year, charged with three runs (two earned) in two innings of relief in the Las Vegas Aviators' 14-8 loss to Sacramento.

Top 100 Opposition: West Michigan starter **Jackson Jobe** is ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 8 prospect in baseball, the second-highest regarded player in the Midwest League behind 17-year-old catcher **Ethan Salas** (No. 4), who arrives in town with Fort Wayne on Monday. The TinCaps also have starter **Dylan Lesko** (No. 67).

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.258), total bases (953), triples (31) and OPS (.748) and ranks 2nd in runs (380), base hits (616), doubles (125), RBIs (347), slugging percentage (.398) and tied for 2nd in on-base percentage (.350).

Speedball: On June 2, the Lugnuts beat Peoria in Game 1 of a doubleheader, 5-1, in one hour and 23 minutes, setting the franchise record for fastest seven-inning game. Then on Thursday night, the Nuts set the new franchise record for fastest nine-inning game, beating the Whitecaps, 3-0, in one hour and 44 minutes.

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Bryan Buelvas** (No. 29).

History: **Jake Garland** (5 innings), **Grant Judkins** (2 2/3 innings) and **Colton Johnson** (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which **Donnie Hood** hit for the cycle.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2007: The Lugnuts faced the Loons' Clayton Kershaw for the second and final time, torching him for six runs on six hits and two walks in 4 1/3 innings and handing him the defeat in a 15-7 Nuts win at Dow Diamond. The Nuts scored three in the 2nd and three more in the 5th vs. Kershaw, who did strike out seven, before blowing the game open with four-run rallies in the 8th and 9th. The Loons scored six runs in the bottom of the 9th in defeat.

2018: Maverik Buffo became the first Midwest League pitcher and the second MiLB pitcher to reach nine wins, tossing seven scoreless innings, and the Lugnuts continued the Great Lakes Loons' misery with 3-1 victory at Dow Diamond. It was the Lugnuts' 11th win in their last 12 games, opening the second half with an 8-1 record, while the Loons lost their 13th straight game and their ninth straight to open the second half.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas for an emergency relief appearances on June 23 at Tacoma, earning the win in a 20-10 victory; allowed first five batters to reach before recovering to record the next nine outs scorelessly...

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph as a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the Fort Wayne TinCaps have featured two WVU teammates in Jackson Wolf and Ryan Berger; pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.
