#### NEWS & NOTES

**ROME, SWEET ROME:** The Renegades continue their season-opening road trip against the Rome Emperors. This marks the third-straight season that the Renegades have made a visit to the Peach State on their first road trip of the year. Since joining the South Atlantic League, Hudson Valley has played more games at Rome than in any other South Division ballpark. Since the start of the 2022 season, the Renegades have played as many series in Rome as they have played at North Division foe Aberdeen and more than at Greensboro, another North Division team.

**MAMMA SAID SHUT YOU OUT:** With back-to-back shutout wins over Rome, the Renegades have already thrown three shutouts in their first six games of the 2024 season. They are one of three teams across Minor League Baseball who have thrown three shutouts this season. Both the Hartford Yard Goats (COL, AA) and Montgomery Biscuits (TB, AA) have also thrown two shutouts. Hudson Valley finished third in MiLB with 13 shutouts in 2023. From Saturday 4/6 through Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader in Rome, the Renegades staff combined for 19.0 consecutive shutout innings spanning parts of three games. The staff currently has a 16.0 inning scoreless streak across the last two games.

**EASY AS 1-2-3:** With **Brian Hendry** and **Matt Keating** combining on a three-hitter in Game 2 of Friday's doubleheader in Rome, the Renegades became the first team in MiLB this season to have thrown a 1-hitter, a 2-hitter, and a 3-hitter (since joined by Montgomery). Among MiLB teams, only the Akron Rubber Ducks (CLE, AA), Columbus Clippers (CLE, AAA), Lakeland Flying Tigers (DET, A), and Montgomery Biscuits (TB, AA) have had three games this season in which they have allowed three-or-fewer hits to their opponents.

**ON THE RIGHT FOOT:** In the last four Renegades games, starting pitchers **Cam Schlittler**, **Jackson Fristoe**, **Brian Hendry** and **Sebastian Keane** have pitched lights out. The quartet posted a combined 2-0, 0.68 ERA, 172 IP, 9 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 3 BB, and 26 K. They have combined to strike out 39.4% of batters faced and 13.25 K/9, roughly equivalent to the start of the 2024 season for Freddy Peralta of the Brewers.

**NEW IN TOWN:** The Renegades welcome four 2023 Yankees draft picks to the Opening Day squad: **Kyle Carr**, **Roc Riggio**, **Kiko Romero** and **Brian Hendry**. All four selections were taken in the 10th round or earlier. Riggio and Romero each played briefly after the draft, while Carr and Hendry did not make professional appearances in 2023.

**THIRTY, FLIRTY & THRIVING:** The Hudson Valley Renegades are celebrating their 30th anniversary season throughout 2024. Now in their fourth season as a full-season club and affiliate of the New York Yankees, the Renegades will pay tribute to the greatest players and moments in franchise history throughout the season. Since the team's inaugural 1994 season, 131 Renegades have gone on to play in Major League Baseball, with catcher **Kevin Brown** being the club's first alumni to reach MLB on Sept. 12, 1996. Hudson Valley has been affiliated with three MLB clubs, the Texas Rangers (1994-96), Tampa Bay Rays (96-19) and Yankees (20-Present). They won the New York-Penn League Nader Cup Championship three times: 1999, 2012, and 2017. Other notable former Renegades include 2008 AL Rookie of the Year **Evan Longoria**, 2009 AL Rookie of the Year **Jeremy Hellickson**, 2010 AL MVP **Josh Hamilton**, and Cleveland Guardians manager **Stephen Vogt**.

**OVER A DECADE OF SUCCESS:** With a 70-62 (.530) record in 2023, the Hudson Valley Renegades recorded their 11<sup>th</sup> consecutive season with an above .500 record (since 2012). During that span, the team has won two league championships (2012 and 2017), seven playoff appearances (12, 14, 16-19, 23), and five league championship series appearances (12, 16-18, 23). Including their 4-2 start to 2024, among teams in affiliated baseball with at least 800 games played, the Renegades have the best winning percentage (.575) in MiLB.

**LEADING OFF:** On Saturday night **Jared Serna** connected for a leadoff home run in the top of the first against Bowling Green's Alex Cook. It was the first leadoff home run by the Renegades in 2024 after the club had four in 2023, three hit by Spencer Jones and one by Ben Cowles.

