### Leading Off

The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series with the Portland Sea Dogs on Tuesday night. It is the 13th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-12 in Reading. Reading won the season-series over Harrisburg last season 11-9, with a 5-3 record at home, and 6-6 on the road. The teams play next at Portland from July 19-21. Portland currently leads the season-series 9-3.

### A Strong Finish

The Fightin Phils clinched their third series win (all at home) of the season with a 4-0 win over the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday. Noah Skirrow earned his third win to improve to 3-3 and continue a strong week for him. Tristan Garnett, Tommy McCollum, Carlos Francisco and Tyler McKay each pitched a scoreless inning. It was the third shutout of the season for Reading and second in three games, and the pitching staff combined to strike out nine Senators and issue no walks. Kendall Simmons launched his seventh home run of the season in the second inning, then Carson Taylor hit his eighth. It was Taylor's Eastern League-leading 42nd RBI. Marcus Lee Sang had a two-run single in the seventh inning to add insurance runs and make it 4-0, Reading.

### Titles on Titles for Pina

Robinson Pina was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. Pina was nearly unhittable in his game-one complete-game shutout on Saturday night. Pina pitched seven innings, allowed two hits, no runs, zero walks and struck out six Senators hitters. Pina's complete game was the first seven-inning complete game by a Fightin Phils' pitcher since Ranger Suarez did it on June 19, 2018, at Portland. It was the first complete game of any sorts for Reading since Tyler Viza on September 1, 2018, at Trenton. It was also the first seven-inning shutout tossed by a Reading pitcher since Pete Zamora's perfect game on June 7, 2000, which was the only perfect game in Reading history. Pina's seven-inning shutout came 24 years and one-day later. Additionally, Pina threw the first two-hitter by a Reading pitcher since JC Ramirez did it on July 7, 2011, at Bowie. Pina's seven innings pitched is the most in a game by a Fightin Phils' pitcher since Matt Osterberg went seven frames at Binghamton on September 14, 2022. The seven innings matched a career-high for Pina, and it was his first shutout and complete game of his career.

### On the Way Up

It was a busy Tuesday in the Phillies organizations as many players were promoted to the next level. Reading received infielder Otto Kemp and catcher Andrick Nava from the High-A Jersey Shore BlueClaws. Kemp was named the Phillies Minor League Hitter of the Month for May. In May, Kemp slashed .337/.453/.581, with a 1.034 OPS. He added seven doubles, four triples, two homers and 15 RBI. With Jersey Shore, Kemp hit .333, with four home runs and 22 RBI. He led the South Atlantic League with a .333 batting average, .440 OBP, was sixth with a .533 SLG% and was third with a .973 OPS. Kemp also ranked amongst the league leaders in triples and runs scored. Joining Kemp is catcher Andrick Nava. Over 31 games this season with Jersey Shore, Nava is slashing .314/.388/.490, with a .878 OPS. He's added 13 runs, seven doubles, one triple, three homers and 21 RBI. Nava hit .349 in May and .320 in June prior to being called up.

### Rehabbing Relievers

Michael Rucker and Luis Ortiz are both scheduled to be rehab assignments with the Fightin Phils on Tuesday night. Rucker was placed on the 15-day injured list on May 28 with a right hand arterial vasospasm. He was transferred to the 60-day IL on June 3 and began a rehab assignment with Single-A Clearwater on June 7. It's his first year with the Phillies after previously pitching in the Cubs organization. Joining Rucker will be Luis Ortiz. The Phillies placed Ortiz on the 15-day IL on March 31 with a right ankle sprain. He made a brief rehab assignment with Clearwater on April 23.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

### Sea Dogs Synopsis

Portland enters tonight in first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division with a 31-26 record. Portland most recently split a series at home against the Akron RubberDucks. Following this week, Portland returns home and welcomes Richmond to Hadlock Field. Portland's roster features 10 players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Luis Pereles (9), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

### Portland Pitcher

Righty Isaac Coffey makes the start tonight for Portland. This season, Coffey is 2-2, with a 4.64 ERA (42.2 IP, 34 H, 25 BB, 45 SO). Coffey last pitched June 4 against Akron, earning the win, while allowing three runs over five innings, with seven strikeouts, matching a season-high. Against Reading this season, Coffey is 0-1 over two starts (10.2 IP, 6 H, 4 ER, 4 BB, 9 SO). Coffey also faced Reading twice in 2023. In his career against Reading, allowing six-earned runs over four innings. Coffey split 2023 between High-A Greenville and Portland, combining to go 11-6, with a 3.37 ERA over 23 appearances. He made his pro debut with the FCL-Red Sox in 2022. The Boston Red Sox drafted Coffey in the 10th round of the 2022 draft out of Oral Roberts.

**CAREER TRANSACTIONS:** Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as an undrafted free agent on July 20, 2021.
