**WHAT A TRIP:** After winning three thrillers in the first three games of the series against the Charleston RiverDogs, the FredNats go for the series win tonight on Friday night at the Joe. Fredericksburg's bullpen has held onto slim leads late in all three games of this series so far, and tonight, the team sends top pitching prospect Jarlin Susana to the hill against the RiverDogs. Susana has pitched well in his last two starts, combining for 8 IP with three runs allowed and 13 strikeouts against just two walks.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Jose Atencio turned in the longest start of the season for the FredNats, throwing 94 pitches in six innings to earn his third win of the season. Atencio allowed two runs and finally walked his first batter of the year after over 28 IP. The Freddie's overcame seven errors in the field to win the game 11-8. Brenner Cox hit a three-run home run, his second of the series, and Marcus Brown had two doubles and two RBIs in the win. Bubba Hall got out of an 8th inning jam to hold the lead for Fredericksburg, who remains undefeated when leading after seven this year.

**LEAVE 'EM LOADED:** The FredNat pitching staff have stranded the bases loaded in crucial moments late in all three wins in this series with the RiverDogs. In Tuesday's game, Fredericksburg got a game-ending double play in the 10th with the bases loaded. On Wednesday, Merrick Baldo left the bases loaded to end the game with the tying runs in scoring position when he struck out Christopher Barete. Last night, Bubba Hall left them loaded with a one-run lead in the 8th.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are a perfect 15-0 this season when scoring first, including all five wins two weeks ago against Delmarva, all four wins last week over Down East, and the first two wins this week against Charleston.

**CONTINUED:** Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 21 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .246 with RISP, compared to .091 in losses. The Freddie's went 2-for-17 with RISP on Sunday, and left 14 men on base in a two-run loss. The FredNats have struggled at the plate with runners in scoring position in all three wins this week, going a combined 6-for-25 against Charleston, but the FredNat bullpen has held on to leads all three nights so far.

**BULLPEN WORK:** So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. In 160 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 39 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.19. The Freddie's are also 11/12 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and tied with High-A Wilmington's Todd Peterson for the second-most saves in Minor League Baseball with six. The team is 16-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 18-0 when leading after eight innings this year. Bryan Polanco has been a strong contributor to the bullpen, logging 25.1 innings and allowing just seven earned runs. He pitched 4.1 scoreless frames last night in relief of starter Travis Sykora.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 162-129 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Jarlin Susana is set to make his sixth start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a fading changeup and a sharp slider that will touch the low 90's.

**EARLY-SEASON HIGHS:** After an up-and-down April, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

**LATE-SEASON LULL:** Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Susana brought his best stuff last week against the Down East Wood Ducks. The big righty allowed just three base hits and one walk over four innings, while striking out six batters and walking just one. Over his last two starts, Susana has given up three runs in 8.0 IP, with a 13:2 strikeout to walk ratio.
