#### JUMBO SHRIMP FALTER LATE IN 7-6 DEFEAT

Both **Deyvison De Los Santos** and **Jacob Berry** homered and **Cade Gibson** struck out six in 3.1 dominant innings, but a late **Eloy Jiménez** homer vaulted Durham to a 7-6 win over Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp plated three two-out runs in the first only for the Bulls to tie on **Bob Seymour's** three-run shot in the bottom of the inning. Each side scored twice in the third before Berry's home run broke the tie in the sixth. Jiménez, though, crushed a two-run shot in the eighth to give Durham its first lead. Gibson ceded just one hit in his 3.1 innings and did not walk a batter.

#### APRIL COME SHE WILL

With a 21-8 (.750) record, the Jumbo Shrimp already posses the most wins of any team in Minor League Baseball. As the calendar turns to May, the 21 wins Jacksonville accumulated through March and April were the most in recorded club history (2005-present) over the months of March and April. In the month of April alone, Jacksonville recorded 19 victories, their most in any month since a 20-win August during the 2017 season.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Wednesday's 7-6 Jacksonville loss at Durham was the 18th time in the last 20 games that the Jumbo Shrimp played a contest decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 13-5 (.722) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 15-6 (.714) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 10-3 (.769) mark in one-run games. Those 10 one-run victories are by far the most in the minors; only two (Oklahoma City & Chesapeake) of the other 119 MiLB teams have even eight wins by exactly one run.

#### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 18 of their last 28 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank third in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 75 stolen bases.

#### 'PFN PALS

Jacksonville starters have gone at least 5.0 innings just 13 times in 29 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.53 ERA (second-place Memphis at 3.39 is closer to 12th place than to Jacksonville) and .186 BAA, the best marks in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks third in the level in both fewest hits allowed (93) and strikeouts (152). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 138.2 innings through 29 games (4.8 per game), fifth-most in Triple-A.

#### BE STILL. MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 115.0 innings thus far through the season's first 29 games, a rate of just 4.0 per contest. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective; Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have posted the second-best ERA in Triple-A at 3.13 and issued just 30 walks, the fewest in the level. The club's starters also rank fifth in both fewest hits allowed (95) and BAA (.228). Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three runs or fewer in 12 of their last 13 games and in 26 of their 29 contests this season.

#### HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 16-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a nearly 2:1 margin at 83-46 at VyStar Ballpark. Of the other 119 teams in Minor League Baseball, only 10 have double-digit wins at home, with none above 12 home triumphs. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-6 on the road, with a 50-50 margin in their run differential. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .767 and at home compared to .685 on the road. Their team ERA is 2.05 at home and 4.05 on the road.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost consecutive games for only the second time this season... Jakob Marsee leads the International League with 20 stolen bases. The two players in second place have 13 steals, meaning they are as close to Marsee in first place as to the 11 players tied for 24th place with six swipes... Marsee also ranks tied for tied for second in walks (21). Maximo Acosta's 19 walks are sixth in the IL.

#### ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

- -Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).
- -When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).
- -As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.
- -Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.

#### 2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
