"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints scored the final eight runs of the night and leaned on a six-run fifth inning capped by an Aaron Sabato grand slam that cleared the batter's eye to net right-hander Trent Baker his first Triple-A win and snap a season-long seven-game losing streak. Andrew Morris started for the Saints and had his strikeout stuff working, but a pair of walks bit him in the first two innings. A double by Justyn-Henry Malloy were one of the handful of hard contact Morris allowed on the night, scoring a one-out free pass in the first. A bloop single to left by Gage Workman brought across a second run that also had reached via the walk in the second to make it 2-0. The Saints were shutdown by rehabber Reese Olson, who went 3.2 scoreless before Jose Miranda blasted out Beau Brieske's second pitch back into the bullpen where he came from to make 1-0 in the fourth. The Saints followed with three more consecutive two-out hits, including a single by Sabato that marked his first Triple-A RBI. In the fifth, Miranda rudely welcomed another new reliever, Nick Margevicius, with a two-run double after three straight walks by Brieske. Morales reached on a free pass to load the bases again before Sabato hammered one to dead center, the first home run of his Triple-A career, and became the eighth player in the last 11 seasons at CHS Field to clear the batter's eye. From there, it was all Trent Baker. After recording just two outs in his Triple-A debut last Friday in Indianapolis, he nailed down four scoreless innings as the piggy-backer before Anthony Misiewicz threw up a zero in the ninth.

IN THE REARVIEW: The Saints' season long losing streak was halted at seven games in-a-row with Thursday's win. The skid is tied for the 3rd-longest in Saints franchise history with St. Paul having last dropped seven in-a-row during a 10-game skid from August 9-20 last season (the St. Paul record losing streak is 11 straight games from May 8-20, 2022). The Saints went just 3-14 (.176) from May 31-June 18, touting the worst winning% among all 120 full-season minor league teams during that stretch. Over the course of their 7-game skid, the Saints were outscored 99-64 (-35) with the most runs allowed in the league and 9th/120 full-season teams in MiLB.

SABATO STAYS SWATTIN': Saints first baseman Aaron Sabato made his mark with his first Triple-A home run on Thursday night with a grand slam that cleared the batter's eye at CHS Field. At a Statcast-estimated 426 feet, it is tied for the 2nd longest home run by a St. Paul batter this season and marked just the eighth time a player has cleared the batter's eye in 11 seasons of baseball at CHS Field (six Saints players have now done it, incl. just three in the Triple-A era: Yunior Severino on August 19, 2023 vs Indy & Jair Camargo on July 7, 2024 vs Gwinnett). Since being called up for his Triple-A debut on June 12, Sabato is leading the International League with a 73.3% hard-hit rate (min 20 PA) and is third in average exit velocity (96.7 mph).

ED(WALK) JULIEN? MORE LIKE ED(RAKES) JULIEN: Entering play Friday, Saints second baseman Edouard Julien is tied for the second-most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 33 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 20 of 34 games while touting a .455 OBP. Julien has also collected hits in 9 of his last 12 games, a stretch where he's 15-for-41 (.366) with three homers, 7 RBI, and 8 walks. Since June 7, Julien's 57% hard-hit rate (13th) and 93.3 mph average exit velo (17th) both rank top-20 in the International League.

THE KING OF STATEN ISLAND: Saints utility man Anthony Prato turned in a stellar performance in Tuesday night's homestand opener, going 3-for-3 with two walks and a hit by pitch. The Staten Island product became the second-ever St. Paul Saint hitter to reach in six-of-six trips to the plate or more, joining Nash Knight from Sept. 16, 2022 vs Louisville (Knight was 3-for-3, 3 BB). Prato also wore his 11th hit by pitch of the season, putting him at second in the league in that category, trailing Lehigh Valley's Otto Kemp (17). Prato's 26 career HBP's now tie him for the most in Saints franchise history with Mark Contreras. The single-season record for HBP drawn as a batter is Contreras' 13 in 2021. Prato's career .409 on-base% with the Saints ranks third among all St. Paul hitters in franchise history that have appeared in at least 80 games:

HEY MICKY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5 for his second stint with the Saints this year, utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .326 (43-132) with 12 doubles, 8 HR, and 23 RBI in 34 games. Gasper's 20 XBH ranks 3rd in the IL since that date and his OPS ranks 3rd in the International League (min 100 AB). Because of a pair of stints with the Twins this season, Gasper does not have enough at-bats to qualify for the official league leaderboard, but ranks among the top-10 in several offensive categories if you drop the qualifier to 150 plate appearances (see below):

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (37-37) snapped their season-long six game losing streak with a 12-5 win yesterday afternoon in Cincinnati. Byron Buxton homered in each of the first two innings, including a first-inning blast that marked the 12th leadoff home run of his career, tied for the fifth most in Twins history. He ranks second among all AL outfielders to Aaron Judge in fWAR (2.9). All nine Twins hitters collected a knock in a 17-hit hit outburst, including Brooks Lee, who has now hit safely in a career-high 18 straight games. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (36-30) have won six of their last seven after a 5-1 win in Arkansas (SEA). Twins top prospect Walker Jenkins has collected a hit in each of his first two games back with the Wind Surge following a 2-week rehab stint. High-A Cedar Rapids (40-26) swept Beloit (MIA) in a doubleheader on the road, clinching the Midwest League West first-half, clinching their 11th playoff berth in the last 12 years. Low-A Fort Myers (27-37) were rained out at home after being slated to face Lakeland (DET).

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Saturday in Indianapolis and completed 5.0 innings for the fourth time in six outings as a traditional starter. Allowed back-to-back two out hits in the first, including a two-run homer to Jack Suwinski, and pitched around traffic in four of his five innings of work. Threw 29 sinkers (33%), 28 sweepers (32%), 17 four-seamers (19%), and 14 changeups (16%). Induced 12 swings-and-misses, one shy of his season-high. Recorded two K's apiece on the changeup and sweeper.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp and the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints mark the 12th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues in his career.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings; he worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineup in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT!: Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former "Dirtbags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jared Weaver.
