#### TRAVS WALK OFF RIDERS ON JULY 3RD:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Arkansas Travelers 3-2 on Wednesday evening from Dickey-Stephens Park. Frisco (5-4, 49-29) started the scoring against Arkansas (6-3, 42-35) when **Alejandro Osuna** and **Liam Hicks** scored on an RBI double by **Cody Freeman**, giving the Riders a 2-0 lead in the top of the first. Arkansas cut the deficit in half in the bottom of the first inning on an RBI Freeman, giving the Riders a 2-0 lead in the top of the first. Arkansas cut the deficit in half in the bottom of the first inning on an RBI double by the Mariners top prospect, Cole Young. Trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the second, **Ben Anderson** induced a 4-6-3 double play but the Travelers tied the game at 2-2 as Victor Labrada crossed the plate. Anderson exited after 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on six hits and no walks with six punchouts. **Andy Rodriguez** worked a pair of one-hit, scoreless innings with three strikeouts to keep the game knotted at two. **Seth Clark** entered the game, working a scoreless eighth inning. In the bottom of the ninth, Harry Ford opened the frame with a double and advanced on an errant pickoff attempt by Clark. With the winning run standing 90-feet away, the left-hander picked up back-to-back strikeouts before inducing a groundout to second to end the threat, sending the game to extra innings. The Riders loaded the bases in the top of the tenth inning with one out, but were unable to score against Peyton Alford (3-1). **Steven Jennings** (6-1) entered for the bottom of the tenth, inheriting Labrada as the runner at second base. A sacrifice bunt pushed the winning run to third. Offensively, the Riders were paced by Osuna's three-hit night. **Kellen Strahm** also snagged a pair of hits in the loss.

#### HAPPY FOURTH:

The Riders play Arkansas today for the Fourth of July, hosting an Independance Day game for the 12th time in their 21 years as a franchise. The Riders are 13-7 on Fourth of July, including their 6-3 win over Midland last year. This is their sixth game against the Travelers on the Fourth of July in franchise history, most of any team in the Texas League.

#### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh on Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has clubbed three home runs in his last nine games with two of them being game-winners and drove in the only runs that the Riders scored on July 3rd with a two-run double in the first. This sea son, he has a career highs in average (.272), slugging percentage (.455) and OPS (.782) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (63) and home runs (16).

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Tex-as League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

#### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the third-fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (46) while also ranking third in fielding percentage (.982) in the minors. Frisco's 76 double plays are tied for the most in the Texas League. Frisco have allowed the fourth-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (56), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

#### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.86 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their last eight games, the bullpen has a 2.14 ERA (8ER/33.2IP). In their last five series, spanning 34 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.81 ERA (25ER/124.1IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** was fantastic, only surrendering two runs over his nine outings, throwing 18.1 innings (0.98 ERA).

### FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 24 games, the Riders have allowed just 61 earned runs over 220.1 IP (2.49 ERA). On Saturday, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 11 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 33 games (5/23 vs. MID). In thier last 36 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 12 times and nine times in the last 24 games

#### HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 39 games, batting .313 (42-for-134)/.421/.433/.854 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 20 strikeouts and 25 runs. In June (21 games), he hit .333 (25-for-75)/.440/.520/.960 with five doubles, three home runs and 11 RBIs, reaching in all but three games in the month. He paced the Texas League in BA (.333) and OPS (.960) in June. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.



ABOUT NICK -Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-8.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### **2021 SEASON**

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