**THAT'S ALL THEY GOT? ONE HIT?:** Four Renegades pitchers, **Kyle Carr**, **Trent Sellers**, **Leonardo Pestana** and **Joel Valdez** combined to one-hit the Bowling Green Hot Rods on Saturday night in a 14-2 victory. The lone Hot Rods hit was a second inning double by Brock Jones.

- ✦ It was the 15th one-hitter thrown by the Renegades since 2005.
- ✦ It was the 11th one-hitter thrown by the Renegades since becoming a Yankees affiliate in 2021.
- ✦ HV threw three one-hitters in 2023, including one on June 20 at Brooklyn to clinch the SAL North Division First Half.
- ✦ It was the first one-hitter thrown by the Renegades against a South Atlantic League South Division opponent.

**LIMITING HITS:** Hudson Valley pitchers have been on a roll early on, and have allowed only 25 hits through six games. The Renegades have allowed the fewest hits in MiLB. At one point on opening weekend, the Renegades held the Hot Rods without a hit across 10.2 innings, and shut Bowling Green out over the final 16.1 innings of the series. The team's 1.64 ERA is third-best in MiLB, trailing Rome (0.88) and Montgomery (1.30 - TB, AA).

**STARTING STRONG:** After **Jesús Rodríguez** homered to lead off the top of the second inning on Friday night against Trevor Martin, the Renegades have now had a solo home run be their first hit of the season in three straight years. In 2022, Trey Sweeney hit the first pitch of the season from Greenville's Brian Van Belle for a home run, while Spencer Jones took Greensboro's Anthony Solometo deep in the bottom of the third in 2023.

**HUDSON VALLEY TO THE SHOW:** Already in 2024, the Renegades have seen four former players make their MLB debuts. **Mitch Spence** (2021) made his MLB debut with the Oakland Athletics, **Matt Sauer** (2021-23) debuted with the Kansas City Royals, and **Oliver Dunn** (2021) broke in with the Milwaukee Brewers all over MLB Opening Weekend. On Monday night, **Josh Maciejewski** (2021, 23) made his big league debut for the Yankees against the Marlins. The Renegades have now had 131 former players reach the major leagues, including 18 from the Yankees era and 16 from the star-studded 2021 team.

**FINISHING STRONG:** Over his last 14 games of the 2023 regular season, **Jesús Rodríguez** went 19-for-53 (.358) with two doubles, a triple, two home runs, 9 RBIs, and seven runs scored. Rodríguez has carried that success into the 2024 season by reaching base safely in his first four games, extending his on-base streak to 16 straight games and his hitting streak to 10 in a row. Both streaks were snapped on Saturday night at Rome in an 0-for-4 night. The Renegades team record on-base streak was set last season by **Ben Cowles**, who reached safely in 41 consecutive games from 7/4-9/2.

**INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH:** The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night on August 20 at Heritage Financial Park. The team is currently fundraising to bring over several Bhutanese baseball players for baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York. **NON-SACRIFICIAL LAMBS:** The Hudson Valley Renegades have not laid down a sacrifice bunt in either of the last two seasons, one of four teams in MiLB to not register a sacrifice bunt in that time (also Asheville, Fayetteville and Tampa). The last time the Renegades successfully executed a sacrifice bunt was Eduardo Torrealba on 8/31/2021 at Greensboro, a span of 286 regular season games.

**ON THE MOVE:** This week the Renegades have sent two pitchers directly up to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. On Thursday **Yorlin Calderon** was summoned up to the RailRiders, and on Saturday **Matt Givin** was promoted to AAA before he ever had a chance to pitch for Hudson Valley.

PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS: *Baseball America* - NYY #10; *MLB Pipeline* - NYY #12

**LAST TIME OUT:** Carr's professional debut came to a premature end last Saturday when he left after tossing 2.0 innings at Bowling Green. He allowed two runs (one earned) on one hit while walking three and striking out one, but threw 40 pitches in the top of the second. The hit, a double by Brock Jones, was the only hit allowed by the Renegades as four pitchers combined to one-hit the Hot Rods in a 14-2 victory.

**INJURIES IN SAN DIEGO:** Carr spent two years playing at the University of San Diego before transferring to Palomar for 2023. During that time he struggled with injuries including Tommy John surgery in October 2020, and a broken hand and torn right shoulder labrum in 2022. Carr to the San Diego Union-Tribune: "I struggled with injuries and school at USD. And they were related. As I fought my way through the injuries, I let my schoolwork slip. And you can't do that in college. You have to stay on top of your classes. I didn't do that. I loved the coaches and players at USD. [USD head coach] Brock Ungricht is one of the really good guys, my favorite all-time coach. I felt I let him down."

**POWER PITCHING:** Carr opened eyes at Palomar with a fastball that touches 97 mph, a sharp-breaking slider and a mid-80s power changeup. Scouts registered his velocity as continuing to sit at 95 late into games. Carr: "The biggest thing for me is that I'm finally healthy ... That hasn't always been the case. I've always been able to throw hard, but now as I've matured, I've been able to keep my stuff late into games."

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.

### PERSONAL:

- Full name is Kyle Isiah Carr.
- Pitched one season at Palomar College (2023) after spending two seasons at the University of San Diego (2021-22).
- Underwent Tommy John surgery in October 2020 after graduating from high school, also broke his hand in February 2022 while at San Diego, then tore his right (non-pitching) labrum in March 2022 while swinging a bat.
- Had committed to play at TCU following his graduation from Palomar, but signed with the Yankees instead. TCU had recruited him out of high school, but he decided to stay home in Southern California. When he transferred to Palomar, TCU was one of the first schools to reach out.
- Was named ABCA West Region Pitcher of the Year and the ABCA Pitcher of the Year after going 12-1 with a 2.31 ERA (78.0 IP, 20 ER) in 15 games (14 starts) for the Palomar Comets in 2023.
- At San Diego was a two-way player who mostly pitched, going 2-for-14 at the bat in 2022.
- Graduated from San Marcos HS in 2020, where as a two-way player he hit over .400 in his last two seasons.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Making his season debut on Sunday at Bowling Green, Schlittler turned in a phenomenal start, completing 6.0 innings of one-hit shutout baseball while walking one and striking out two. The right-hander retired the first nine batters of the game, before he allowed an infield single to Chandler Simpson leading off the top of the fourth. He walked Simpson in the sixth for the only other baserunner against him. He needed 64 pitches to navigate the outing.

### 2024 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Threw career-high 6.0 innings in his first start of the year at Bowling Green on April 7, allowing one hit, one walk and seven strikeouts while starting off a 3-0 shutout win. He was the first Renegades pitcher this year to pitch into the third inning (3rd game of season).

### 2023 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in Extended Spring Training and assigned to the FCL Yankees... transferred to Single-A Tampa Tarpons on Aug. 2... transferred to High-A Hudson Valley on Aug. 29.
- Was promoted up to Tampa after Leonardo Pestana and Baron Stuart were transferred to Hudson Valley.
- Made his professional debut on June 9 at FCL Phillies: ND, 3.2 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K.
- Picked up his first professional win on Sept. 9 (1) vs Jersey Shore: 5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 6 K. Notably, this was the game that the Renegades wore their Snooki jerseys, a jersey designed with help from Jersey Shore star (and former Renegades part-time employee) Nicole "Snooki" Polizzi for the Renegades' Snooki Night promotion, which was postponed due to inclement weather on Sept. 8. The night (not Schlittler's start) was featured in parts two episodes of the most-recent season of MTV's *Jersey Shore: Family Vacation* which aired this winter.

### PERSONAL:

- Full name is Cameron John Schlittler.
- In three seasons at Northeastern University (2020-22), went 14-9 with a 2.62 ERA and 180 K... As a redshirt sophomore in 2022, posted a 3.53 ERA in 15 starts.
- In 2022 among CAA pitchers, ranked third in strikeouts (85), eighth in ERA and opponent's BA (.229), and 10th in wins (5)... Earned All-CAA First Team honors and was the co-Rookie of the Year in 2021.
- At Northeastern was coached by former MLB infielder Mike Glavine, the brother of Hall of Fame LHP Tom Glavine. Mike played six games in 2003 with the New York Mets and parts of nine seasons in the minor leagues from 1995-2004 with the Cleveland, Atlanta and Mets organizations, as well as a two-year stint with the Somerset Patriots in '01 and '02 when they competed in the independent Atlantic League.
